Post Communion Sentence

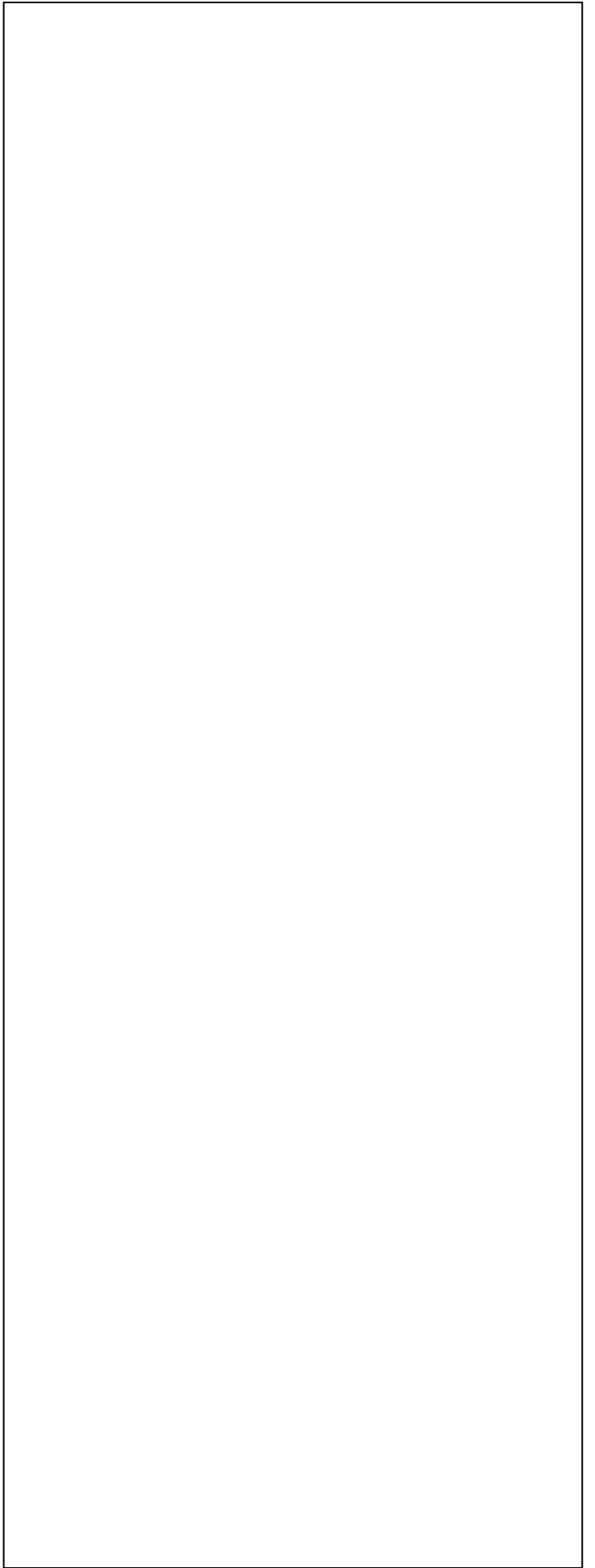
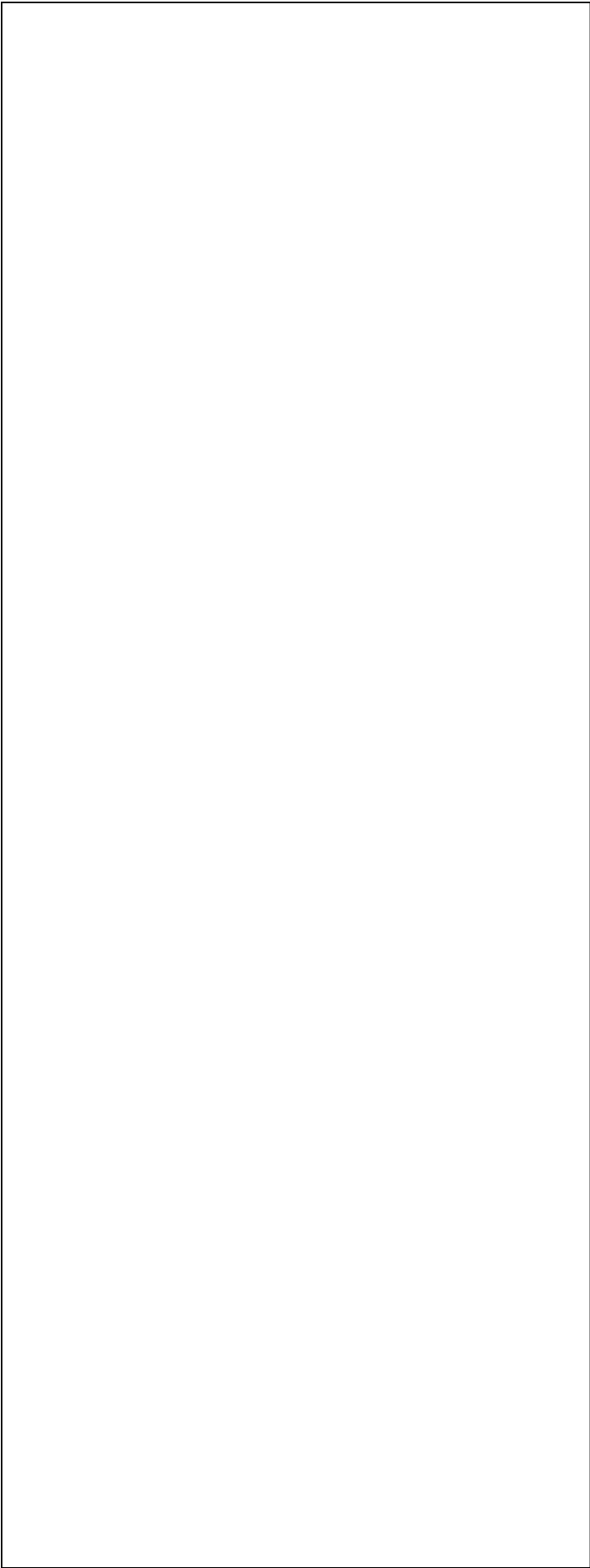

