5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 16TH MAY, 2021

THEME: THE DIVIDENDS OF GODLY

PERSISTENCE

READING: PSALM 97; II KINGS 2:1-15,

EPHESIANS 4:1-13; JOHN 16:12-24

In simple words, persistence means the attitude and personality trait of working hard and trying again and again until complete success is achieved. Persistence is defined as, "continue firmly or obstinately in an opinion or a course of action in spite of difficulty, opposition, or failure." It is derived from, "steadfastly; to stand." To persist is to continue your journey towards greatness despite internal weaknesses and external distractions.

In life, there are many things to discourage us. Godly persistence is born out of unyielding trust in God that He will surely answer irrespective of how long. It is a popular saying that winners never quit, quitters never win.

From our text-2 Kings 2:1-15, we see the magnitude of power in being persistent as well as the blessings in it. Elisha knew that his master was going to leave him (vv. 1, 3, 5), and he wanted to be with him to the very end, listen to his counsel and learn from him. While Elijah wanted Elisha to tarry behind and let him go on alone, but this was merely a test of Elisha's devotion but He promised, "I will follow you" (2 kings 2:2), and he kept that promise. The end of the story is quite amazing. Elisha got what he wanted by being persistent.

Please note:

- 1. Being Persistent is all about being determined-2 King 2: 2- Elijah said to Elijah, 'Stay here' the Lord Has sent me to Bethel' But Elisha said, as surely as the Lord lives and you live, I will not leave you' so they went down to Bethel.
- 2. Being Persistent is all about ignoring obstacles to pursue your dream.
- **3.** Being Persistent is all about ardent focus in the midst of distractions
- 4. Being Persistent is a decision to pursue one thing with One's heart and mind.
- 5. Being Persistent is seeing problems and daring them to achieve success.

- 6. Being persistent is being enduring and persevering
- 7. Being persistent is 'keep pushing until something happens'
- 8. Persistency believes all things are possible
- persistency tells you, 'you need to try more';a little more effort will give you the success'

THE DIVIDEND OF PERSISTENCE

1. Success is guaranteed- when a man is persistent, he does not accept failure. Like the story in Luke 18:1-7 -The widow continued to persuade the judge to assist her. There might have been many things the judge said which were sufficient to discourage her from returning to him yet she did not succumb. She persisted in her visits and cries for justice until she got the attention of the judge on her case.

There is no problem in life without expiry date. The faint in the spirit cannot get anything significant from life. They gave up at the point when they were so close to their blessings. Being persistent guarantees success in life.

2. It empowers one above all limitations-2 kings 2:3-one would think Elisha would easily be discouraged when the company of other prophets came to despise him. Yet, he shunned them and continued his journey. When one is determined, power to overcome all challenges is generated.

It brings stability and improvement-look at the testimony about Abraham in Romans 4:20 'He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God' He was never moved by his circumstance, he kept worshipping God until God answered him. Stability of life does come from determination never to give up, no matter the situation. Apart from this, when you continue to do a thing again and again, you become perfect at it. A man who wants to develop a good praying life must be ready to pray over and over again. By this, he gets to a stage where praying becomes part of him.

1. Persistence is a very important trait to develop in life because it is intimately interlinked with one's own personal development and self-improvement. You will only get better in life by failing at things, learning from those experiences and moving on

- 3. It makes one to thrive in the midst of discouragement. The Christian race is not a sprint but a marathon. We are going to face a lot of discouragements, like Elisha, we need to be resolute in order to thrive in the midst of this. Some people conclude that their miracle is taking too long to come; they become impatient and begin to look for alternative that will not give them the kind of joy they desire. Don't be like such people but rather keep your hope alive.

Beloved, try and read the story in **Luke 11:5-9**, People often give up because a request is "repeated." The requester cannot allow himself to become discouraged merely because his first or second request is denied. He must be persistent. The Greek word translated as "persistence" means "shameless," suggesting freedom from the bashfulness that would stop a person from asking a second time. Knocking once does not indicate perseverance, but "continued" knocking does.

God often answers us after long and persevering requests. He hears prayers and grants blessings long after they appear to be unanswered or withheld. He does not promise to give blessings immediately. He promises only that He will do it according to His will and plan. Although He promises to answer the prayer of the faithful, often He requires us to wait a long time to try our faith. He may allow us to persevere for months or years, until we are completely dependent on Him, until we see that there is no other way to receive the blessing, and until we are prepared to receive it. Until Next Week, Keep the hope alive.
