# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY, 2021

THEME: THE CALL TO FOLLOW CHRIST READING: PSALM 99:4-9, HOSEA 14:1-7; COLOSSIANS 1:18-23; MARK 2:13-17

Ministering unto others and dying for sinners were incidentally true of the assignment of the Lord Jesus, but fundamentally and essentially true of Him is that He came not to do his own will but the will of Him who sent Him (John 6: 38) in that He became obedient unto death. (Phil.2:8). Having taken a clue from Jesus, we can say that a call to follow Christ is a call to say yes to the command of God (Ps.119:32). It is accepting to go all the way for God; accepting to be His servant; responding positively to the Lordship of Christ; subjecting oneself to His dominion and carrying out His revealed will. We can say that responding to this call is not to do something for God as though we show him favour but as discharging the obligations of a servant who does as his master bids him and seeks to please Him and promote His interests.

In other words, the call to follow Christ is not first to carry out assignments for Him in the Church or community but to love Him with all your strength, power, and mind and be ready to obey. (Deut.6:4-7). There is no one who can render any Christian service outside Jesus, the owner of the service; otherwise such service is going to be without God's approval and commendation. Jesus said to his disciples, "if anyone will follow me ....." (Luke 9:23). So, the first call on Christians is call to follow and obey Jesus Christ.

The call of Levi by Jesus is another incident that occurs as Jesus went about. He called him while teaching a crowd, and gospel by Mark has a record that he followed Him. In fact, Luke records that Levi left all to follow Jesus (Luke 5:28). Levi left friend, business, career, pleasure, and sinful lifestyle and followed Jesus. He did not mind the mockery from friends and the public. He was not ashamed of following Jesus being a big man in the society. He was purposed in his heart to go all the way with Jesus.

From the above point, we know that there can be no following without a previous forsaking. To follow Christ is to renounce all lesser loyalties just as Simon and Andrew also left their nets and followed Him. James and John left their father in the boat with the hired servants and followed. Mathew also left all just like Levi and followed Jesus.

Today, the call of Jesus has not changed. He says, 'follow me'. And as the disciples renounced their old ways, we are to renounce sins if we are to follow Him. This is called 'repentance' and the first part of Christian conversion. It is a definite turn from every thought, word, deed and habit which is known to be wrong. Repentance is an inward change of mind and attitude towards sin which leads to a change of behavior.

There can be no compromise here. To live the right life, you must go by the clear teaching of the Bible and by the prompting of your conscience under God and Christ will gradually lead you further along the path of righteousness.

## The Call is for a Purpose

However, all Christians are ordained stewards and servants to carry out some specific assignments. Such assignments are not limited to church activities, but cut across all spheres of life to the glory of God. At the back of our minds is to remember that the first call of God upon a man is to follow and obey the master, to know the secrets of the kingdom, to be friends of Jesus; to be heir and joint heir with Him and to be part of His assignments here on earth. All Christians are called to render service and minister in the body of Christ and in the community at large.

In other words, a call to Christ is a call to Christian service. It is a call upon all Christians so much that everything they are, everything they do and everything they have is invested with a special devotion, dynamism and direction lived out as a response of His summons and service.

However, any service that reflects Christ love is Christian service. Jesus' manifestoes were foretold in Isaiah 61, of which He himself reechoed in the Gospel according to Luke chapter 4. So, Christian service starts from giving a cup of water (Mark 9:4); to showing hospitality to strangers, (Hebrews 13:2); to remembering those in Prison, (Mathew 25). The Christian service is any work that reflects love of Christ.

#### Conclusion

The world is full of corruption and evil. The situation is so bad that God needs people to go to work of redemption. There are gaps in families, schools, polity, and economy. There is hunger, injustice, and a lot more. Governments, corporate bodies and individuals have tried doing the work on their own but it is not just working. To be candid, man is helpless without God's intervention.

To this end, all Christians' calls, beliefs, humility and love, should culminate in service, otherwise such belief or call is questionable. Jesus said in one of his sermons that Christians should let their light so shine before all men, that they may see their good works and glorify God(Mathew 5:16). Therefore, any faith or calling which does not result to works is dead, (James 2:17). The New Testament is replete with calls and there is no one that does not end in service.
