5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 23RD JANUARY, 2022

THEME: TEAM MINISTRY TODAY

**Readings: Psalm 27:1-8; Exodus 33:12-End;
1 John 1:1-7; Matthew 8:1-13.**

Team Ministry is all about following God's design for the Body of Christ to function interdependently with each member doing his/her part for the growth of all. In this race to heaven, we all need each other to be most effective. It is not about how much 'I' accomplish but how much God uses 'us' to do His work-**interdependence, not independence.**

Paul used the human body as a picture of Christian unity and the need for team ministry, making it known that each part of the body is different from the other parts, yet all make up one body and work together (Eph 4:13-16). The human body serves as the perfect metaphor for the people of God on Earth. The church is one body with many members, called from every nation, kindred, tongue, and people. In Christ we are a new creation. Distinctions of race, culture, learning, nationality, and differences between high and low, rich and poor, male and female, must not be divisive among us.

We are all equal in Christ, who by one Spirit has bonded us into one fellowship with Him and with one another. We are to serve and be served without partiality or reservation.

Therefore we must know:

1. We are not equally talented- *There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. (1 Cor. 12:4-7)*
2. The work is not only for you, God also assigned others roles to play. You can't do it all alone. *From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. (Eph. 4:16).*

3. We are interdependent as the Body of Christ- *If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. (1 Cor. 12:17-18)*
4. We must involve others in the ministry and trust them to do it - *Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. (1 Pet. 4:10-11)*
5. *The unity of the brethren is a must to ensure an effective ministry.*
6. We must believe every individual is significant, therefore, diversity must be expected, welcomed, respected, valued, and pulled upon. - *For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. (Rom. 12:4-5)*
7. We must believe in the importance of every person having a unique contribution to make, and encourage them to do their part according to their best fit.-*For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. (Rom. 12:3-6a)*
