5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 6th FEBRUARY, 2022

THEME: THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD

READINGS: ACTS 20:26-32, 1 CORINTHIANS 2:1-11, JOHN 15:1-11

Introduction: Paul, in his farewell speech to the elders of the Ephesian church, affirmed how he had declared to them the whole counsel of God without being guilty of the blood of any. As a witness is sworn in a law court to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, so a preacher is to preach the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth. That is, a preacher is to preach the whole Bible, all of God's revealed word to mankind. Nothing is to be overlooked. This was exactly what Paul did to this Ephesian Church. Why did he emphasize that he "**did not shrink**" from declaring the whole counsel of God? Likely because declaring the whole counsel of God would have been offensive to the people as it is offensive to some today. Some will rather say "Pastor, that is too much now, we didn't kill Jesus". For Paul, rather than holding back hard things, he has not obscured the revelation of God to His people – both Jews and Gentiles. We see that Jews and Greeks were similarly offended by the gospel that Paul preached (Acts 21:34 and 19:32). Paul emphasizes "the whole counsel of God" as a way to affirm the completion of his duties toward the Ephesians and to remind them of the truth. Paul warns, "**I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock. Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to draw away disciples after them. So be on your guard!**" (Acts 20:29-31).

WHAT IS THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD?

Knowing that Acts was written by Luke helps us here as well. In Luke 24:27 we are told that Jesus "beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself." So, if the 'counsel of God' is the Scriptures and the whole of the Scriptures ultimately point us to the life and work of Jesus, the '**whole counsel of God**' is also referring to the whole plan of God for humanity and the created order revealed in the Scriptures and fulfilled in Jesus Christ. So, in Paul's discipleship of the Ephesians in Acts 20, he likely would have explained Creation, the Fall, the Flood, the Abrahamic covenant, the Torah, "prophets-priests-and-kings" all in the context of God's plan for humanity, which includes the virgin birth, sinless life, vicarious death, victorious resurrection, and ascension of the Lamb of God, the Savior of the World, Jesus of Nazareth. Paul would NOT have shrunk back from calling sin sin, from testifying to sinners' need for salvation, from declaring

the unity of Jews and Gentiles, or from calling elders to faithfulness in their calling to preach the whole good news of the Kingdom of God realized in Jesus Christ and contained within the Scriptures.

THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD IS THE MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM TO BE PREACHED.

In the declaration and proclamation of the Gospel, nothing must be downplayed. Paul says he did not shrink from declaring the whole counsel of God. He did not shrink from declaring anything that was profitable. He testified to the gospel of the grace of God and proclaimed the kingdom of God. There is nothing he left unsaid. He proclaimed the whole truth. So it is clear that the Whole Counsel of God is the minimum to be preached. But, it is also the maximum. We can not to go beyond the Scriptures. We don't mix the Bible with some Greek mythology, or some Koran, or some Buddhist writings or some African traditional religion concept. We cannot mix the bible with the wisdom of men. We don't mix the Bible with the latest scientific surveys. The Bible Alone is the Word of God and it stands sure forever. Paul did not say "I've told you all the wisdom of the Greeks, and Jews, and peoples of all nations." Rather, he said, "I've relayed to you the whole counsel of God." Not of man, but of God. That the whole counsel of God is the maximum to be preached means that only Biblical truths are to be preached.

THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD IS TO BE UNDERSTOOD.

The contents of the Bible were written to be understood. The histories of the Old Testament, the letters of the New Testament, and all else contained in the pages of the Bible; all was written to convey a message- message from God. An understandable message that is supposed to produce an awareness and reveal the truth. Some things no doubt are hard to understand. And Peter admitted so. But with diligent study more and more of the Bible is understood. And the most important Scriptural truths are repeated many times and in many ways to ensure we understand them. The whole counsel of God concerning all things necessary for His own glory, man's salvation, faith and life, is fully expressly in the scripture and by careful study and continuous meditation, we can understand it and come into the reality of all that God has made available for us. This is why we must fully embrace the **BIBLE REFRESHER COURSE** currently going on. There is so much good in the refresher course for you and you can still join us.

THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD IS TO BE BELIEVED.

The whole counsel of God cannot be a blessing to us until we fully believe it. You cannot fight the scriptures, accepting only what you like. We must rather embrace the whole counsel of God, for God has revealed it all for your knowledge and benefit, and to His glory. Psalm 19:7-11: *"The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul.*

The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple. The precepts of the Lord are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes. The fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the Lord are sure and altogether righteous. They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb. By them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward."

The Bible is declared to be perfect, trustworthy, wise, right, radiant, pure, sure, righteous, more precious than gold, sweeter than honey, capable of warning, and greatly rewarding for those who obey it. These qualities do not exist in ordinary literature but characterize the perfection of biblical revelation. The counsel of God is trustworthy, so you can believe it!

THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD IS TO BE OBEYED

When we fully understand and believe the whole counsel of God, we just must respond in Obedience. "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, *that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it*. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success". Joshua 1:8. When it comes to the counsel of God, we don't continue to rationalize or give our opinion, we just simply obey. In our obedience of the whole counsel of God lies our blessing. We are to take in the Scriptures with the desire to understand, to be renewed, and to ultimately obey.

SHAPED BY THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD

Knowing the Whole Counsel of God is kind of like riding a bike. You can read a book on how to ride a bike, but in order to know how to ride a bike, you have to get on the thing and ride it. It is the same with Scripture, until we practice following Jesus, we can't really say we "know" the whole counsel of God. Following Jesus here means living like He lived in His days. Showing His Love, forgiveness, Mercy and all the good virtues exemplified by His life. The whole counsel of God is taken in as we obey, it begins to shape our lives and then we can live it out. Living out the counsel of God may be offensive to our culture or the traditions of men, but that is the only way to show that we have been formed by the word of God. While living and working as a Christian in our often-hostile culture is fraught with risks, God clearly calls us to live in the world but not be "of the world" (John 17:14-18). Jesus and the authors of the New Testament clearly understood the tension expressed in this statement. And history shows that by living this way, Christians through the centuries have had a positive influence on their world and we can do the same in this generation.

CONCLUSION: Every dimension of culture, whether it is art, science, or politics, is an arena in which we can speak about Christ with our lips and reflect him with our lives. We thank God for the existence of culture and recognize whatever is good in it, while at the same time seeking to redirect whatever is not good for Christ. This is why we must combine our words and deeds (work) in a meaningful way to positively impact the culture around us. The whole counsel of God can help us to deliver this even in this generation. Let's get to work!
