God’s intended world is the type where peace, love, joy, goodness etc reign. But due to sin, pollution came in and it became the world of sorrow, pain, agony, calamity and wickedness. The coming of Devil to the world marks the beginning of a different world which now becomes a battle field instead of a garden. No wonder the angel says in Revelation 12:10 that woe to the world for the accuser of the brethren has been cast down.

Therefore, to everyone coming to or on planet earth must be rest assured that he’s coming or has come at a time when the battle gets tougher. This is because it is now at the last lapse. The questions we need to ask ourselves are, is there a way of escape for man? Can man still live a life of victory? How can the world of sin and wickedness be overcome?

The story of David and Goliath explains to us how we can have our victory in any battle of life. Please take your time to read the whole story- 1 Samuel 17: 31-54 and let’s engage ourselves with revelations from it.

Facts from this story

1. Before the physical combat, there was Battle Of Words between Goliath and David (vv41-47) Meaning;
 - a. The battles of life are often spiritual, before the physical manifestation of them, there have been some spiritual undertones. Therefore, for victory to be achieved, we must first of all win the battle in the spirit realm. No tree stands without its tap root. The tap roots of many problems are forces of darkness.
 - b. David won the physical battle because he had won the Battle Of Words that came first. This talks about our confession. What do you say when you face battles of life matters? This is a call to faith confession. What you confess is what you possess.
 - c. David faced Goliath in the name of the Lord. We are to face our battles in the name of the Lord, not in our name. it is in the strength of God, we can win the battles of life. Leaving aside God in your battles will surely amount to failure.
 - d. David made use of his own weapon 1 Samuel 17:39. When King Saul gave him his own tunic, he rejected it. He chose to go with the little catapult and five stones. No matter how small what God has given you, be rest assured that it is enough to secure you the expected victory. You don’t need to borrow other people’s weapons to fight your battles. Never underrate that which you have. You have your own mouth to pray, don’t wait for anyone to pray for you. Don’t wait for anyone to fast for you. Make use of that which you have.
 - e. Every battle of life understands the potency of spoken words. Speak the word of God to your situations. That situation will hear you.

2. Both David and Goliath came as representatives of their nations; Goliath stood for Philistine while David was for Israel (1 Sam 17: 4-9). As representatives, they both fought with hope of giving honour to who they represented. This tells us that:
 - a. Everyone in the world is a representative of either God or Satan.
 - b. Whatever that happens to man is either from Satan or from God.
 - c. Any battle against a child of God is a battle against God and any battle against a child of Satan is a battle against Satan
 - d. The battle of life is just between the Kingdom of God and the Devil and man has always been the victim of its outcome.
3. They both consulted their gods for backup. David consulted God while Goliath consulted the gods of the philistines. (see verse 43b against verse 45b.)

Meaning;

 - a. David won the battle because his backup was greater. 1 John 4:4
 - b. Christians have upper hand in any battle of life because He that backs them up is greater than that of the world.

HOW TO USE THE WORD TO SECURE VICTORY FOR YOUR LIFE

1. Know it-this has to do with studying, meditating and memorizing the Word of God. Col 3:16
2. Speak it- having known it, next is to speak it to the situation it addresses. Every word of God addresses one situation or the other. Ability to identify the right word for a situation is important in ensuring victory on that situation. No doctor ever gives wrong medication and expects healing to take place.
3. Believe it- you have to believe the word and have faith in it. Faith in it makes it powerful. Heb 11:6; Matt.21:21-22.
4. Act it- this talks about living it and carefully observing the Word. John 15:5-7

Beloved, some Christians today are in bondage because they lack the understanding of what the word of God can do for them. No wonder God said my people perish for lack of knowledge (Hosea 4:6). We must all return to the practice of the Apostles which is constant meditation of the word of God if really we want to overcome this world of evil, sin and wickedness. The Word has been given to us, let us read it, mark it, study it, memorize it and apply it to our situation. By this, we shall overcome.