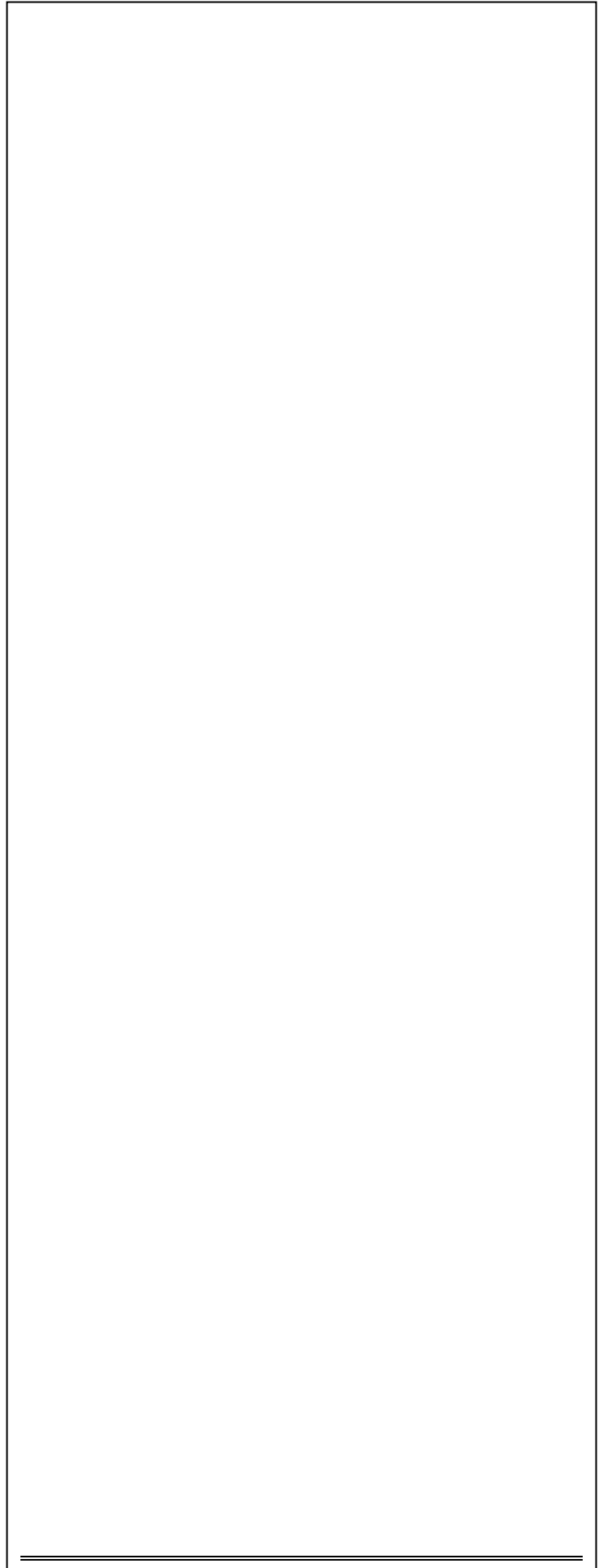
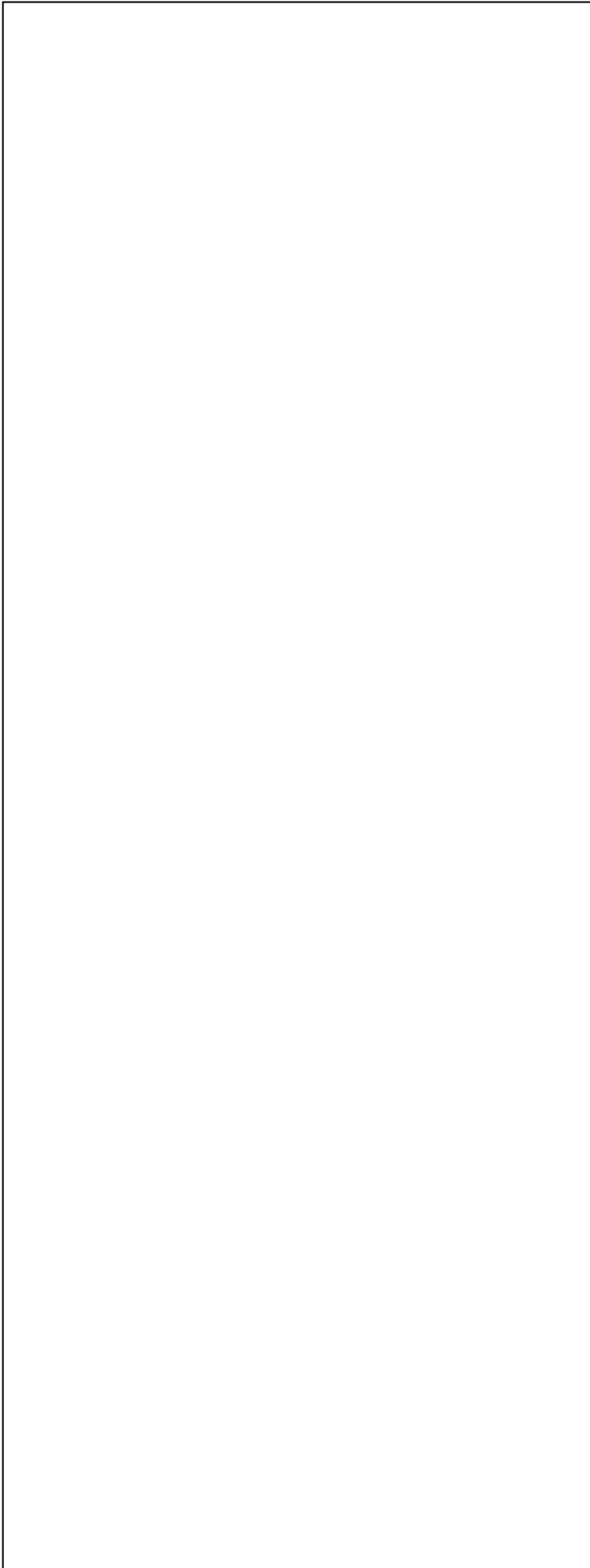
