THEME: THE PRAYER ANSWERING GOD SUB-THEME: HARVEST OF RESTORATION READINGS: ISAIAH 65:24, 1 JOHN 5:13-15, JOHN, 16:21-24, 1 KINGS 3:3-14, MATTHEW 7:7-11

Introduction

I suppose there has been no word on Christians' lips so frequently at this time as the word "prayer". Prayer is, for the most part, an untapped resource, an unexplored continent where untold treasure remains to be unearthed. It is talked about more than anything else, and practiced less than anything else. And yet, for the believer it remains one of the greatest gift our Lord has given us outside of salvation. It is often said that if there is a man to pray, there is a God to answer. The ability of God to answer prayers is never in doubt. Through the scriptures, we find a God who is waiting to hear and answer the request of His children. F.B. Meyer, the author of the great little book, The Secret of Guidance said, "The great tragedy of life is not unanswered prayer, but un-offered prayer." Instead of it being something we do every day, like breathing, eating and walking and talking, it seems to have become like that little glass covered box on the wall that says, "break in case of emergency." It is true that so very often we associate prayer with crises in our life. We must move from this level (in case of emergency) to a place of consistent prayers with the assurance of a God that answers prayer.

The Answer Is Prepared Before We Pray

In Isaiah 65:24, listen to what the Lord Himself tells us about prayer. "It will come to pass that before they call, I will answer; and while they are still speaking, I will hear."

The answer to our prayers is prepared before we pray. The desire to talk to the Lord about our needs comes from Him. Prayer begins in the mind of God, invades our minds, is formulated into a clarification of what He wants to do or give, and then articulated in our words. He is more ready to hear than we are to pray! This encouraging promise of the Lord was made in response to an excruciating question asked by Israel, recorded in Isaiah 64:12. The people had sinned and felt the judgment of God. They were distant from Him; He had never left His people. Their sorrow had reached its height when they cried out, "Wilt thou keep silent? The response of grace was mediated through the prophet. There will come a time when not only will the Lord answer, but His answer will precede the petition, and prayer will be the response of God's call rather than just His response to our call. Then in 1 John 5:14-15, John sounds the same joyous note we heard in the Isaiah promise. "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him." Our assurance that He hears us is that He is the one who asked for the conversation. He would not call us to prayer and then refuse to listen or be inattentive to our prayer. That's the confidence, boldness, we have: prayer is our response to His call. So when we do ask, it is with the confidence that we are asking for what He is prepared to release for us. "And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him." We know before we ask, because the content of our asking has been guided by Him.

KEYS TO ANSWERED PRAYERS

1. Resolve to Persist until God Answers (Matthew 7:7-8)

"Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that askethreceiveth; and he that seekethfindeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened." When our hearts are burdened with a need, we should ask God for it, and not only ask, but earnestly seek after it, and not only seek but keep knocking, until the door is opened. In the use of these three action words we learn that answered prayer belongs to those who are persistent in praying. James 5:16 teaches us the same truth -"The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." One reason why many believers do not experience much by way of answered prayer, is that they are not fervent at all in their praying. They are not really serious in what they ask for. They don't mean business in asking God for the things that are in His will for them to ask. Such half-hearted non-serious praying is typical of those who pray without any definite objects. They merely ramble in their prayers after this or after that, and get nothing – because they are not seriously desiring anything in particular .Let us always remember this when we pray. We are making our requests to the Almighty God whose supply far exceeds every need. One mistake we often make in prayer is to focus our attention on the magnitude of our own problems.

We get so discouraged when we see how unsolvable our problems are. This only results in prayers that are actually complaints of self-pity.

2. Recognize what is Permissible for Us to Ask (Matthew 7:9-10)

"Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?" The son in this example asked his father for something that is good and necessary. If he had requested something that is harmful (such as a stone or a serpent), it would have been evil of his father to grant it. Here is one reason why our prayers are sometimes not answered - because we ask God for the wrong things. We ask for things that may even be selfish and sinful. As James 4:3 says "Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts". Whatever we ask for in prayer must therefore be within God's will for us to have. If it is not God's will, then it is not permissible to pray for it. This truth is found in 1 John 5:14-15 - "And this is the confidence that we have in Him. that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He heareth us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him." There was once a boy who asked: "When I am playing a computer game, can I ask God to help me to get on to the next level?" A football fan may ask a similar question: "When I watch the world cup series, can I pray that God will make my favourite team win the game?" It is quite futile to make such prayers. They will not be answered. They only encourage us to think of God as vending machine or a fairy godmother who can be used to make all our dreams and wishes come true.

3. Rely on the Provision of Our Heavenly Father (Matthew 7:11)

"If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?" This verse presents a picture of a loving father who is most willing to grant his children whatever they ask of him, for their welfare. Those of us who are parents can understand this a little better. How do you feel when your child comes to you for help to do the things that he cannot do on his own? How would you feel if your little child should one day stop asking you for help, and look instead to someone else for the help that you can provide? I am sure you would feel quite sad, and even upset if he does this. However, the point in this verse is not merely the parents' willingness to give to their children, but their willingness to give them gifts that are good - even though they themselves are evil. Human parents are evil in the sense that they are intrinsically self-centered rather than God-centered. This taints everything that they do. Nevertheless they are still able to give good gifts to their children. How much more then, will our heavenly Father, who is nothing but pure goodness, give good gifts to us when we ask of Him. From all these we will realise that the best course of action for us to take when we pray is to ask, seek and knock, and then leave the outcome of our praying entirely to God. He knows whether or not it is in our best interest to grant our petitions. We should not question why He gives more to some of us, and less to others. God gives according to His wise counsel, knowing how much each of us can handle. And what He finally gives to us in answer to our prayers may not be what we asked, but it is actually even better than what we had asked from Him. And so we must rely on Him to give what is best to each one of us.

Conclusion: Charles Spurgeon said "prayer is not fancy of fiction; it is a real actual thing coercing the universe, binding the laws of God themselves in fetters, and constraining the High and Holy One to listen to His poor but favoured creature, man". God answers prayer, Yes, yes, yes He does. God answers prayer. I know, I know, He does. So please don't forget to pray. Make full use of the key to answered prayer. And may the Lord be glorified as we spend more time coming boldly to His throne of grace. AMEN.
