INTRODUCTION

The phrase "Sons of God" appears in the New Testament as a name for people who are in a covenant relationship with God. This exact phrase never appears with the same meaning in the Old Testament, although the idea is implied. For example, God referred to the scattered children of Israel whom He promised to gather again, as His sons and daughters (Isa 43:6; Isa 45:11)

The classic New Testament passage where this occurs is in Romans 8:12-19. The apostle Paul encouraged the Christians in Rome to live "not according to the flesh, but by the spirit, because those who are led by the spirit of God those are sons of God (Romans 8:14)

The process is described as one of adoption, by which the believer becomes a child of God, and thus an heir of God, a joint heir with Christ (Gal 4:5; Heb 2:10; 12:7) other passages use the phrase "children of God" with the same basic meaning (John 1:12; Phil 2:15; 1John 3:1-2)

How and why are Christians called the children of God?

Faith has always been the mark of a disciple of Jesus, Jesus said "everything is possible for him who believes" (Mark 9:23).

What then is Faith?

Faith is obedient action in response to what God has said. True faith is expressed in Obedience and action in response to Hearing God's word (voice)

According to Hebrews 11:1; Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. Faith means having trust, assurance or confidence in another person or that person's word. Having faith in God involves an exchange of self trust for God trust, we stop trusting ourselves and trust Him, we abandon reliance on our limited source of knowledge and start receiving from His unlimited source. All knowledge that comes to natural man comes to him through the five senses- seeing, hearing, tasting, smelling and feeling. This is limited knowledge, described as man's wisdom.

Also, there is revelation knowledge and this knowledge isn't based on the five senses nor on natural reasoning but on an alternative source- the truth of the word of God. It is received through man's spirit and is described as "Gods wisdom" we live by faith and not by sight (2Cor 5:7)

Beloved, the basis of having faith in God is in 3 important realities;

- He cannot change (Mal 3:6) see also James 1:17
- He cannot fail (Job 42:2) see also 1 Chronicles 28:20
- He cannot lie (Num 23:19)

How Faith works

The principle of faith (Rom 3:27) is to operate in our lives continually, no matter what the circumstances (see 2Cor 5:7; James 1:5-6).

The crisis or trial of our Faith

This is the period of testing, everything happening around us appears contrary to what God has said and there seems to be no natural evidence to our believing. At this point, our faith rests completely on God's work (what He has spoken to us) "In this you shall greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that your faith, of greater worth than gold which perishes even though refined by fire may be probed genuine and may result in praise, glory and honour when Jesus Christ is revealed" 1Peter 1:6-7.
