So also Christ died only as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. He will come again but not to deal with our sins again. This time He will bring salvation to all those who are eagerly waiting for Him. *Hebrews 9:28*.

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 21ST NOVEMBER, 2021

THEME: JUDGEMENT DAY SURPRISES
READINGS: AMOS 5:18-24; PSALM 146;
HEBREWS 9:24-28; JOHN 10:7-

18.

As it is our custom in the Anglican Church, the two or three Sundays preceding Advent Sunday are used to prepare our minds for the Lord's return, not as a baby in the manger that we celebrate at Christmas, but as Judge. Last week, our thematic focus was on The Great and Terrible Day while that of today is on Judgment Day Surprises. Whereas The Great and Terrible Day reminds us of the reality of heaven and judgment after this earthly existence, Judgment Day Surprises seeks to beam on us the fact that the judgment we are talking about is not in our hands and so not according to our human standard assumptions, hence many pleasant and disappointing surprises.

This write-up touches on some of those surprises to give us a glimpse of divine workings that should be enough guide for us in our pilgrimage journey.

The Day of the Lord or The Great Day of the Lord or The Great and Terrible Day, as the judgment day is variously described, was in the Old Testament time called the Day of Yahweh among the Israelites. It was a popular belief in Israel during the time of Prophet Amos that God would come to destroy the pagan nations and save Israel - Woe unto you that desire the day of the LORD! to what end is it for you? The day of the LORD is darkness, and not light-Amo.5:18. If we read down the lines, we would see how God through the prophet shunned the congregational worship of Israel because of idolatry and injustice, He described their songs as noise.

Take away from Me the noise of your songs, For I will not hear the melody of your stringed instruments. 24 But let justice run down like water, And righteousness like a mighty stream.

Other Old Testament prophets such as Zephaniah and Joel in particular shared this thought in their prophetic works.

That day is a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness, - Zeph.1:15. Verses 8-9 present idolatry, violence and deceit as reasons for God's anger against Judah.

The statement Woe unto you that desire the day of the LORD! is an expression of, and as we earlier observed, a glimpse into the unpleasant surprise that awaited the people of Judah who thought the judgment of God was not designed them but for the punishment of gentiles, and so got themselves deep into sin of idolatry, violence and deceit. The prophecy of Amos however proved them

The notion among some Christians that they are forever saved once they come to Jesus Christ by faith is a belief that can hand unpleasant judgment day surprise to those who hold it. And that is the point the Bible makes clear in Heb.9:28 - To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation (NKJV). Jesus is not coming to deal with sin matters again; when he next appears, the outcome for those eager to greet him is, precisely, salvation. Surprises therefore await those who live their lives, like Judah, as though Christ is not coming again. This is a warning against religious impunity anchored on the deceitful doctrine of eternal security that is fast gaining ground in the modern Church of our time. Please be careful and be warned!

Common to all the prophecies about the Day of Judgment was a latent hope anchored on repentance. So, the Day of the Lord from the Old Testament perspective, as per the prophecies, can be summarized to mean two things.

- 1. A day of God's anger and judgment against sinners
- 2. A day of restoration and joy for repentant sinners. Zeph.3:16-17 tells us that much -

In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Do not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak. The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

The New Testament sees the Day of the Lord as the day of the LORD's Return, in which He will do two things:

- 1. Judge the living and the dead
- 2. Establish His endless kingdom with the Saints.

Our creeds remind of this fact every time we gather.

So, we can add that it is equally a day of judgment and of salvation. Paul tells us in 1Cor.5:5 that a repentant sinner's soul may be saved in the day of the Lord. And that is another surprise. Those who have been condemned and consigned in human imagination to hell will be seen in heaven.

In Mat.21:31-32, Jesus said to the Jewish leaders who questioned his authority in their brazen unbelief, "Assuredly, I say to you that tax collectors and harlots enter the kingdom of God before you. 32 For John came to you in the way of righteousness, and you did not believe him; but tax collectors and harlots believed him; and when you saw it, you did not afterward relent and believe him. This again is one of the Judgment Day surprises to expect, a situation in which strangers enter into the house before the sons. There's nothing to take for granted in matters of heaven and eternity; faith and obedience are of essence and are held sacrosanct by those who are really preparing for heaven.

Those who think that religious activities and ministry works can qualify them for heaven at the expense of faith, obedience and holiness are certainly bracing up for unpleasant Judgment Day surprises. Jesus said this much in Matt 7:21-23, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 Many will

Rewards of Believers at Judgment.

God has made many promises the righteous will be judged and rewarded as they work not from any wrong motives. All believers must appear at the judgement seat of Christ and be judged for their works-1Cor.3:11-15; 2Cor.5:10-11]. All believers will stand before this seat of Christ and give an account of themselves. Responsibility necessitates accountability- Rm.14:10-12. The Lord desires that we have boldness in the face of judgement and not ashamed before him at His coming- IJhn.4:17; 2Tim.4:18; Rev.11:18. This judgement will actually take place at the second coming of Christ. It is not a judgment concerning the believers salvation, for that was settled at calvary; it is a judgment of his works and service for the Lord.

The reward of crown of life- Jam.1:12; Rev.2:10
The reward of the crown of glory- IPt.5:2-4; Heb.2:9.
The reward of the crown of rejoicing- I Thes.2:19-20
The reward of the incorruptible crown- ICor.9:25-27
The reward of the crown of righteousness- Tim.4:8.
The reward of the prophet and the righteous man-Mat.10:41-42.

The reward to God's saint and servant- Rev.11:18. The crown of gold- Rev.4:4; 3:11.

Rewards of unbelievers at Judgment.

The reward of faithfulness- Mat.25:21-23

The unbelievers are to come up for judgement. If God did not bring man up for judgement, then His own justice is violated, His righteous and holy law insulted. The character and deeds of the ungodly, which so often escape judgement in time, demand that God bring every work to judgement, and this He will do at the Great White Throne judgement.

Although the wicked are sometimes judged in this life, the final and eternal judgement of the ungodly will still take place- Rev.20:11-15, out of the books according to their works- Dan.7:10, 22-26; Act.24:28; Jude 14-15; Heb.9:27; Rm.2:5

The cities of the nations such as Sodom and Gomorrah, Tyre and sidon and Capernaum as well as all modern cities will also be judged- Mat.10:15; 11;20-24; 12:28-42; Eccl.11:9;12:14.

Remember . . .

Balaam received "the reward and wages of unrighteous" 2Pt.2:13-15.

Judas received "the reward of iniquity" Act.1:18. So shall all the wicked receive their "rewards" according to their evil deeds!

What we have admonished in this write-up is that the judgment day will be full of surprises, pleasant and unpleasant; hence the need to run our Christian race with diligence, seeking to please at all cost the one in whose hands lies the judgment of both the living and the dead. Let us strive earnestly to walk and work by God's standard and not by our dangerous assumptions like the Jews that felt secure, though falsely as it were, because they had Abraham as father, not knowing that Jesus that they didn't believe preceded Abraham and held the key of because
