5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 30th JANUARY, 2022

THEME: POWER AND WISDOM OF GOD IN MINISTRY

**Readings: Psalm 37:1-11; 1 Kings 8:22-30;
1 Corinthians 1:18-25; John 4:19-26.**

TEXT: *1 Cor. 1:24KJV* "But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God".

INTRODUCTION

The idea that service to God should have only to do with a church altar, singing, reading, sacrifice, and the like is without doubt but the worst trick of the devil. How could the devil have led us more effectively astray than by the narrow conception that the service of God takes place only in the church and by works done therein? ... The whole world could abound with services to the Lord ... not only in churches but also in the home, kitchen, workshop, and field.—Martin Luther.

Last week sermon which was a revelation from the throne of mercy instructing us about **TEAM MINISTRY**, "Every believer in Christ is saved and **SHAPED** for service". It is necessary to understand ministry and how it ought to function effectively with maximum results unto the kingdom of God according to the scripture.

WHAT IS MINISTRY? *Ministry is any activity carried out: to bringing people to saving faith in Christ and then assist them to grow in Christ-likeness; and to bring every believer into a vital, authentic relationship with God through the grace of Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit, such that every believer glorifies God in thought, word, and deed both in the church and in the world with the ultimate goal of presenting every one complete in Christ (Col. 1:28).*

The Greek word in the New Testament that is often translated as “ministry” is **diakonia**. The basic meaning of this word is “service.” It can refer to tasks as basic as waiting on tables (see **Acts 6:1**), caring for the poor through monetary gifts (see **2 Corinthians 9:12**), or proclaiming the gospel (see **Acts 20:24**). Ministry can simply be explained thus: **any God approved service(s) rendered by a believer in Christ; in the church or outside the church, expanding the kingdom of God’s in God’s pattern glorifying only Him per time.**

Power is simply the ability or capability to do something or act in a particular way. **Wisdom** is the quality or state of being wise; knowledge of what is true or right coupled with just judgment as to action; sagacity, discernment or insight. Note: *having the understanding of what, how and when service(s) ought to be done per time and capability to carry it accordingly is the **POWER and WISDOM IN/ FOR MINISTRY.*** Jesus Christ shows to us the end of every ministry in the parable of talents (Matthew 25: 14-30). He exemplified the ministry and the end of every ministry according to **Philippians 2:5-11**.

Apostle Paul in the chosen text explained that Jesus Christ is the power and wisdom of God; we may rewrite the topic this way **Jesus Christ in Ministry**. Jesus Christ in ministry in the context of our topic, text and in the realities of our world simply refers to:

- Every service(s) rendered by a believer (the called) must be Jesus Christ centered.
- Every service rendered must follow Jesus Christ’s pattern **Mark 1:10-13, 35; 6:46; Luke 4:1, 14-16; 5:16; Acts 1:4-8.**
- Every service rendered must bring glory to God through Jesus Christ. **Isaiah 43:7; John 7:18; 1 Corinthians 6:20.**
- Every service rendered must be according to the will of God through Jesus Christ **John 4:34; 5:19; 6:38-40.**
- Every service rendered must be according to the Divine timing. **Eccl.3:1; Gal.4:4.**
