- Applicants must have good academic performances with evidence through the statement of result signed by the Registrar/appropriate authority of the institution

2. How to Apply for AVMCC Scholarships

Each applicant shall submit a typed application letter, not more than two pages. addressed to **"The Chairman, Educational Support Initiative, Archbishop Vining Memorial Church Cathedral, Ikeja, Lagos"** The letter must include the name of the candidate, course of study, year of study, state of origin, and why the candidate believes that he/she should be given the scholarship award. The application letter must be accompanied by:

- Or a letter from the Dean of AVMCC certifying that candidate is a member indicating the Society or ministry he /she or the parent belongs

Young people must embrace this and fight being ensnared by the unfortunate charade going on out there. God bless every young person in AVMCC and our Diocese in Jesus Name. Strength will not fail you in becoming great in Jesus Name. Amen. We have for meditation the topic; Today's Pain, Tomorrow's Glory.

2. What is Pain?

The International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP) gives the definition of pain as an unpleasant sensory and emotional experience associated with actual or potential tissue damage, or described in terms of such damage. The first usage of the word 'pain' in the Bible was in connection with childbirth in Genesis 3:16. "To the woman He said, 'I will greatly multiply your pain in childbirth. In pain you will bring forth children.....; That speaks to the fact that the pain we experience as a natural part of living in a sin-cursed world will be a thing of the past for those who, through faith in Christ, spend eternity in heaven with Him. John 16: 20-21 rendering of pain in relation to childbirth connotes pain as a process or a tunnel leading to joy; "Very truly I tell you, you will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy. A woman giving birth to a child has pain because her time has come; but when her baby is born she forgets the anguish because of her joy that a child is born into the world". We can stick to not seeing pain as negative but a route.

3. Pain in Positive Light

Paul told us in 2Corinthians 4:17 "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory" Take note of the phrases 'light affliction' and 'weight of glory'. Necessary Pains always lead to Gains. What we suffer is nothing compared to what we'll gain. Pain is usually the pathway to glory. Hebrews 12:2 talked about Jesus, 'looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God'. The motivation for going through pain today is because of the gain, the glory in the future. No pain, No gain. Nothing comes on a platter of gold. Nothing ventured, nothing gained. The salvation we enjoy today was paid for by Jesus Christ. Such sayings like 'No rose without a thorn' or 'No gain without pain' or "No thorns, no crown' are a reminder that in any life situation, we cannot achieve real success without great effort and some kind of sacrifice. So, pain in the context of our meditation is the discomfort or the denial or the discipline or the process or the waiting or the courage or insult or the patience or the affliction or the hunger or the suffering one must pass through to achieve a desired joy-outcome. Hebrews 12:11 says "No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it"

3. Nothing Ventured, Nothing Gained.

Aside from the super example of Jesus Christ, let me give just five brief examples of people in the Bible who went through pain or sacrificed for a greater glory.

- a) Abram left his Country, people and family to follow an unknown God. He left his comfort zone. Are you willing to stop being average and make the move? Genesis 12:1-3; Abraham became the father of many nations Genesis 17:4. Lesson - Break away from your comfort zone
- b) Job had everything going on for him until Satan got permission to alter his good fortune. In all, he didn't curse God. He came out better. God blessed his latter days, He had everything better than initial. He even lived 140 years longer in enjoyment. He saw his children's children to the fourth generation and died full of days. He died fulfilled. Job 42:12-17. Lesson – Be patient in difficult times.
- c) Joseph said to his brothers who had horribly mistreated him, *“But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.”* Genesis 50:20. He was sold into Egyptian slavery by his brothers at age 17. He went through the ordeal faithfully and came out better and greater. Lessons – be faithful to God in your trials. Keep your eyes on the goal
- d) Daniel was so much hated by other Governors in Babylon for his fear of God and wisdom. His haters concluded the only way to humble him is a plot against his faith. They succeeded in getting executive order against praying to any God except to the King Darius. Daniel defied that order and was ready to pay the ultimate price of death. He was put in the Lion's den but God was there. How did that end? Daniel's haters became food for the lions but Daniel prospered, Daniel 6:28. Lesson – Daniel ventured.
- e) Solomon offered a thousand burnt offerings on the altar at Gibeon. That was a lot and not cheap. So much work that he fell asleep afterwards. God appeared in a dream and told him to ask for something. He said wisdom and understanding! God was pleased. He added so much to the request. 1 Kings 3:1-15. Lessons – Go out of your way to beat your own record. You are more than who you currently are. Be impressive in loving God. Discover yourself.

4. Conclusion

The summary of this message is you refusing to be average, irrelevant or inferior by putting in the required efforts for exploits. This would mean denying yourself of current pleasure and gratification. If spiritual height is the goal, denial of flesh and devotion of more time in intimacy with the Holy Spirit and necessary lifestyle adjustments should deliver the result. For our future glorification, we must consistently beat down the flesh and live in the Holy Spirit. Heaven is worth going. Let me leave Matthew 7:13-14 for food for thought; *“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.*
