BECOMING MORE THAN CONQUERORS THROUGH THE LOVE OF GOD.

INTRODUCTION

Amidst the backdrop of insecurity, economic recession and the fight with COVID-19 Pandemic we have a clear leading to embark on this intensive PERSONAL prayer project as part of our Lenten season prayer.

God's Apostle set over the Diocese of Lagos West, our own Prophet THE RT. REV. JAMES OLUSOLA ODEDEJI Ph.D. has given us a powerful prophetic word from God for the year 2021.

And we have to run in prayer with the word in other to see it fulfilled in our lives. Otherwise it will remain a tale. The Bible says;

'This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare." 1 Timothy 1:18 “

This exercise is hereby tagged, “PROJECT ROMANS 8:28-39” it entails daily prayer of repentance, prayer of consecration and dedication to God, minimum of three prayer points from the book of Romans and numerous daily declaration/proclamations of the passage- Romans 8:28-39 daily, throughout the season of Lent to raise a cloud of victory, protection and help over our lives, our families, the church and our nation.

ROMANS 8:28-39

⁸ *And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.*

²⁹ *For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.*

³⁰ *Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.*

³¹ *What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?*

³² *He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?*

³³ *Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.*

³⁴ *Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.*

³⁵ *Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?*

³⁶ *As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.*

³⁷ *Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.*

³⁸ *For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,*

³⁹ *Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

MODE OF THE PROJECT

The essence of declaring the passage aloud over and over is to engage the power and virtue of concentration over the passage in order to release the Spirit and life(John 6:63) it carries to impact the Spiritual atmosphere over our lives, families, church and the entire nation.

A WORD ON THE PASSAGE

This passage of the book of Romans is very dense. It is concerned with the certainty and unshakability of God's love for us. Of all the passages in the New Testament, this is perhaps the one in which God's sovereignty is most apparent. The focus in these twelve verses is firmly on God rather than us-yet the cumulative sense of the verses is one of enormous security for us. It reveals HOW GOD WORKS FOR US. Verse 28. GOD'S ETERNAL PLAN FOR US Verse 29-30. OUR SECURITY IN GOD. Verse 31-39.THEREFORE; WE ARE MORE THAN CONQUERORS. Verse 37

CONCLUSION.

The Diocesan, The Rt. Rev. Dr. James Olusola Odedeji in one of his powerful sermons said, “ YOU DON'T MANAGE THE DEVIL, YOU DAMAGE THE DEVIL.” May we begin to live our lives from now as if the devil does not exist. Amen. THE ESSENCE OF LENT BY THE VEN GBENGA ONIYE

TEXT: Isaiah 58:6-11; Leviticus 23: 27-32; Hebrews 9:7-9

LENT

The season or period of forty (40) days in preparatory to Easter is referred to as lent in the Christian calendar.

It is a season of penitence, devotion, sober reflection, enforced with fasting and mourning and almsgiving, revival and prayer. In observing the forty (40) days of lent, the sacrifice of Jesus Christ and His withdrawal into the wilderness is believed to be replicated. It is also a time of intense preparation for catechumens anticipating Easter baptism- the sacrament of admission to the church.

It is always a very solemn religious observance. And since it involves self denial and fasting, it goes together with prayers, it is advisable to abstain from some activities that can be contradictory to this; some of these are social pleasures and ceremonies. The period of lent must be characterized by fasting- abstinence from food, drink, pleasures of life and curtailment of some activities so that there can be enough time to dedicate oneself to prayers.

THREE MAJOR THINGS TO BE DONE DURING LENT

1. FASTING

Fasting, abstinence from food and drink in readiness and determination to seek and see God's face and mercy and to put Him first has its origin in the time of the law. (Lev.16:29-31, 23:27-32). The Hebrews fasted on the Day of Atonement. (Num 27:7). The Day of Atonement is a Hebrew festival instituted by Moses and was held on the 10th day of Tishri, the 7th month in the Hebrew calendar. And the activities on this day were, fasting, abstinence from labor, penitence and sacrifice for sin. This was the day the high priest would enter the holy of holies. (Exodus 30:10; Heb 9:7-9). On the Day of Atonement, the people were told to "afflict their souls" (Lev16).

2. REPENTANCE

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of lent with the age long practice or tradition of the blessing and the imposition of ashes (from palm fronds of the previous Palm Sunday) on the foreheads of worshippers, thus reminding us that we are mortal- of dust that must repent.

One of the things lent is meant to achieve is repentance and forgiveness of sin. It is a time when awareness is created to remind everyone that sin is the only thing that separated us from God.

Repentance during lent, therefore should be a regretful acknowledgment of sin with a commitment to change. It is a period where we are reminded of the opportunity that Christ provided through what He did for us on the cross. Fasting prepares the heart by humility. "I humbled my soul with fasting" (Psalm 35:13). Therefore, a very good way to express repentance and sorrow for the sins committed is through Fasting. (Jonah 3:3-10).

