THEME: THE RICHES OF CHRIST'S GRACE READINGS: PSALM 119:49-64; EZEKIEL 36-24-28; GALATIANS 5:16-26; LUKE 6:27-38

#### INTRODUCTION

Grace combines two ideas; it is first an attitude or disposition of goodwill and favour and second this goodwill is given freely and unconditionally.

And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, in order that in the coming ages He might show the incomparable riches of His grace, expressed in His kindness towards us in Christ Jesus (Eph 2:7)

- 1. Jesus is full of grace and truth John 1:14 the word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.
- 2. We have received grace upon grace.
- 3. We have been redeemed through the riches of His grace using the costly currency of His blood.

## The Riches of God's grace.

Ephesians 2:4-9

"But God who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved) and raised us up together and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of his grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith and that not by yourselves; it is the gift of God not of works lest

Paul took time to reflect on our past failures and God's present redemption. He insists that God not only raised Jesus up and set Him in heavenly places above all authority (Eph 1:20,21) but He did the same for us (Eph 2:4-6)

Therefore we must identify with Christ in life, death, resurrection and Ascension.

# What must we do to experience some kind of authority in Christ?

- 1. Renew your perspective (Col 3:1-3) we must think like God thinks, we must see ourselves as He does and fix our minds on Him. We must base our life on this position rather than our experience.
- 2. Release your past (Gal 2:20) we must let go of old patterns we will never lead in any empowering way if we hold on to our old self, our old baggage, our old citizenship we must die to the past.
- 3. Remember your purpose (Eph 1:3-12) we drift when we lose sight of why God left us on earth, our goal is to participate in Gods redemptive plan for the world. If we embrace purpose we gain power.

#### **Conclusion**

The grace of God was supremely revealed and given in the person and work of Jesus Christ. Jesus was not only the beneficiary of God's grace (Luke2:40) but was also its embodiment (John1:14) bringing it into humankind for salvation (Titus 2:11) the grace of God revealed in Jesus Christ is applied to human beings for their salvation by the Holy Spirit who is called "the spirit of grace" (Heb 10:29)

The spirit is the one who binds Christ to His people so that they receive forgiveness, adoption to son ship, and newness of life as well as every spiritual gift or grace (Eph 4:7)

The theme of grace is especially prominent in the letters of Paul. He sets grace radically over against the law and the works of the law. (Rom 3:24,28) Paul makes it abundantly clear that's salvation is not something that can be earned it can only be received as a gift of grace (Rom 4:4) Grace however must be accompanied by faith; a person must trust in the mercy and favour of God even while it is undeserved (Rom 4:16; Gal 2:16).
