THEME: THE FUTILITY OF WORLDLINESS READINGS: PSALM 119:33-48; HOSEA 11:1-9; 1JOHN 2:8-17; MARK 12:28-34

1John 2:15-17

"Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever."

Good morning Church of the Living God in AVMCC. Thank you for staying on this page to read this meditation. May God bless your heart as you receive instructions and revelations in Jesus name. Amen. In clear terms, worldliness is everything that opposes godliness. Worldliness embraces that which is devilish. It has to do with matters that are obstacles to the service of God, and in many cases, lure men away from interest in Christ altogether. Being like the world was not God's intention right from the start. Being like Him was the design. That was why He created us in His image. Godliness is a journey back to being what God intended when He made man and we have to keep at it, all our lifetime. Our yearning must be to keep being more and more like Him on a daily basis. Let me say this bodly; IF A MAN IS NOT GODLY (LIKE GOD), HE CAN'T BE IN GOD'S HEAVEN. Worldliness ends in futility (HELL). John 15:5 says, in separating ourselves from God, we can do nothing. The most comforting testimony about us is to be referred to as godly.

This second half of 2021, God is pointing us to something deep and essential. God is calling us to separate ourselves from the world and be wholly identified with him. Ideally, the call to salvation is no different from the call to godliness. Once someone becomes born into the Kingdom of God, he is a new creature. The call always demand for 'separation'. Separation from worldliness and all that opposes holiness. The call always demand for 'movement'. Movement towards being more like God. If we look around us today, we'll see how people are frantically veering off God! It's alarming! The social media is full of display of vanity and perversion. Sadly, Churches are not exempted.

Abraham is pictured as **a friend of God** in Genesis 18. "And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God (James 2:23). In Genesis 19, Lot is pictured as **a friend of the world**. James 4:4-5 "Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that **friendship with the world is enmity with God?** Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God"

Scripture also teaches that the Corinthian believers were worldly. In 1 Corinthians 3:1, Paul called them carnal or worldly. Throughout the Corinthian books their worldliness is clearly displayed. In 1 Corinthians 1, they were separating into factions, as they idolized their teachers. In 1 Corinthians 5, a man is sleeping with his father's wife. In 1 Corinthians 6, they were suing one another. In 1 Corinthians 14, they were abusing spiritual gifts. In 2 Corinthians, they challenged Paul's apostleship, even though he started the church. Consider what he said to them in 2 Corinthians 6:14, 15-17; Do not be yoked unbelievers. For together with what righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness... Therefore come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."

- 1. No desire to commune with Christ or no joy of salvation anymore
- 2. When you constantly live in fear of death. It's a sign of separation from God
- 3. Prayer and Sermon times are boring to you or you often sleep off.

- 5. Dislike for prayer time or wandering off during prayers
- 6. You dislike Christians who seem to be enjoying their relationship with God
- 7. You get angry when holiness is preached.
- 8. Dwindling desire to fellowship with the people of God.
- 9. You always have an alternative to being in Church.
- 10. Paying attention to worldly music, dressing and movies.
- 11. No real concern for the lost or soul-wining
- 12. Obedience to God's Word is "optional"
- 13. You seek spiritualists and witchcraft for solutions
- 14. You easily pick and use worldly slangs and languages.

There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death (Proverbs 14:12). Worldliness leads to eternal damnation. Titus 2: 11-14 adds "For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works"

CONCLUSION

Remember that all the devil was flaunting before Jesus in Matthew Chapter Four was worldliness. The futility of worldly pursuits bring no lasting material gain and sadly, no spiritual gain. God has given us the right to make our own choices but the counsel of God is, fear God and love Him with all your heart, mind, soul and strength and you will have no space for the devil and his tricks of worldliness. Let us close with this scripture. Mark 8:36-38 "For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? For whoever is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."
