5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 7TH NOVEMBER, 2021

THEME: THE PRAYER ANSWERING GOD

READINGS: II KINGS 20:1-7, PSALM 103:1-18;
ACTS 9:32-35; JOHN 5:2-14.

INTRODUCTION:

Prayer is the communication with God. Because God is personal, all people can offer prayers. However, sinners who have not trusted Jesus Christ for their salvation remain alienated from God. So while unbelievers may pray, they do not have the basis for a rewarding fellowship with God.

How should we pray?

- (a) To God (Acts 12:5)
- (b) In the Name of Jesus (John 14:13&14)
- (c) By means of the Holy Spirit (Eph. 6:18)

Does God answers prayers?... God's word is clear that He does, indeed answer prayers and you can trust in Him to do so...And this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask we know that we have the requests that we have asked of Him. (1 John 5:14 & 15)

It is commonly said that God gives three(3) answers to prayers: YES, NO or WAIT. And this is true!

You can be confident His answer to your prayers is the best one for you and for His purpose in your life, whether it is a No, Yes or not Yet. It is also said that God answers prayers in 2 ways:

- (i) Provision
- (ii) Protection

Either God provides what you ask for or protects you from it. He knows better than you do. Nothing happens without His permission and knowledge. Thus, He alone knows not only what the future holds, but also the very depth of our hearts and souls. Whatever He does in your life is for a specific purpose, whether it is to grow you in your faith, encourage you in times of desperation or to confront sin in your heart and life.

The Bible also tells us that there are certain situations in which God will not hear a person; prayer nor answer it.

So what is the difference between the prayers He does answer and those He does not?

1. The state of your heart matters:

God desires to answer prayers of those who love and obey Him. He responds to you similarly to the way a father grants requests from His children. John 9:31: echoes these themes by making the

1 Peter 3:12 states that God hears the prayers of the righteous, but His is against anyone who does evil. And so when you pray, God looks at your heart to determine whether you are genuine or not. He is not like a genie in a lamp who will answer any master who runs the lamp, whether good or evil. He pays careful attention to those who love Him and ignores those who simply ask for selfish and sinful reasons.

2. How to pray prayers God answers

There are two(2) keys to effective prayer: the right heart and the right prayer.

Praying with the right heart: Jeremiah 29:12-13 says that God will us if we seek Him with all our hearts. You must approach God with a heart that desires relationship with Him. He wants your whole heart for your whole life, not occasional transactions when you want something from Him. Read Psalm 66:17-20, in this Psalm, the Psalmist says that if he had treasured sin within his own whole heart, God would never have listened to him. But because he cried out with an attitude of worship and repentance, God heard his prayer.

3. Praying the right Prayer

"And this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us" (1 John 5:14). When you have a humble heart that repents from sin, and you are reading the Bible, it is likely you are praying in accordance with His will.

When you pray, you must believe you are praying to the God who answers prayers. Paul gives great insight into this in his second letter to the Corinthians Church. "infact, we expected to die. But as a result, we stopped relying on ourselves and learned to rely only on God, who raises the dead" (2 Cor. 1:9). When you know who you are praying to, you can be confident God answers prayer... because that is exactly who He Is; the Beloved who bends down and listens to His Bride. Therefore Brethren, pray in alignment with His Will, and believe in the one to whom you are praying... and God will answer your prayers.

Conclusion:

Beloved prayers re answered when...

1. Promised - Isa. 58:9; Jer. 29:12; Matt. 7:7
2. Sometimes immediately - Isa. 65:24; Dan. 9:21 & 23
3. Sometimes after a delay - Luke 18:7; Dan. 10:12 & 13; 1 Kings 18:42 & 44
4. Sometime differently than we expect - 2 Cor. 12:8 & 9
5. Better than we can expect or think - Jer. 33:3; Eph. 3:20
