5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 23rd MAY, 2021

THEME: EMPOWERED TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THE WORLD

READING: PSALM 130; JOEL 2:28-32, ACTS 2:1-

21; JOHN 20:19-31.

In the Christian church Pentecost is celebrated as Anniversary of the coming of the Holy Spirit. When Jesus was about to ascend, he instructed his disciples to remain in Jerusalem until they would receive power from on high (Acts 1:4-5, 8; Luke 24:49). As a group of 120 were praying in an upper room in Jerusalem fifty days after his death, the Holy Spirit descended upon them with the sound of a great wind and with tongues of fire which settled upon each of them. They began to speak in other languages and to preach boldly in the name of Christ, with the result that three thousand were converted. This tremendous manifestation of divine power marked the beginning of the church, which has ever since regarded Pentecost as its birthday.

It is important to note that speaking in diverse tongues at Pentecost was more of a sign to unbelievers while the real promised power was demonstrated in the great sermon that resulted in the monumental number of converts.

In this Pentecost edition of our Thought for The Week, we want to see briefly how this power should impact our lives, the Church and our world.

The power to will:

Psalm 110:3 - Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power....

Many preachers and scholars have repeatedly submitted that Pentecost is not just about speaking in tongues but about Empowerment to Impact the World with the blessedness of the Gospel of Christ.

This is simply what Jesus meant when He said But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. (Acts 1:8). The Pentecostal Power which is the power of the Holy Spirit breaks in the life of a Christian the force of inertia that prevents him from preaching the Gospel and replaces it with the consuming zeal that burns in his soul like fire fire that cannot be quenched.

The power to do:

Acts 2:40-41; Peter under the power of the Holy Spirit preached and 3000 men were converted. Apostle Paul taught in his Epistle to the Phillippians that it is God that worketh in you (us) both to will and to do of his good pleasure (Phil.2:13). Our empowerment to impact the world should never stop at the level of willing but moved to the level of doing which gives opportunity for practical demonstration of the Holy Spirit's power to change our world for better.

The power to please:

So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. 9. But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.

10 And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you (Rom 8:8-11, NKJV).

Here lies the crux of today's theme and message – Empowered to Make a Difference in the World. The purpose of Pentecostal empowerment cannot be achieved without Christian soldiers who live in conformity with the right definition of spirituality – a heart stayed on God. Living a life that pleases God is a synonym for Character Evangelism, without which the Gospel will be hindered.

Now, what should you do with the Holy Spirit's power in you?

Bring the three strands of your empowerment – power to will, power to do and power to please – to work in concert to empower the Church of God which is God's own machinery to reach out to the world for global impacts. What are we saying here? You will empower the Church:

Spiritually like Peter

Acts 2:40-44; And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation."

- 41 Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.
- 42 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread and in prayers.
- 43 Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles.

Every believer is a beneficiary of the prophecy- Joel 2:28 - 29, as fulfilled on the day of Pentecost- Act.2:1- 13 and is empowered as prophet, priest and king to battle against the world, the flesh and the devil.

Let us go forth in the power of the Holy Spirit and make a difference in the world!
