READINGS: ISAIAH 7:10-17; PS. 45:10; ROM. 1:1-7, LUKE 1:26-38, NEHEMIAH 6:8.

Introduction:

Literary Meaning: Harbinger in a sign that shows that something is going to happen soon.

Faith in God and His word brings favour, favour being the gift of been in a relationship with God. Faith bring Divine favour. Though Nehemiah had never visited Jerusalem, but he could see both the problem and solution. Nehemiah was able to see the problem even though he lived hundred of miles away from Jerusalem he could picture the solution in his need.

What is God's favour?

God's favour or grace is God giving us the ability to do all things....My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness....." (2 Cor. 12:9) been saved through faith and that not of yourselves; it is a gift of God.

- The favour of God will change your life, then you have to received them by faith. Remember Ephesians 2:8. "God saved you, by His grace....." God's favour provides every possible blessing.....
- God's supernatural favour flowing in your life is not based on your background, looks or personality.
- His favour is based on the word of God and believing
- Divine favour is being out by God for special treatment. It is at His exclusive and unquestionable bidding and pleasure.
- God's good face Numbers 6:25-26
- Support of the Almighty God Prov. 16:15
- An exciting free gift from God.

How do we maintain God's Favour? How do you walk in God's favour?

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord bestows favour and honour. No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly. Ps. 5:12 – For you O Jehovah will bless the righteous with favour. You will surround him as with a shield.

- <u>Issues of faith:</u> Seek, receive Jesus for God's favour. Biblical faith always has God as its objective and focus. Therefore the type of faith that God favours is a faith that trust God.
- Faith has always been the mark of a disciple of Jesus.
 Faith means total dependence on God. Faith advances you beyond your five senses of seeing, hearing, tasting, smelling and touching. By faith you move from –in-ability to His-ability.

This is the walk of faith to which all of us are called – Where "nothing is impossible") (Matt. 17:20).

Faith is obedient action in response to what God has said:

True faith is expressed in (i) Obedience and (2) Action in response to (3) hearing God's word (voice). "Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see" (Heb. 11:11).

Faith means having trust assurance or confidence in another person or that person's words.

Having faith in God involves an exchange of self trust for God – trust. We stop trusting in ourself and trust Him.

We abandon reliance on our limited source of knowledge and start receiving from His unlimited source.

The Basis of Faith:-

The basis of having faith in God is in 3 important realities:-

(1) The nature of God.

- (a) He cannot change.... "I the Lord do not change......" (Mal. 3:6)
- (b) He cannot fail "I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted" (Job 42:2) see also 1 Chronicles 28:2)
- (c) He cannot lie "God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he promise and not fulfill? (Num. 23:10) see also Titus 1:2.

(2) The Redemptive work of the Son of God

"Le t us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scoring its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God " (Heb. 12:2)

Christ has become the source of our faith in God. The fact of His death and resurrection provides grounds for our believing .

"....Christ Jesus has become for us wisdom from God That is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption"...... (1 Cor. 1:30)
