SUNDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER, 2021

THEME: THE GREAT AND TERRIBLE DAY

READINGS: JOEL 2:1-2 & 11, ZEPHANIAH 1:14-18, 1 THESS 5:1-11, MATTHEW 13:24-32

### INTRODUCTION

Joel 2:1-2, 11

*Blow the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble; for the day of the LORD is coming, for it is at hand: A day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness, like the morning clouds spread over the mountains. A people come, great and strong, the like of whom has never been; nor will there ever be any such after them, even for many successive generations. The LORD gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word. For the day of the LORD is great and very terrible; who can endure it?*

Joel's message contains powerful warnings of punishment and destruction from God to wake people from their apathy and sin so they can turn to God and be delivered. This terrifying invading army is unstoppable; no human defenses can withstand it. The only solution is to turn to God. The Day of the Lord is mentioned throughout the Bible. It is the theme of the book of Joel. It is also the theme of the book of Revelation, where the plagues and battles are described in much more detail through the seven trumpets and the seven last plagues.

### The Day of the Lord.

In the book of Revelation, John, who recorded what he saw in vision, begins by explaining whose revelation it was (it was the Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God the Father gave Him, Revelation 1:1), who he was sending the message to (initially, seven churches in Asia, verse 4) and where he was (the island of Patmos, verse 9) when he received the vision. Here the Lord's Day is another way of saying the Day of the Lord—a time when God will intervene in world affairs to bring punishment to mankind for disobedience to His laws and to offer salvation to all who will repent of their sins. While many scriptures describe the Day of the Lord as God's wrath, we should note that the "Lord's Day" (as John's vision is described in Revelation 1:10) includes more than just God's wrath. It also includes the wonderful time referred to in Revelation 21 and 22.

When God created Adam and Eve, He gave them free will. God gave them the opportunity to choose how they would live. Of course, God continues to give us and all humanity this same freedom to choose what we will do. Unfortunately, Adam and Eve chose to reject God's instruction not to eat of the forbidden tree in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3). Sadly, we humans have all followed Adam and Eve's tragic example of disobedience to God. As Paul wrote, "all have sinned" (Romans 3:23) and thus deserve death (Romans 6:23). The Bible is so very clear on this. There will indeed be a final day of judgment. There is no doubt about it. There is so much in a scripture about this. It's constantly referred to as a day. A day of judgment. In other words, a single point at the end, which will end it all. Human history as we know it will be brought to an end. The dead will be judged. The people of God brought into eternal blessing, and the wicked brought into eternal damnation. So much Scripture on this "day." Old Testament and New Testament are abundantly united in passage after passage about this coming day. So we believe it will come and it is closer than we can imagine. In its broadest sense, the Day of the Lord simply refers to the era wherein God will take control of the earth.

### **The Day of the Lord is a call to repent**

This should cause us all to pause. It should strike us a great and dreadful day. This should spark in us all a beginning sense of the fear of God. And yet this is why our generation today needs to hear this. It seems there is so little fear of God in our culture. People want to invent a god today of their own choosing. One for which they would never need to have any sort of fear. But that's not a Biblical picture of the one true God. The God of justice will come and bring a terrible judgment on the wicked.

The prophet Joel wrote: *"Blow the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble; for the day of the LORD is coming, for it is at hand.*

*"Now, therefore," says the LORD, 'Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.' So rend your hearts, and not your garments; return to the LORD your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm"* (Joel 2:1, 12-13).

Unfortunately, human nature is such that the majority of mankind is going to be deceived into fighting against Christ when He returns (Zechariah 14:1-3; Revelation 17:12-14). And then, as Christ delivers punishment after punishment, humans are still going to refuse to repent (Revelation 16:9, Revelation 16:11, Revelation 16:21).

Noting this hardened resistance to God, the apostle Paul wrote: "For the wrath of God [part of the Day of the Lord] is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness" (Romans 1:18). It is going to take a series of punishments from God to get through to humans that they must repent of their evil deeds and live as God commands. And so the response commended to this coming day is one of repentance. Turn back to God and find salvation instead of judgment. That was the message back then. That response is still commended to us today in light of the coming Day of Judgment.

### **When is the Day of the Lord?**

1 Thessalonians 5:1-2 NIV

*Now, brothers and sisters, about times and dates we do not need to write to you, for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. While people are saying, "Peace and safety," destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.*

From this verse we see, that no one can put a date to it. So do not be deceived by the wave of fake prophecies about when the Lord will return. But we know it will come as recorded in the scriptures and it is closer than when we first believed. So as we wait, we keep watching and praying. Holding steadfastly to the faith and ensuring that what we have received is not taken away. As we wait we continue to declare to the world the message of Salvation that Jesus brought. As we wait, we continue in prayers and in the study of the word. We continue to do all that we can to keep ourselves well positioned for the return of the Master.

### **Conclusion**

In one way, we can be thankful that that Day has not yet come. Would we have been ready if it had? As the days darken toward the return of the King of kings, Christians need to heed the warnings embedded in these latest disasters and repent of their sins and move even closer to God. Christ is preparing His Bride, and she will make herself ready for His glorious appearing (Revelation 19:7). If we desire to be part of that Bride, we should do as the apostle Paul advises in Ephesians 5:15-16: "See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil." Jesus gave us a WARNING and an instruction to WATCH "world events" concerning this "DAY"! Notice: "Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come. Are you watching?"
