1. Chatting and receiving calls during Church Service.
2. Running out to pick calls with your phone ringing out so loud. This is SACRILEGIOUS.
3. Refusing to obey the directives of the Church Stewards indicates disobedience in the house of God.
4. Folding your hands when your Pastor is teaching or preaching. You are telling him that what he is saying is not worthwhile.
5. Habitual lateness to Church service is a SPIRITUAL FLIGHT that has take off time.
6. Staring at fellow parishioners and making them uncomfortable.
7. Dozing or sleeping in Church during sermon or in the course of the Service –Acts 20:9.
8. Sitting down inactive during Prayer or Praise session especially when other parishioners are standing without any evidence of health challenge.
9. Looking at the clock on the wall and your wristwatch and then at the Pastor's face insinuating that he should round off.
10. Borrowing things like phone chargers, pen etc. and leaving the Church with the said items. Remember Exodus 20:15, 17.
11. Leaving the Church before the end of Service.
12. Gathering outside the Church to discuss while Service is going on. You're not honouring God whom you come to Worship.
13. Buying yourself a seat in Church and ensuring no one sits there even when you are not in church.
14. Leaving the Church without dropping your offering.
15. Talking and distracting others while service is on.

THEME: PRAYER: ASKING & RECEIVING

READING: PSALM 31, 1 KINGS, 3:13-14, 1 JOHN

5:13-15, JOHN 16:21-24;

TEXT: JOHN 14:23-24; 1 JOHN 5:14-15; I KINGS 3:10

INTRODUCTION:

To be a Christian without prayer is no more possible, than to be alive without breathing “– Martin Luther”.

Prayer is talking to God. It is our way of communicating our thoughts, needs and desires to Him. It is an avenue that God has provided for the believer of making know the deepest feelings of our heart.

Prayer is an act, not merely an attitude which means you begin and finish it. Prayer is not something, you merely think or talk about but an ACT you carried out, Prayer is God’s power made available to mankind, a great resources to make changes. Prayer is a force to be used, a tool to be utilized, a mighty weapon to be deployed. Hebrew 4:16.

Oswald Smith says “when we work, we work, when we pray, God works. Throughout history, the men and women that God used mightily have been people WHO KNOW HOW TO PRAY AND FOR WHOM PRAYER WAS BOTH A PRIORITY AND A NECESSITY.

Jesus Christ in His earthly sojourn and ministry made prayer a priority, a necessity and way of life. It was a means of communion with the father and the means of brining the power of God the father to bear on His humanity status moment by moment, (Matthew 12:18, 28; Mark 1:32-37; Luke 21:39-46; John 5:19).

Beloved, in a time like this (1Peter 4:7; 2 Timothy 3:1-5; Matthew 24:7, 8, 12) If you will ask from, communicate or commune with God and receive. There are principles to be applied. Solomon prayed and received because his words pleases God (1 Kings 3:10NKJV) Some of the principles are as follows:

1. Prayer offered from a Pure Heart

When your heart or mind cherished sin or remain polluted or contaminated with sins, it is classified IMPURE. When you ask with such heart without CONFESSING AND FORSAKING those sins or sinful habit, you will not receive. Psalm 66:18 NIV “If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened”. Unconfessed and forsaken sins hindered your prayer (Psalm 24:3-5; Matthew 5:8)

2. Prayer offered in Righteousness

Righteousness simply means when you continue to do what God says at the stated time completely. When a righteous person prayed it command God’s attention with evidence of such person’s joy full or complete after prayer (Psalm 34:15, 17; Proverb 28:9; Isaiah 59:1-2)

3. Prayer offered in/with God word

One of the most effective prayer is to pray God’s word back to Him. The Psalmist said in Psalm 138:2b “.....For you have magnified Your word above all Your name”. *To ask and received in order for your joy to be full become addicted to the study, memorizing and meditating in God’s word.* A Christian filled with revelations from God’s word can never pray a miss (John 15:7; James 4:3; 1 John 5:14).

4. Prayer offered from a heart of faith

Once you begin prayer based on God’s word, the next step is to submerge your pray in faith. That means you don’t wait for a manifestation to believe you receive. The simple and quick tips for adding faith to your prayers involve - Believe you receive when praying; speak it and Act on it. (Matthew 21:22; Mark 11:24; Hebrew 10:35; 11:6).

5. Prayer offered with and in thanksgiving and Praises

The Psalmist says in Psalm 100:4a “Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with Praise”. Whenever you approach the throne of grace (Hebrew 4:16) with and in genuine thanksgiving and praises, your asking receive God attention and your Joy will be full. Likewise Apostle Paul encourages us to always seasoned our prayer with thanksgiving (Philippians 4:6).
