5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 20TH DECEMBER, 2020

THEME: THE FAVOUR OF GOD READING: PSALM 45:10-END, 1SAIAH 7:10-17; ROMANS 1:1-7; LUKE 1:26-38a.

It is in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ, that we heartily welcome you to the presence of God this fourth Sunday in Advent and the Sunday before Christmas. We thank God that the global storms of the year failed to drown our joy of celebration. Praise the Lord!

Pondering how good it is that God above has never gone on strike because He was not treated fair in things He didn't like; an unknown author scripted the following possible reactions of God that could have wiped humanity off the face of the earth. He wondered If only once God's given up and said, "That's it, I'm through," "I've had enough of these on earth, so this is what I'll do. "I'll give My orders to the sun, cut off the heat's supply, and to the moon give no more light, and run the oceans dry. Then just to make things really tough and put the pressure on, turn off the vital oxygen till every breath is gone." You know He would be justified, if fairness were the game for no one has been more abused or met with more disdain than God, and yet He carries on, supplying you and me with all the favours of His grace, and everything for free.

Favour is gracious kindness or an act of such kindness shown to a person or group of persons. The element of grace in this definition implies that favour is really an unmerited act of kindness shown to or received by a person and this tallies with the popular definition of grace as unmerited favour.

The intricate relationship between grace and favour makes it such that both terms are difficult to differentiate and are as such often used interchangeably. When considered in relation to God, which is the thematic focus of our thought for this week – **The Favour of God**, one begins to appreciate the thinking that led the author to enumerating God's possible reactions to man's unfair treatment of Him.

As we can see Matt. 5: 45, favour is bestowed upon man, in that He causes the rain to fall and the sun to shine upon both the good and the evil. If God were to deal in reciprocal "fairness", a large majority if not all of us would have been cut off from the face of the earth. Why? you may ask. Well, we are all undeserving! In one way or the other, we have fallen short of His glory. So, the fact that we are alive especially with all that has happened since the beginning of the year is a great show of God's favour.

When we take a look at Luke 1:26 – 38a, we see a vivid recipient of God's favour. Mary, by all worldly merits and standards did not necessarily deserve to be chosen as the mother of Jesus. She wasn't the only virgin in the city of Nazareth but she was chosen by God. *Being favoured is simply grace granted to the undeserving*. When God decides to favour a person, the person's qualifications, background and connections do **not** matter.

We must necessarily realize that we are all beneficiaries of God's favour. The fact that we are alive, healthy, able to function independently, have food and water on our table, a place to lay our head and clothes on our bodies goes to show the extent of God's favour on us. We tend to rationalize our perceptions of God's favour into the granting of our wants and desires at each particular time. "Oh, I need a better job and I went for that interview but didn't get it. So, God has not favoured me." "I am in financial difficulty and nothing is happening even with all my prayers, so God has not favoured me." This mindset is extremely wrong. You may not have attained the level of financial security you desire, yet your child is on an educational scholarship, you do not have to borrow to pay hospital bills. You desire a better job but the one you have is meeting your needs. That is favour! It might not be how you expect it but it is how God sees you need it.

We however need to note that since grace dispenses God's favour, a warning in Pauline treatise on grace must be taken into consideration in our appropriation of this unmerited gift called favour. Paul asked in Romans 6:1b – "Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?" and he retorted in v.2 – Certainly not! What Apostle Paul is saying here is that Grace and sin do not hold a direct proportionate relationship. Grace does not expand in coverage with increase in sin, hence it can be dangerous for us to assume a constant, unfailing, eternal supply of divine favour irrespective of how we live.

Our life of faith in purity and holiness may not buy us favour, it help sits sustenance because God doesn't get angry with holy living; he is rather enthused by it and looks on those who live it with favour upon favour, showing mercy, according to Exod.20:6, to thousands of those who love Him and keep His commandments. Apostle Paul brought this to sharper focus when he wrote in his pastoral Epistle to Titus – "For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, 12 teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, 13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, 14 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works." Titus 2:11-14.

This is a point we cannot afford to forget or ignore as we celebrate Christmas in joyful appreciation of the salvation that Jesus brought to mankind at his birth.

May grace that brought salvation to man through divine favour on Mary continue to attend our ways in the name of Jesus.
