1 Timothy 3:15; 2 Thessalonians 3:7; 1 Thessalonians 2:10

1. Chatting and receiving calls during Church Service.
2. Running out to pick calls with your phone ringing out so loud. This is SACRILEGIOUS.
3. Refusing to obey the directives of the Church Stewards indicates disobedience in the house of God.
4. Folding your hands when your Pastor is teaching or preaching. You are telling him that what he is saying is not worthwhile.
5. Habitual lateness to Church service is a SPIRITUAL FLIGHT that has take off time.
6. Staring at fellow parishioners and making them uncomfortable.
7. Dozing or sleeping in Church during sermon or in the course of the Service -Acts 20:9.
8. Sitting down inactive during Prayer or Praise session especially when other parishioners are standing without any evidence of health challenge.
9. Looking at the clock on the wall and your wristwatch and then at the Pastor's face insinuating that he should round off.
10. Borrowing things like phone chargers, pen etc. and leaving the Church with the said items. Remember Exodus 20:15, 17.
11. Leaving the Church before the end of Service.
12. Gathering outside the Church to discuss while Service is going on. You're not honouring God whom you come to Worship.
13. Buying yourself a seat in Church and ensuring no one sits there even when you are not in church.
14. Leaving the Church without dropping your offering.
15. Talking and distracting others while service is on.

THEME: BEING FAITHFUL TO OUR CALLING

READING: PSALM 89:19-30, ISAIAH 42:1-9;

ACTS 10:34-38a; MATTHEW 3:13-17.

It is one thing to serve God; it is another thing to be faithful in the service. Our God is not a God of ‘everything goes’, He demands our faithfulness to Him as the only God we have. We all serve God in one way or the other, but have we paused and thought for a moment whether the kind of service we offer unto God is acceptable to Him? Serving God is more than just coming to church to give our offering to God. It entails our entire life; it involves the way we talk, treat others, manage the resources we have, our mindset, opinions, imaginations, and beliefs. God has called us into a new life and we must live worthy of it.

Being faithful to our calling requires:

- a. Serving with exceptional love for the Master
- b. Sacrificial service unto God and man—it must cost you something- **II Sam.24:24; Mk.14:6-9.**
- c. Serving beyond self — selfless service — **Philippians 2:19-23; Gal.2:20.**
- d. Serving with fervency — not lukewarm or sluggish service- **Rev.3: 15-16**
- e. Serving willingly and cheerfully - **Rom.12:8; 2 Cor.9:7.**
- f. Serving with good motives and intentions — holy and acceptable —**Romans 12:1-2**
- g. Serving not as men’s pleasers but God’s pleasers- Col 3:22-24

To be faithful, therefore, means

- To be devoted, totally committed to the life Christ has given us
- To be honest, stick to the truth, sincere, not dubious
- To be trustworthy in all God's given assignments
- To be dependable
- To put to use God's talents and blessings in you accordingly.

God is calling for your:-

- 1. Availability:** The very first thing Jesus did was to make Himself available- Phil 2:6-7. He relinquished His glory to be qualified for the assignment. It therefore implies that faithfulness in service requires some levels of sacrifice.
