5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK** **SUNDAY, 3RD OCTOBER, 2021**

THEME: LEARNING FROM THE FATHER'S OF FAITH

READINGS: Psalm 65:1-7; Hebrews 11:1-2, 8-16; Mark 2:1-12.

INTRODUCTION

Fathers of faith were people with flesh and blood like us but who had shown the world how big God is through their faith. By faith, they obtained everlasting reports of life and testimonies that cannot be tarnished. "Faith" is far more than a bare assent to anything revealed and declared by God: it is a firm persuasion of that which is hoped for, because it assures its possessor not only that there are such things, but that through the power and faithfulness of God he shall yet possess them. Faith is an act of believing God's word in order to lay hold of things that are promised and make them real in our lives.

Hebrews 11 tells what God's people did by faith in the Old Testament. It tells of the faith of Abel, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Samuel, Rahab etc. The thing to notice about these heroes is not their personalities, training, or upbringing. We are not told that Abraham was such a super made person. The only thing that made him different from others was his faith.

How did a man like Moses deny himself of worldly pleasures of Pharaoh and preferred to suffer with his own people? It wasn't because Moses was such a moral person. He did it by faith! Without faith, none of these heroes of Hebrews 11 would have lived for God in the ways they did. Through faith, they lived with extra ordinary power of God and gained the salvation the world has ignored. Because of their faith, verse 16 says, "God is not ashamed to be called their God."

Let us learn from their faith;

Abel - faith worshipping (v. 4). The background story is in Gen 4:1-10. Abel was a righteous man because of faith (Matt 23:35). God had revealed to Adam and his descendants the true way of worship, and Abel obeyed God by faith. In fact, his obedience cost him his life. Cain was not a child of God (1 John 3:12) because he did not have faith. He was religious but not righteous. Abel speaks to us today as the first martyr of the faith.

Enoch - faith walking (vv. 5-6). Our faith in God grows as we fellowship with God. We must have both the desire to please Him and the diligence to seek Him. Prayer, meditating on the Word, worship, discipline - all of these help us in our walk with God. Enoch walked with God in the wicked world, before the flood came; he was able to keep his life pure.

Noah - faith working (v. 7). Noah's faith involved the whole person: his mind was warned of God; his heart was moved with fear, and his will acted on what God told him. Since nobody at that time had ever seen a flood (or perhaps even a rainstorm), Noah's actions must have generated a great deal of interest and probably

ridicule as well. Noah's faith influenced his whole family and they were saved. It also condemned the whole world, for his faith revealed their unbelief. Events proved that Noah was right! Jesus used this experience to warn people to be ready for His return (Matt 24:36-42). In Noah's day, the people were involved in innocent everyday activities and completely ignored Noah's witness (2 Peter 2:5).

The patriarchs - faith waiting (vv. 8-22). The emphasis in this section is on the promise of God and His plans for the nation of Israel (Heb 11:9,11,13,17). The nation began with the call of Abraham. God promised Abraham and Sarah a son, but they had to wait twenty five years for the fulfillment of the promise. Their son Isaac became the father of Jacob and Esau, and it was Jacob who really built the nation through the birth of his twelve sons. Joseph saved the nation in the land of Egypt, and Moses would later deliver them from Egypt.

Waiting is, for me, one of the most difficult disciplines of life. Yet true faith is able to wait for the fulfillment of God's purposes in God's time. But, while we are waiting, we must also be obeying. "By faith Abraham . . . obeyed" (Heb 11:8). He obeyed when he did not know where he was going (Heb 11:8-10).

If you look for these heroes of faith in the secular histories of the ancient world, you won't find them. Why is that? Because there is something faith will not do. Faith will not give you fame and fortune as the world reckons them. These heroes of faith were worldly nobodies, but they were great in God's sight. Their faith did not commend them to the world. Many of them were put to death because of their faith. As a rule, their faith earned them the world's contempt. Look at verse 2: "For by it [faith] the people of old received their commendation." What commendation was that? By faith they were commended by God, and it doesn't get any better than that. "Faith is the assurance of things hoped for," begins Hebrews 11. What better to hope for than commendation from God—not just to be forgiven and received by faith, essential as that is, but to really please God with your life. By faith you may be assured even of this.

Faith can do great things in anyone's life. If you live by faith in God, no matter who you are and whatever else is true of you, you can make a difference for God's kingdom. What really matters is not your strengths or weaknesses, your training or lack thereof. By faith you can be a spiritual hero. So, don't be ashamed of exercising faith in your daily life. Our faith grows each time we put it into practice.

In the world, Seeing is Believing, but to God, Believing is Seeing and that is faith. Faith is the currency of heaven without which there cannot be any transaction with God. Faith is the basis of Christianity. If faith is removed from Bible, what remains is myth. Let us therefore do all necessary to increase our faith in God by listening to sound sermons, having quality time for personal meditation on the word of God, sharing our testimonies with others to encourage them and walking with the faithful. As our faith increases, let's set our sights on the great kingdom objectives—the nations coming to the Lord, the church preparing herself as His bride. And see what God will do through us!