3. REVIVAL

Another thing to achieve during the period of Lent is spiritual revival of the soul. Fasting puts down the flesh and increases our spiritual capacity, strength and awareness. "But they that wait on the Lord shall renew their strength". (Isaiah 40:31). It also an act which provides and add powerful spiritual factors which helps in obtaining special favor from God in crucial times. (Ezra 8:21-23).

The period of lent is seen as an opportunity to petition God for important things. A good example is the account in the book of Esther when Esther asked Modecai to "go gather together all the Jews who are in Susa, and fast for me. Do not eat or drink for three days, night or day. I and my attendants will fast as you do". (Esther 4:16). Therefore, the Jews and the Christians have on many occasions fasted to overcome particularly difficult trials and sought God's favor.

There are also certain evil propensities, in some persons, which pampering the flesh tends to nourish and strengthen, but self denial and fasting accompanied with prayers are the means to destroy them. Therefore, in order to experience the miraculous deeds of God and to cast out devils in obstinate and dreadful cases, faith and fasting with prayers are necessary; hence Jesus said "Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting". (Matt 17:19-21). The prayer made in the energy of the flesh cannot reach the throne of Grace. This is why we are told to pray always "With all prayer and supplication in the spirit". (Ephesians 6:18).

Fasting helps us become more focused on the Lord. We can better receive His guidance when we fast. Jehoshaphat is an example of this in the bible. He was alarmed, and He also gave orders that everyone should observe a fast (2Chronicles 20:3). During lent, we have an opportunity to seek courage as well. The fast of Esther and her people (Esther 4:16) was attended with earnest supplications so that the Most High would intervene on their behalf.

CONCLUSION

Lenten season remains a period for powerful spiritual experience, a time for discipline and rediscovery of oneself in the light of God's word and holiness, a good time to mend habits to be mended, to forgive and be forgiven, to reconcile to God and with others, and also to reach higher spiritual realm in prayer and meditation.

May we fast most truly and profitably by feeding in prayer on God's spirit, finding God and living in His will and favor, and rededicating ourselves for God's work, and also be more prepared and ready for the tempter and temptations as season succeeds to season in Jesus name. Amen!

DAY 1. WEDNESDAY, 17th FEBRUARY, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of Personal Sins.All forms of un-forgiveness, bearing of grudges, envy, offenses, pride, laziness, indolence, falsehood, lying, hypocrisy, deceit, craftiness and greed.

“He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and

forsaketh them shall have mercy.” Proverbs 28:13

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9

2. Father, as from now let your will prevail in my life. I dedicate my life to you forever.

“Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.” Luke 22:42

B. CARDINAL AND SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS

1. Father, let the spirit of Holiness descend a fresh on me and declare my sonship.

Roman 1:4. “and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.”

2. Father, release fresh Grace and peace to be daily. *“Roman 1:7.To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be his holy people: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ.*

3. Father, let my daily life be a testimony of faith and example to others *“Romans 1:8 “First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world”.*

4. Father, help me to prayer without ceasing.

Romans 1:9 “God, whom I serve in my spirit in preaching the gospel of his Son, is my witness how constantly I remember you”

5. Father, open the flood gate of heaven and let it rain on me this Lenten season.

“And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing.” Ezekiel 34:26

C. TIME ALONE WITH GOD/ DECLARATION OF ROMANS 8:28-39-10MINUTES

Matthew 6:6 “ But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou art shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly”.

D. CLOSING WITH THANKSGIVING

I John 5:14-15 “*And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.*”

DAY 2. THURSDAY, 18th FEBRUARY, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of ancestral and family sins.....Idolatrous practices, demon worship, idolatrous festivals, dance and songs, tribal/incision marks, blood/human sacrifices, idolatrous priesthood, consulting with sorcerers, witchcraft, all forms of occult practices.

“Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.” Psalm 51:5

2. Father, please use me for your glory. ***“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.” Ephesians 2:10***

B. CARDINAL AND SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS

1. Father, let all my journeys in life be prosperous. Rom. 1:10.... ***“in my prayers at all times; and I pray that now at last by God’s will the way may be opened for me to come to you”.***
2. Father, connect me with people that will bring spiritual benefits to my life. Let me bring spiritual benefits to other too. Rom 1:11 ***“long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong”***

Psalm 66:19 “But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer.

DAY 3.

FRIDAY, 19th FEBRUARY, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of the sins of the church – Prayerlessness – Low Biblical knowledge, understanding and application-Scriptural indolence leading to carnal interpretation of scriptures-Carnality among Christians.
(1 Corinthians 2:11-16, 3:1-3)-

“I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars: And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.

Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.” Revelation 2: 2-5.

