From reading Genesis 1, we learn God's Words are powerful, and they matter. Not only are God's words powerful, but they are also important. So important in fact that they will never pass away. "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away." - Matthew 24:35.God's words are permanent; they remain forever; they will withstand the test of time. "All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of the Lord stands forever." – 1 Peter 1:24-25.
