5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 20TH MARCH, 2022

THEME: HAVE YOU BEEN TO JESUS?

**READINGS: PSALM 115:1-7; GENESIS 7:17-24;
COL. 1:24-29; LUKE 9:18-27.**

1. Happy Sunday in the Name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Welcome to another Sunday, a day of worship and fellowship. Please keep the two 'ships' on voyage always. 1John 1:3 highlights that our fellowship is with one another and with God. As we interact with God, we also interact with one another. There is indeed a social angle to being in Church as the body of Christ. No one should miss that. We are socio-spiritual!
2. Our theme for today is a question and we all need to answer. Have we been to Jesus? Question is not putting you on the spot but quietly pleading and hoping your answer would be positive. Maybe you are like me when I saw the theme. I started to sing that very ancient and modern hymn; *"Have you been to Jesus for the cleansing power? Are you washed in the blood of the lamb? Are you fully trusting in His grace this hour? Are you washed in the blood of the lamb?"* There is always a trilling flow of quiet excitement in me when the hymn is rendered. It brings a refreshing feeling.
3. WILL YOU ANSWER? The answer can be a 'YES' or a 'NO' but you should answered it? If you have been to Jesus, great! If you haven't, you have wasted too much time and I plead with you to leave what you are doing right now and get to Jesus. Luckily, he is not hard to find. Matthew 7:7-8 says *"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened"* Then Jesus goes on to say in Matthew 11:28 *"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest"*. I picked a line from one of the common sayings of the Dean, "everyone comes to Jesus eventually, either

voluntarily, i.e while alive or compulsorily when dead". Now, the latter is scary if someone refuses to go to Jesus when alive! John 3:18 says *"He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God"*.

4. WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO COME TO JESUS? It means many things, yet one particular thing. SALVATION. Being to Jesus means reconciling with God; getting saved. John 14:6 *"Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me"* The only reason Jesus came into this world is to save us. When we go to Jesus, that's what we primarily go to get. There are a million more other things in Jesus – what I call the 'treasures and pleasures of salvation'. They are derivatives of salvation. Nicodemus, a prominent member of the Sanhedrin, the Jewish Supreme Court, secretly visited Jesus Christ at night because he suspected he was the Messiah promised to Israel by God (John 3:1-10). Before him, four men came to Jesus in John Chapter 1:35-50. They were simple men with no big titles. In fact, two of them were John the Baptist's disciples.
5. WHO CAN COME TO JESUS? Anybody can come to Jesus. We just saw the examples of Nicodemus, a high ranking member of the Sanhedrin and that of Andrew, Peter, Philip and Nathaniel – simple men. Jesus's call is to everyone and anyone. It is to the great and mighty as well as to men beaten by hard life. It is to the rich and the poor. It is to the strong and weak. It is to Northerners, Southerners, Westerners and Easterners. It is to men and women. It is to both old and young. The invitation is not sectional, sectarian or selective in nature. It is all-inclusive. In fact, the parable of the feast in Matthew 22:1-14 is about the universalism of the call of Jesus. The dirtiest of men can come to Jesus. The most brutal criminal can come to Jesus. It is Jesus resolve not to turn anyone back. *"All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me"* (John 6:37-38).

6. WHAT MAY STOP ANYONE FROM COMING TO JESUS? If we despise or neglect this great a salvation, how can we escape....? This is the cry of the writer of the book of Hebrews (Heb 2:3). Many things are stopping people from coming to Jesus but none is excusable! a) Gain of this world – Mark 8:36. b) Love of this world – 1 John 2:15. c) Pride of Life - 1 John 2:16. d) Lust of the eye – 1 John 2:16. e) Pride of life - 1 John 2:16. All these are caused by the deceit of the devil and blindness to the Truth. Blindness to the Truth (Jesus) is a life in utter darkness.

7. WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF COMING TO JESUS? We can capture these with Psalm 103:1-12. It shows some of the amazing benefits of choosing to follow Jesus;

- He forgives your sins and offers you eternal life
- He redeems your life from the pit, crowns you with love and compassion, and restores your soul
- He satisfies your desires with good things (His blessings are tailor-made for you)
- He does not treat you as you deserve to be treated (based on your sins) or repay you according to your iniquities (even though your sins separate you from Him for eternity)
- He is patient with you and loves you greatly (His love never gives up on you)
- He removes your transgressions as far as the east is from the west
- He has compassion on you (just as a father has compassion on his children) and adopts you into His family and kingdom

8. We can come back to the last Stanza of the Hymn we started with. It says, "*Lay aside the garments that are stained with sin, And be washed in the blood of the Lamb; There's a fountain flowing for the soul unclean, O be washed in the blood of the Lamb*". I believe that the comfort and the self-actualization we all seek in this life are all in Jesus Christ. He gives us in safe measures so as not to take our eyes off him. Much more than these is the Eternal Life. He calls it Abundant Life, which is an unending and eternal overflow of spiritual blessings. WHAT ELSE CAN ANYONE BE WAITING FOR? Lay aside the hindering garments and come to Jesus.
