5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 13TH JUNE, 2021

THEME: NEW LIFE, NEW LIVING

READING: PSALM 71:16-24; DEUTERONOMY

6:17-25; ROMANS 6:3-11; JOHN 15:5-

11;

Introduction: The concept of the New Life in Christ Jesus is a foundational gospel truth. It is the beginning of all things about the kingdom life. It is the process of new birth that brings about the new life, the new life can then bring about the new living. It is the process of this new life that is referred to as being BORN AGAIN. To put it succinctly, The Bible teaches us that man's heart and soul, his entire being is so tainted by the indwelling presence of evil, that there is nothing we can do to remedy or fix the situation. There is no meeting, no method, no modification of behaviour, no meditation, no medication, no magic and, no mere flexing our will power that can fix our broken lives. Our lives must be discarded, put aside, left in the past and we must exchange them for new lives, we must have a new birth, we must be regenerated by Author of all life. Jesus made this process of new birth clear in his conversation with Nicodemus as we have it in John chapter 3. The concept of new life rings out from many pages of Scripture but nowhere is it more prevalent than in the Gospel of John and nowhere do we see such an explanation of it than in John chapter 3. Note that John by the help of the God's spirit made it clear that:

- i. The Gospel of Jesus Christ was about far more than living according to some set standards, it began with new life and without that new life, no amount of religion, knowledge, or morality would do you any good.
- ii. This new life come through belief, not through heritage. No man can by inheritance receive the new life.

A closer look at Nicodemus

The life of Nicodemus depicts the life of a lot of people in the Church today who are members of the church but have not yet experienced the new birth that brings about the new life.

- In Nicodemus we see the story of every "good" person who has tried to come to God in their own strength
- In Nicodemus we see regular church members who are active in their church, respected in their community, morally better than others and are on their way to hell with an unregenerate heart.

- But in Nicodemus we don't just see good church members, we see church leaders and pastors who have spent much of their lives studying the Scriptures, who have spiritual responsibilities and who are looked up to as examples of the faith yet they are no more able to get into the Kingdom of God than a corpse is able to dig his way out of the grave.
- Certainly John wanted the Church to see an example of the absence of spiritual life in a person who outwardly appeared to have all the decorations of righteousness. Paul in his writing to Timothy says, they have a form of godliness, but deny its power (2 Timothy 3:5).

Today we have substituted all kinds of cosmetic changes for true heart change. People want to pursue new and better spiritual gifts. They are told to recover ancient devotional techniques. They try to beef up on a particular doctrinal system, as if more correct facts will do the trick in itself. They tend to show audacious, mountain-moving faith in prayer filled with shouting. They want to get radically committed to the Great Commission. These things all have their place, but all we are doing is piling superficial changes onto a heart that doesn't really love God. None of those things can produce love for God. Only the gospel can! Jesus told Nicodemus what seemed impossible and Nicodemus asked the question everyone who will experience the new life must ask. The Gospel must lead people to ask this all important question. It's likely that Nicodemus understood that Jesus was not speaking literally, yet he did not understand how this new life could be his. Nicodemus had a sincere desire to know how this new birth could actually take place. Jesus' explains that the new birth is "of water and the Spirit"

The Process of the New Birth: Just as we can't give birth to ourselves physically, we can't accomplish this spiritual birth by ourselves, either. This new life is received as you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead for your justification. "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation" (Romans 10: 9-10). We become born again when we respond to God's offer of forgiveness and eternal life through Jesus Christ.

The New Birth

1. New Life, not new Religion: Nicodemus did not require a new religion, he needed a new life. The life of the spirit. He was physically alive but spiritually dead. Full of religious activities without the knowledge of God (Roman 10:1-2). So the new birth brings a new life and not a new religion. It brings the man back to his source- God, the author of life. The new life is not coming to church, rather it is fully returning to God

- 2. Experiencing the Supernatural, not affirming it:
 Nicodemus came to Jesus affirming all His good virtues. But Jesus' response shows that Jesus was not interested in the affirmation but in the reformation and regeneration of his heart. Jesus addressed what was missing. It is not enough that you affirm the acts of God, but have you experienced it? Have you been to Jesus for the cleansing power? Are you washed in the blood of the lamb? Until you experience this, your affirmations will get you nowhere. As Jesus said to Nicodemus, He is saying to you, YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN.
- 3. New creation, not improving the old one: The new birth produces a totally new man. This was well captured in the writing of Paul in 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new". The new birth is not improving the old life, but God gives a new life powered by His spirit. Don't try working on your old life, there is new life in God for you. After the new birth, our regeneration is so complete it can be described as nothing less than a totally new life in the spirit.

Conclusion: A sinful life is a self-centred rather than God centred life. "I" is at the centre of sin and when we focus on ourselves we ignore God and live in rebellion against God's will and kingdom. At New birth, our old life is replaced by a new life that enables us to live before God in righteousness and purity. Our desires becomes the accomplishment of God's will rather than the realization of our will. This is much more than tweaking our lives by improving our speech and attending worship regularly. The passing of the old is a fundamental change in our lives. Jesus didn't die to make us "good", He died and rose again so that we may have new lives. New life powered by His spirit. This is when we begin to live the new life that God gave us through the death and resurrection of Jesus.