2. Father, please make me your Temple. *“What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?” 1 Corinthians 6:19.*

B. CARDINAL AND SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS

Furthermore, just as they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, so God gave them over to a depraved mind, so that they do what ought not to be done”.*
3. Father in the name of Jesus this year 2021, I reject tribulation and anguish. I receive glory, honour and peace *“Rom. 2:9-10. “Tribulations and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first and also of the Gentile. But glory, honour and peace to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile”*
4. Father make me a doer of your word. *“Rom. 2:13 “For not the hearers of the law are just before God , but the doers of the law shall be justified”.*

DAY 4. SATURDAY, 20th FEBRUARY, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of the sins of Lagos state. Promotion of idolatrous practices under the pretense of culture, oppression of the poor & the weak, wickedness of some agents of state in carrying out their duties, extortion of money from the public.

“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.” Acts 3:19.

2. Father, we dedicate Lagos state government to you. Let righteousness and peace prevail forever in this state. ***“For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.” Revelation 14:17.***

B. CARDINAL AND SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS

1. Father, I pray that my conscience will never die. Keep my heart circumcised oh Lord.
Rom. 2:15, 29. ***“Which show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts, the meanwhile accusing or else excusing one another; but he is a Jew, which is one inwardly and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.”***
2. Father, help me never to drag your name that you have put upon me in the mud.
“..Rom. 2:24-25 “For the name of God is blasphemed among Gentiles through you, as it is written; for circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision”
3. Father, let Your word be ever true in my life. Let your promises be yes and Amen in my life, family and business. ***“.. DAY 5. MONDAY, 22ND FEBRUARY, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of the sins of Nigeria –Hypocritical rejection of godliness and righteousness-Culture of entitlement-Laziness and “get rich quick” syndrome-Discrimination: tribalism, nepotism, sectionalism, suppression of women-Corruption and unethical practices, election rigging, stealing of public funds, giving undue advantage to foreigners to the detriment of Nigeria.

“Yea, all Israel have transgressed thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against him.” Daniel 9:11. (Daniel 9: 3-19.)

2. Father in your name we enthrone righteousness in every sphere of our national life.

“Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people.” Proverbs 14:38

B. CARDINAL AND SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS

1. Father, show me the way of peace” Rom. 3:16-17.”*Destrcution and misery are in their ways; and the way of peace have they not known”*

1. Repent of Personal Sins.All forms of un-forgiveness, bearing of grudges, envy, offenses, pride, laziness, indolence, falsehood, lying, hypocrisy, deceit, craftiness, greed, stealing and cheating, gossip, slander, idolatry, hero worship, Self-promotion, seeking the praise of men, rebellion, disobedience, not submitting to one's spouse, unrighteous parenting, unfaithfulness, betrayals, unfulfilled promises, selfish ambition, tribalism, sectionalism, denominationalism, favoritism, tribalism, all forms of discrimination.
“He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.” Proverbs 28:13
“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9
2. Father, lead me in the way of holiness. ***“And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.” Isaiah 35:8***

DAY 7. WEDNESDAY, 24TH FEBRUARY, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of ancestral and family sins.....Idolatrous practices, demon worship, idolatrous festivals, dance and songs, tribal/incision marks, blood/human sacrifices, idolatrous priesthood, consulting with sorcerers, witchcraft, all forms of occult practices. Sins against the Gospel: Rejection of the gospel, killing and persecution of missionaries/ Messengers of God, burning Bibles and scriptural materials, burning churches. Sexual sins: Adultery, fornication, bestiality, incest, pornography, masturbation, homosexuality, prostitution. *“Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.” Psalm 51:5*
2. Father, I invite you to be the Lord over my family. *“Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named.” Ephesians 3:15*

B. CARDINAL AND SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS

1. Father, help me to walk in newness of your life. Rom. 6:4. *“Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life”*
2. Father, destroy the fear and dominion of death in my life...”Rom. 6:9 *“Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more, death hath no more dominion over him”*

DAY 37. WEDNESDAY, 31ST MARCH, 2021

4. I shut the mouth of evil men against my destiny .Rom. 3:19. ***“Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God”.***

DAY 38. THURSDAY, 1ST APRIL, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

1. Repent of the sins of the church – Prayerlessness – Low Biblical knowledge, understanding and application-Scriptural indolence leading to carnal interpretation of scriptures-Carnality among Christians (1 Corinthians 2:11-16, 3:1-3)-Covetousness – Disunity–Individualism –Slander-Gossips –Bitterness –Murmuring-Complaining-Malice-Quarreling.

“I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars: And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted. 2. 4. Father, give me superior sensitivity to spiritual things so I can live perpetual in victory ... 1Cor. 2:15. *“But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man”.*

DAY 39. FRIDAY, 2ND APRIL, 2021

A. PRAYER FOR FORGIVENESS AND DEDICATION TO GOD.

- 1) Repent of the sins of Lagos state. Promotion of idolatrous practices (using government funds) under the pretense of culture, oppression of the poor & the weak, wickedness of agents of state in carrying out their duties, extortion of money from the public, embezzlement of public funds,
“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.” Acts 3:19
