5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 27th FEBRUARY, 2022 THEME: REPENTANCE: ESSENTIAL TO FORGINESS & RESTORATION READINGS: PSALM 99:4-9; HOSEA 14:1-7, COLOSSIANS 1:18-23; MARK 2: 13-17.

1. Introduction

Today is Quinquagesima Sunday; Sunday before Lent and about fifty days to Easter. We are getting into the penitential period. Penitence. Time to return to God. Joel put it succinctly when he said in Joel 2:13, Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity. There is so much grace during this period to undo all wrong deeds. The flesh can be so beaten for the Holy Spirit to have a firm grip of our hearts. Here is the call to repentance; from sin toward turn away biblical righteousness - in order to give irrevocable allegiance to Jesus - and to receive divine blessings.

2. Leaving the Hard Path

A sinful life is the hard path. The prodigal son chose that path the moment he took his inheritance and headed for a far country. It might appear blissful at the beginning but horrible through the path and destruction at the end. One of the easiest things God requests from man is repentance. It's easier than anyone can imagine but why does it appear hard? In Hosea 14, the Prophet was practically begging Israel to return to God. "O Israel, return to the LORD your God, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity".

To pitch oneself against God is to sign-on calamity. Sin has not ceased to being a reproach. A sinful life is full of stinks and unliness. A sinful life lacks innate peace that only fellowship with God can give. God created man with an instinct to seek His forgiveness and favor? Until he finds forgiveness, he can't have peace. We have flesh and bone and blood and our five empirical senses, but there is more to man than physiology. When the Bible says Man was "created in God's image" it meant we have a moral compass, called "The Conscience," which helps us discern right from wrong. Notice something about the conscience: it doesn't need a vast amount of Bible knowledge to be convicted of wrongdoing. Thank goodness we have had a good teaching on 'Conscientiousness'. Paul said even people completely ignorant of the Scriptures innately realize right from wrong.

Listen to his words in Romans 2:14. "Even Gentiles, who do not have God's written law, show that they know his law when they instinctively obey it, even without having heard it. ¹⁵They demonstrate that God's law is written in their hearts, for their own conscience and thoughts either accuse them or tell them they are doing right" (NLT). Albeit, it is much easier for a child of to repent and turn to God because he has the Holy Spirit. John 16:8And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment. Once convicted, a Christian reconciles with God the help of the same Holy Spirit.

2. Turning the bend

Turning the bend is making up the mind to turn a new leaf; the blessed path. It is called the path of righteousness. Jesus has taken that route. He is ever there. He knows everything in the drive. Once a straying child of God turns the bend to the path of righteousness, so much joy is recorded in heaven. Once a sinner decides to accept Jesus, he is brought to the path of righteousness. ..*And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein. (Isaiah 35:8)*

3. The Promise of a Loving Father

In Israel's sinful state, see what God said he would do if they turn to Him in Hosea 14:4-7 "I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, For My anger has turned away from him.5 I will be like the dew to Israel; He shall grow like the lily, And lengthen his roots like Lebanon.6 His branches shall spread; His beauty shall be like an olive tree, And his fragrance like Lebanon. 7 Those who dwell under his shadow shall return; They shall be revived like grain, And grow like a vine. Their scent[b] shall be like the wine of Lebanon.

This corroborates the Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. If God loved us this much while we were still sinners, can anyone explain the depth of His love to us as His children? The Pharisees had issue with Jesus sitting and eating with the tax collectors but he told them in Mark 2:17 'Those who are healthy have no need of a physician, but [only] those who are sick; I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners [who recognize their sin and humbly seek forgiveness]'. God desires us to return to Him. The father of the prodigal son longed for the return of his son. God longs for the repentance of every sinner.

4. The Blessings

- Forgiveness Pardon: Romans 8:1-2. No more condemnation. Repentance avoids sure punishment for sin. David says, "If a man does not repent, He (God) will sharpen His sword" (Psalms 7:12). The clear indication here is that God prepares a judgement (sword) for those who refuse to repent.
- It produces fruit: It produces things on the inside that are reflected on the outside. Acts 26:11 says there are "deeds of repentance." In other words, repentance produces fruit (Matthew 3:8).
- Repentance leads to salvation. Paul teaches about a "...repentance without regret leading to salvation" (II Cor. 7:10). We often forget that without repentance, baptism is void of meaning and effect.
- Repentance confirms our faith: John the Baptist called on people to demonstrate their faith in the Kingdom to come by doing works "...worthy of repentance" (Luke 3:8). Strong faith is the wellspring for our joy and peace, but sincere repentance is what keeps that source full.
- Repentance brings healing: 2Chronicles 7:14. There are health situations caused by sin. In Mark 2:5, Jesus saw the faith of the friends of the paralytic man and said "Son, your sins are forgiven you"
- Repentance brings increased grace: Romans 6:1. Grace will not increase in sin but grace will increase in obedience.
- Repentance brings joy: Peace doesn't come from places, people, or prescriptions. The joy of repentance brings peace; perfect peace. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives...... says Jesus in John 14:27. Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

5. Conclusion

'Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit'. Psalm 32:1-2. Amazingly, God will receive us as we repent and cry out to him. He does not have to; he could destroy us because of our sins. But he says, "No, even now, return." Even now, return-not tomorrow, not whenever you feel like it. Now is the accepted time, now is the day of salvation. Repent and be blessed. Shalom
