- 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 13TH MARCH, 2022

THEME: JESUS: MAN OF SORROWS READINGS: PSALM 33:17-21; ISAIAH 53:1-12; 1 JOHN 3:1-10; LUKE 15:1-10.

Introduction

The Old Testament is full of deep, prophetic passages that reveal a great deal about the nature of man, God's plans for the universe, and the end of time that leads to a glorious eternity for those who love and obey God. Certain books contain more prophecies, and have a heavier emphasis on the Messiah, or the future of Israel, or the end of days. The prophet Isaiah's writings contain huge wrappings of prophecy within its pages. In one of Isaiah's prophetic passages, he spoke of a man who would live a life of pain and hardship. In one verse it says, "He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief, and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not" (Isaiah 53:3). This man of sorrows was Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit showed Isaiah a glimpse of the life of Jesus where He was rejected in His hometown, betrayed by people who loved Him, and suffered for others. Most of His life was defined by hardship, and the culmination of His ministry was sacrificing His life as an act of substitutionary atonement. Ultimately, Jesus will return to earth, not to suffer, but to rule and reign. Remembering that Jesus Christ is God, it now behoves us to recollect that his manhood was none the less real and substantial.

WHY WAS HE CALLED MAN OF SORROWS?

He could have been called a man of holiness, for he lived a perfect life. He could have been called a man of love, for no one was ever kinder. But the Gospel according to Isaiah calls Jesus "a man of sorrows." What a name! Jesus received the title "man of sorrows" in chapter 53 of the book of Isaiah. This particular passage is one of the more famous Messianic prophecies - a section of Scripture that foretells the coming of a future king of Israel who would redeem the world. Centuries later, Jesus would fulfill these prophecies. Early in the passage he is called the man of sorrows, and the rest of the prophecy outlines why.

It speaks about the crucifixion at Golgotha. Verses address the trial, Jesus' silence, and the physical and spiritual suffering. It applies to an about the

Part of the great sorrow of Jesus' life was that when He died, the weight of all the sins of the world were laid on Him, and He suffered greatly. Each of the Gospels records eye-witness accounts of this process, and it matches with the prophecies of Isaiah 53. Some of these prophecies fulfilled by the crucifixion that underscore how Jesus was a man of sorrows include:

- (a). "But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed" (Isaiah 53:5).
- (b). "He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth..." (Isaiah 53:7a).
- (c). "And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth" (Isaiah 53:9).
- (d). "Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors" (Isaiah 53:12).

Jesus knew the sorrow of loss. He experienced the indescribable pain that comes when those closest to us are taken from us. He felt the agony that hits us when we stand by the grave of a loved one, he knew the sense of rage that fills our hearts at the obscene intrusion of death into the goodness of life. Once, as he stood outside the tomb of his friend Lazarus, Jesus was almost overcome with emotion. He trembled—not with fear or with grief only, but more with anger—as he came face to face with our hideous enemy death. Then, the Bible says, Jesus wept, and those watching him remarked to one another, "See how he loved him" (John 11:36). Jesus' emotions were those of every heart that has felt the sting of death.

Jesus also knew the sorrow of loneliness. While he was on earth, no one ever really understood him, not even his own parents and family or his closest friends. Jesus had no one in whom he could fully confide, no other human being who knew and sympathized with him completely, no one else who was just like him. What is it like when even members of your own family criticize you? How does it feel when even your closest friends turn on you, betray you, or desert you just when you need them most? Jesus knew all these sorrows too.

And Jesus knew the sorrow of rejection. What happens when the very people you are most trying to help have no use for you? Jesus tasted this sorrow at its bitterest. He came to his own people in saving love, and most of them turned on him. One of the gospel writers tells how, near the end of his earthly life, Jesus' heart broke as he stood

Why Would Jesus Be Sorrowful?

God could have lived His incarnate life anywhere. He could have come as a powerful king, a mighty warrior, a wealthy merchant, or in all His glory. Any of these would have made His life simpler and showed the world who He truly was. He could have claimed everything owed to Him. Instead, for His first time on earth. God the Son came in the most humble of circumstances. His family was deeply impoverished; in fact, the Bible only records them sacrificing small birds, the accepted sacrifice for the poorest in Hebrew society. His family probably carried a stigma because of the strange circumstances of his birth. During His ministry, Jesus lived a life of hardship. Many people came to Him, interested in following Him until they learned they would have to give up things in order to do so. There are several accounts of this happening; "As they were going along the road, someone said to him, 'I will follow you wherever you go.' And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head" (Luke 9:57-58). He was homeless, and few people loved Him enough to suffer with Him. Through His life, He knew the ultimate suffering of the cross was coming and He even told His disciples, "The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised" (Luke 9:21). He lived knowing many people would reject Him, rejecting the possibility of eternal life, that He would be betraved, and suffer a painful death condemned as a guilty man, despite living an innocent life.

What Does the Title "Man of Sorrows" Teach Us about the Character of God?

That Jesus was a man of many sorrows is a matter of simple fact, but it is also much more than that. I can't tell you how much comfort there is in this historical truth. "For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin" (Heb 4:15). Because He experienced pain and suffering. He is able to help us through our pains. Despite the many sorrows of His life, Jesus loved those around Him. He reached out to others, giving of Himself, serving instead of being served. Ultimately, those many sorrows led Him to the cross. His death on the cross is what paid the price each person should pay for the sins they have committed against God. After all this suffering, He rose up from the grave, fully alive, and providing for those who accept Him as Lord and Savior to follow Him into eternal life, where there will be everlasting joy. He
