THEME: FOLLOWING GOD COURAGEOUSLY

**READINGS: PSALM 119:17-32; GENESIS 12:1-9,

FOLLOWING MEANS -

COURAGEOUS MEANS -

1. Having or characterized by courage, being brave.
2. Feeling or displaying no fear.

In following God we need to be firm, resolute and determined, deciding in our hearts that no matter what may come our way we will not back down /out from following God- Rom 8: 35-39.

The call of God upon our lives as Christians is such that should/must be answered without reservations. It must not be answered halfheartedly or half measured because with God we cannot afford to be neutral or lukewarm we should either be for Him or not- Josh 24: 15, the God we serve despises lukewarmness, timidity and fear-1Tim 1:7, Rev 3:16, Josh24:15

COURAGE:

Courage is a critical success factor in life struggles and endeavors; there's nothing achieved without courage that is worth celebrating and that is because it is simply ordinary. Every Christian that would be true to himself knows that following and obeying God is the foremost Christian duty that is ironically neglected. And that is because obedience is not an easy task. It takes courage to obey God like Abraham did. God's instruction to Abraham was for him to get out of his country, from his family and from his father's house, to a land that He (God) would show him (Gen.12:1); and this 75-year old man obeyed that "weird" instruction and he, according to v.5, departed as the Lord had spoken to him from Haran to an unknown place that God would show him.

Modernized Christianity would have termed Abraham's courageous obedience as foolishness – taking chances by leaving the known for the unknown at such precarious age. But that is faith – believing in the reality of the unseen, and it takes courage to exercise such come-what-may faith. That Abrahamic courageous faith was commended to in the Scriptures for our example and learning - By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; 10 for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God. (Heb. 11:8-10).

Apart from helping us to exercise the much needed faith in God and in our expectations of God, courage helps in a number of ways to enhance our faith, serve God and live a life that is pleasing unto Him. It takes courage for a man, especially one that has enjoyed the pride of nobility and achievements by whatever definition, to accept one's failure, inadequacies or shortcomings and seek help. Some would rather die in their problems instead of swallowing their pride and seek help. Such persons need to learn from the story of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32) who, after ruining his heritage and reputation, humbled himself and returned home to his father. The story tells of God's readiness to accept as many sinners and backsliders that would be humble and courageous enough to turn to God for help. His father's joyful acceptance of him typifies the readiness of God to joyfully accept as many as turn to Him in repentance.

Apostle Paul in Romans 12:1-8 enunciated some Christian responsibilities that require a good measure of courage. In our overtly secularized world, holiness is seen and treated as scum; the very elect are tempted to conform to worldly standard for avoidance of the criticism and humiliation that ironically attend holy and upright living. Paul had to appeal for Christian's courage to jettison world's standard and embrace holiness as a service unto God. The point is that there is no way we can please God without the courage to dare to be different.

Courage to do it right puts us in right standing with God; this is the reason Apostle Paul in same chapter 12 of his Epistle to the Romans admonished us to use our ministry gifts the right way. The question is how many ministers, priests and pastors in particular, still muster the courage to minister as the Holy Spirit directs and NOT as their congregation or audience and may be their bosses want it. A veritable antidote to fear of persecution is the courage to follow and serve God according to divine standard. Let us wrap up our thought on this theme of courage with the story of a lady who faced severe persecution from her parents for converting to the Christian faith, and eventually died of depression from the misery of parental rejection and attendant hardship. Somehow, her both parents converted to Christianity and were one day asked about the persecution they unleashed on their daughter for converting to same faith they had now embraced; and their answer bears relevance to our theme – Following God Courageously. They said it was doubtful if the Jesus their late daughter accepted was the same Jesus they had embraced because they just couldn't see any persecution that would make them deny Him.
