5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 6TH DECEMBER, 2020

THEME: THE HOLY SCRIPTURES READING: PSALM 119:105-112, 1SAIAH 11:1-10; ROMANS 15:4-12; JOHN 5:36B-END.

A. Introduction

Thank goodness we are talking about the Holy Scriptures today. We have always read in it as traditionally handed down and as commanded. The challenge of this present generation is ensuring the Bible is conscientiously handed down to the next generation. I'm not a fan of the dying ritual of not holding the traditional printed Bible, at least on a Sunday to the Church. I see a trend and I sound an alarm right away. A time may come when a physical Bible may be hard to find in a Christian family. Thank God for the electronic age. However, we must be wary of the imminent danger it poses if we fail to remain conservative in perpetuating the Bible. I agree that the Word of God can't be extinct but I wager that frivolity may grow into gross spiritual lethargy. I suspect modernization was part of the troubles of the seven Churches in Asia minor. It should be fashionable to hold a Bible going to the Church. Can our bag makers and fashion makers help make pouches and bags etc to create some fashion around the Bible? Can we once more be proud of the Bible! I want to encourage you add the Bible to your every Sunday must-holds. Every parent reading this should get copies of the Bible for their children and read in it together, every day. In reading it is knowledge. In studying it is revelation. In living it is power.

As we know, the Bible is a unique Book containing 66 books, written by 40 people, on three continents, in three languages, over a period of 16 centuries. Amongst the writers were fishermen, prophets, scribes, shepherds, farmers, kings, poets, vinedressers, orchard worker, lawyer, and physician. Many lived centuries apart and some lived in countries separated by hundreds of miles. Yet they produced 66 books which together have a remarkable internal harmony. The wonderful unity of the theme is amazing.

B. The Testifiers of Jesus Christ

The writings of the Scriptures are all thematically centered on Jesus Christ as its very life and essence. Jesus made this convincingly clear in John 5:39 'you search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; it is these that testify about me'. The Bible is about Jesus. Jesus who is God in flesh (John 1:1&14), the one who became a sacrifice on our behalf before the Father. This is whom the Bible is written about. Only in the Bible do we read about him from those who knew him and walked with Him. Only in the Bible do we find the words of 1 Cor. 1:9 which says, "God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord."Only in the Bible do we find the words of Christ who says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life, and no one comes the Father but by me," (John 14:6). Only in Christ, whom the Bible is about, can we find rest. Jesus said, "Come to me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. 29 "Take My yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and you shall find rest for your souls. 30 "For My yoke is easy, and my load is light," (Matt. 11:28-30). In many places in the New Testament, Jesus alluded to the writings of the Old Testament.

C. The Godly Routine of Studying the Word of God

Christians should be proud to have the Scriptures breathed or inspired by God for us. Recently, I began to study about 'routine'. I discovered that our entire life is hinged on functional routines; biologically, environmentally and every wise. It will staggeringly interest you that spirituality also thrives on routine. We live on patterns and trends. All in small and big cycles of repetitive events. Spiritual growth answers to consistent, continuous, regular and steady working of spiritual activities or disciplines. No magic around it! Exercising your faith has to be practiced. Hearing God speak takes practice. Observing your quiet time must followed through. Reading the Scriptures is one of the routines and habits every Christian must observe. Timothy was an example for us. Apostle Paul, in 2Tim 3:14-17 admonished Timothy to continue in the things he had learned. He referenced the Holy Scriptures he has known since his childhood. From childhood, we must work the Word of God into the lives of our children. Can I add by force? Yes, by force! I plead with you to understand the seriousness of this. Proverbs 22:6 "train up a child in the way he should go, he won't deviate when he grows"

D. The All-Sufficiency of the Scriptures 2Tim 3:15-17

1. They Are Inspired..."God breathed" (theopneustos)

The Scriptures are not the words or thoughts of mere men, but of Spirit-guided men who spoke and wrote the very Word of God! Jn 16:13; 1Co 14:37; 1Th 2:13

2. They Are Profitable...

As extoled by David, the Scriptures are truly "profitable" (helpful, advantageous), Ps 19:7-11. 2Tim 3:16 mentioned four things about its profitability

i. For doctrine: Teaching, instruction. They have all that God wants us to know regarding Himself and His will for us. ii. For reproof: Proof, conviction. The Scriptures has the ability to convict those in error of their wrong, showing them the need to change. iii. For correction: Correction, improvement of life or character. iv. For instruction in righteousness: Instruction in regard to the principles of natural and divine justice, or what is right.

Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. (Acts 20:32)

How has God's Word built me up this last week? This last month? This last year?

5. God's Word guides us.

Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. (Psalm 119:105) What voice do I make loudest? God's or something else?

God's Word gives us wisdom.

The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. (Psalm 19:7). Your commands are always with me and make me wiser than my enemies. I have more insight than all my teachers, for I meditate on your statutes. I have more understanding than the elders, for I obey your precepts. (Psalm 119:98-100)

Do I go to God's word for wisdom and insight before phoning a friend?

7. God's Word protects us from sin.

How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word. (Psalm 119:9)

I have hid den your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. (Psalm 119:11)

Do I think scripture memory is just for kids?

8. God's Word brings delight.

The statues of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart. (Psalm 19:8) When circumstances or emotions are bringing me low, do I let God's Word lift my head?

9. God's Word is at work in believers.

And we also thank God continually because, when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as a human word, but as it actually is, the word of God, which is indeed at work in you who believe. (1 Thessalonians 2:13)

Do I allow the Word of God to work in me?

10. God's Word is our offensive weapon against Satan.

Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. (Ephesians 6:17)

Am I trying to fight temptation in my own strength? Have I given up on fighting certain temptations because it's too hard to fight on my own?
