- Applicants must have good academic performances with evidence through the statement of result signed by the Registrar/appropriate authority of the institution

**2. How to Apply for AVMCC Scholarships**

Each applicant shall submit a typed application letter, not more than two pages. addressed to **"The Chairman, Educational Support Initiative, Archbishop Vining Memorial Church Cathedral, Ikeja, Lagos"** The letter must include the name of the candidate, course of study, year of study, state of origin, and why the candidate believes that he/she should be given the scholarship award. The application letter must be accompanied by:

- Evidence of AVMCC membership of applicant or parent
- Or a letter from the Dean of AVMCC certifying that candidate is a member indicating the Society or ministry he /she or the parent belongs
- Evidence of membership of the Cathedral Youth Vanguard
- Photocopies of SSCE/NECO results and JAMB admission letter for fresh applicants
- A photocopy of the candidate's current school Identity card.
- A letter from the Registrar of the candidate's institution certifying that the candidate is a student of such institution.
- A letter from the candidate's current Head of Department, including correct information of the candidate's biodata, academic profile and CGPA for the last academic semester.

**SUNDAY, 22<sup>ND</sup> AUGUST, 2021**

**THEME: THE CHRISTIAN IN TODAY'S WORLD**

**READINGS: PSALM 119:129-144; EXODUS 3:13-20**

**ROMANS 8:26-30; MATTHEW 10:16-22.**

Reading through our Biblical passages, one common dominator for all Christians in today's world is persecution of their faith in God. Persecution is one of the trademarks of Christianity. Paul says in Phil1:29 that 'For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for him' NIV. This makes it very clear that Christian life is not such that full of honey, joy, progress, comfort etc without having a moment of trials for the sake of Christ. There is no man that would fold his arms and allow enemy to invade his territory. Likewise, Devil cannot afford to watch and allow Christians to have easy ride in this world.

### **POINTS TO NOTE FROM THE PASSAGE: MATTHEW 10:16-22**

1. Persecution Must Be Expected, vv. 16-18, 21-22, 24-25; 2 Tim 3:12

All Christians are sheep sent out in the midst of wolves.

2. Persecution is a Means of Gospel Witness, vv. 18-20.

Tertullian, one of the early fathers of the Church said- 'the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church'

3. Persecution Identifies One with Christ in His Suffering, vv. 24-25.

The most important benefit of persecution is the opportunity to be identified with Christ in His suffering. Thus, persecution for the cause of Christ points to the heart of Christianity which is the suffering of Christ for our sins 1 Peter 3:15-18, Colossians 1:24. As Christ had carried His cross, so also every child of God must carry his or her cross.

4. Persecution makes Christians stronger
5. Persecution can come from anywhere and anybody. vv21-22.