PROCESSIONAL HYMN: CONH 284

That leads me to the Lamb. Amen

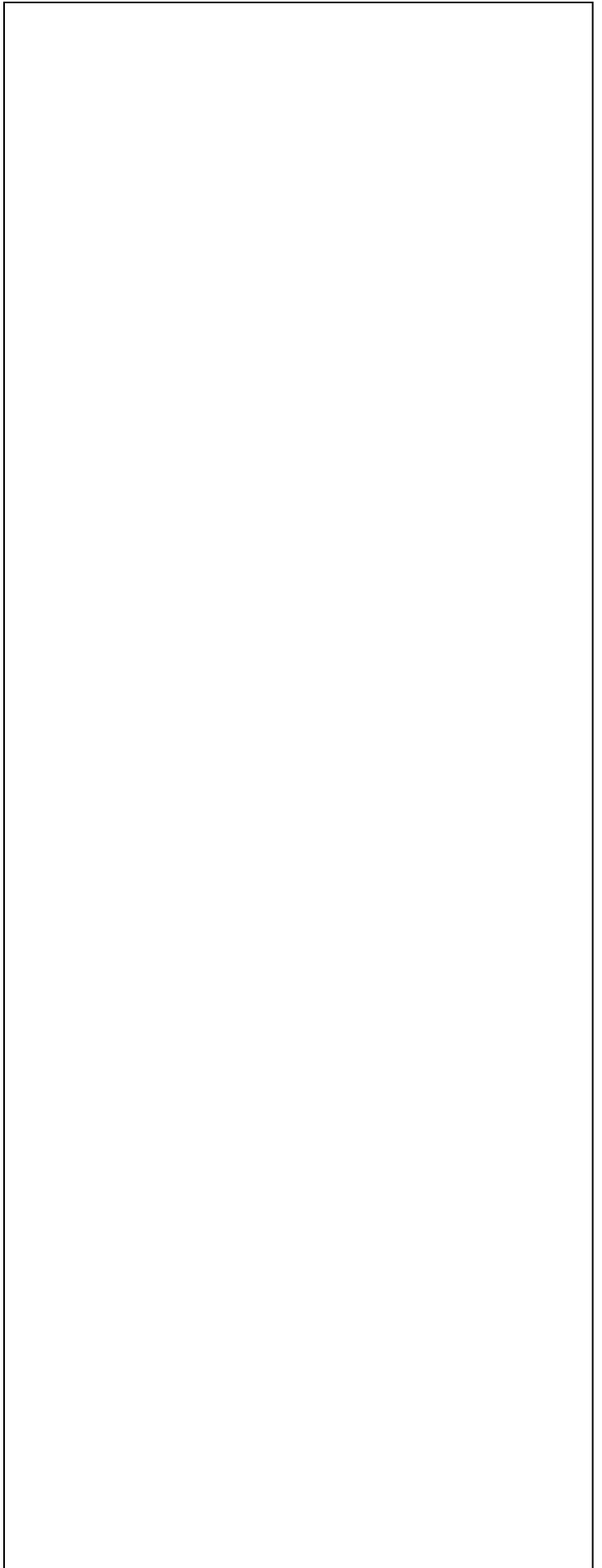
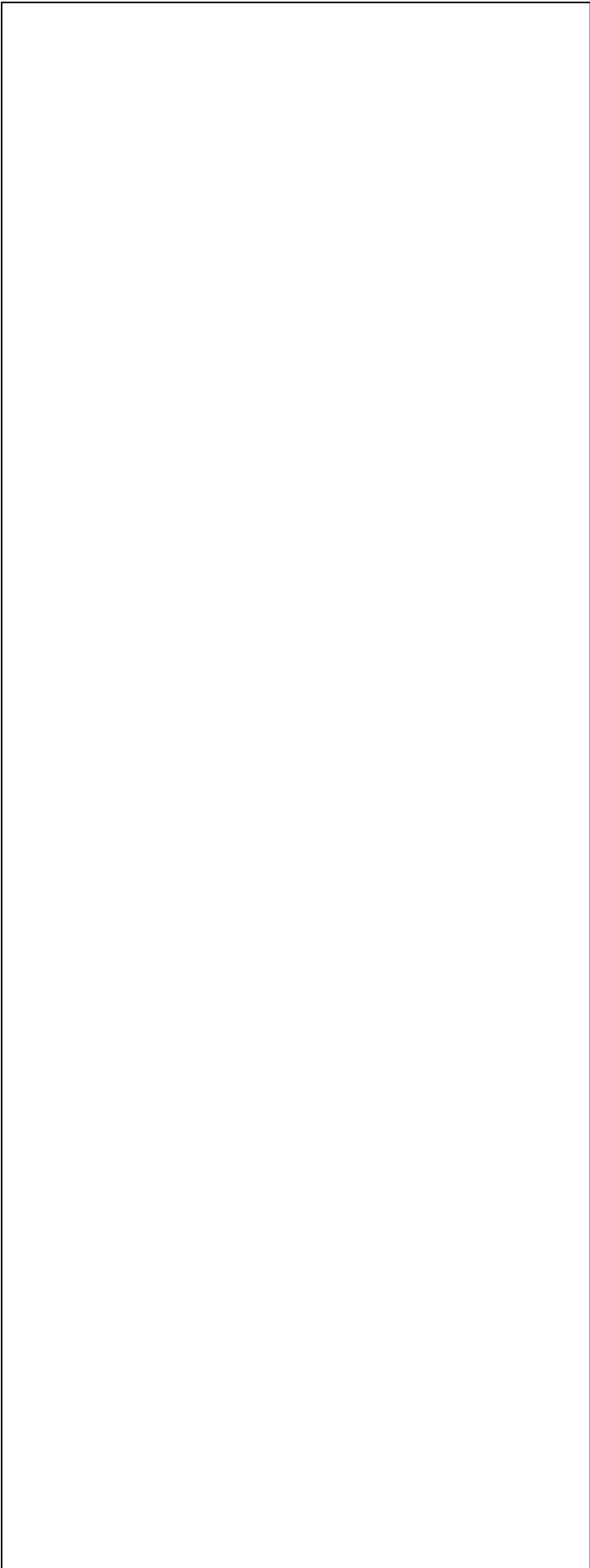
GRADUAL HYMN - CONH 828
