faith, it is an overcomer's walk, it is a winning walk; nothing less. The only way to build capacity, enlarge coast, expand, attain greater heights, tread uncharted path, break new grounds, hear God, love God, grow spiritually, receive spiritual gifts and get God seriously involved is by walking with Jesus by faith. We all need to quickly key into this powerful flow. This season, Epiphany is about the manifestation of Jesus to the Gentiles. We, the Christians, the people that are like Christ, the ones who received the revelation of Jesus must truly walk like him to be able to show him to the world.

2. WALKING IN JESUS'S FOOTSTEPS IS TRULY BEING LIKEJESUS - SPIRITUAL IDENTICALNESS

Children will naturally follow the steps of their parents, especially when they are very young. We are to take after Jesus's in all ways. We are to imitate Him. Paul boldly told the Corinthian Church to imitate him as he imitates Christ. And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ. 1 Cor. 11:1. Also, in Eph 5:1-2, he said, therefore, be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you.

For constraint of space, we can consider the topic under three perspectives:

A. WALKING WITH JESUS - SPIRITUAL FRIENDSHIP /FELLOWSHIP/ASSOCIATION

Three things are involved here; (1)Association - Matt 4:19, (2) Humility - Micah 6:8 and (3) Learning - Matt 11:28-30. Associate with Jesus - be born again. Be humble because He is the Master and He knows everything. If you are humble, you will be able to learn from Him. The Apostles could do great things because they walked with Jesus. They were discipled by Jesus. They knew the ways of Jesus. They interacted with Jesus. In Yoruba language, there is a proverb that says, if a leaf stays for some time wrapped round a soap, it will start behaving like the soap at some point. Association is the first step to be taken if we are going to walk in Jesus's footsteps. There has to be a togetherness; a bringing in, an alliance, an agreement that fosters quality relationship. As Christians, our destiny is to walk with God. It is coming into a divine relationship with Christ. Consider the example of these three men in the Bible that walked with God - Enoch, Noah and Abraham.

- "When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah. And after he became the father of Methuselah, Enoch walked with God 300 years. Enoch walked with God; then he was no more, because God took him away" Gen. 5:21-24.Enoch's fellowship with God was so close that God caught him straight up to heaven to be with Him, without Enoch having to taste of death first.
- Noah was one of a handful of men that impressed the heart of God (Ezekiel 14:12-20). Like Enoch, he is described as a man who "walked with God". "Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God" Genesis 6:9; 7:1.
- "...the Lord appeared to Abram and said, 'I am God Almighty, walk before me and be blameless" Genesis 17:11 ike Fnoch and Noah. Abraham walked with God

"...'Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness,' and he was called God's friend" James 2:23. Abraham's fellowship with the Lord was so great that he was called the "friend" of God (2Chronicles 20:7). Like Enoch, Noah and Abraham, each of us has a choice between two walks -between walking with the world or walking with God (Jas 4:4). In Matthew 11:28-29, Jesus used the picture of yoked oxen plowing a field. When you join two oxen in one yoke, the plowing becomes easier. Christ wants us to be yoked with Him so that we can learn from Him what it means to walk with God.

B. WALK IN JESUS - SPIRITUAL GROWTH

"And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit" The major growth catalyst is the Spirit of the Living God. Ephesians 2:22.Paul told the Athenians about God in Acts 17:28, "for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring". In 1Samuel 3, the boy Samuel mistook the voice of God for the voice of Prophet Eli but that same night, he grew in the knowledge of God, such that He started knowing how to hear God speak.

- Walking in Christ is walking in the Spirit. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit Gal 5:25
- Walking in Christ is walking in the light of His teachings.
- Walking in Christ is appropriating the Word of God.
- Walking in Christ is nothing less than submission to His lordship.
- Walking in Christ is a call to display our gratitude for His grace.
- Walking in Christ is reflecting the fact that we are in union with Christ, and we will grow in our knowledge and application of the gospel as we bow to Him as Lord (Col. 2:7).

C. WALK LIKE CHRIST – SPIRITUAL ATTITUDE / BEHAVIOUR/EXPRESSION

To have a spiritual rebirth, new birth, new life in Christ, new life in the spirit and in the kingdom. It is contrasted with physical birth-Luke 15:7. The holy spirit midwives the process working actively in the Trinity-John 1:13, 6:44. It could be dramatic or Gradual. Acts 9.
- 4. Kingdoms. Every one of us has a kingdom. A realm that is uniquely our own, where our choice determines what happens. This is the core of the likeness or image of God in us. Our kingdom is simply the range of our effective will. In creating human beings God made them to rule, to reign in a limited sphere. Gen.1:28-30.
- 5. The kingdom of God/ Heaven. This is the range of God's effective will. Where what He wants done is done. In the kingdom of God is His person and action of His will. Everything that obeys those principles by
