5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK **SUNDAY, 27TH MARCH, 2022**

THEME: TRANSFORMED INTO HIS IMAGE
READINGS: PSALM 18:27-28; EXODUS 34:29-35;
II COL. 3:4-18; MATTHEW 17:1-13.

We thank God for the privilege of witnessing this year 2022 Mothering Sunday. Mothering Sunday is a day for special celebration of motherhood and honouring of mothers and mother figures in the world. Therefore we rejoice with all the Mothers in the world on the occasion of this year Mothering Sunday. Motherhood is a divine privilege. It is a call for divine partnership with God in moulding life on earth.

Being a mother means more than giving birth to a child. It is about a very special love for the child, which shows in a sacrificial duty to the child, which starts in carrying the baby in the womb to passing through pains to give birth to him, feeding, nurturing, caring, protecting, providing for, training, teaching and watching him grow. Being a mother is, therefore, mainly in playing a role – a very important role. That is why not all women are mothers. Mothers are women who have children that they lovingly and carefully raise or “mother.” The children can be biological, foster, step, social spiritual, etc. Being a mother, therefore, is being an embodiment of love.

Today's call is a call to be conformed to the image of Christ. This simply means- to follow and become like Jesus, who was like the Father. For the Christians, heaven is not a goal; it is a destination. The goal is that “Christ be *formed* in you”. Jesus is our identity, and He lives His life through us, so our chief purpose in this life is to be like Him. In our daily walk with Jesus we learn from Him and His spirit is helping us do His will over our own will.

Just as Paul declares, “Those whom [God] foreknew he also predestined to be *conformed* to the image of his son” (8:29). And to the Corinthians, he says, “All of us, with unveiled faces, seeing the glory of the Lord as though reflected in a mirror, are being *transformed* into the same image” (2 Cor. 3:18) Thus the daring goal of the Christian life could be summarized as our being formed, conformed, and transformed into the image of Jesus Christ. And the wonder in all this is that Jesus Christ has come among his people as our everliving Savior, Teacher, Lord, and Friend.

It is a fact that God has predestined us to be conformed or shaped into the image of Christ. First we need a transformation. For certain, we should “*not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect*” (Rom 12:2), but who does this transforming? It is not us. It is God's Spirit that is shaping us, molding us, and forming us into the same image or likeness of Jesus Christ. Of course, we'll not have the same glory that He has, but we should be living so much like Christ that if a person who had never met Christ saw you, they'd think it was Christ by the way you acted and the way you lived.

We are admonished to *“Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men”* (Phil 2:5-7), and so *“he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross”* (Phil 2:8). If you are being transformed into the image of Christ, then you are becoming more like Christ and Christ humbled Himself to the point of death on a cross, so how can we not humble ourselves before Him? We need to have “this [same] mind among” ourselves.

Don't lose heart if the transformation doesn't happen right away. We must know it's not an overnight thing. It's a lifelong process, much like sanctification is. That's why *“we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day”* (2nd Cor 4:16) by God's Spirit. He is both working in us and through us, meaning we are active participants, meaning we must **work out our own salvation** with fear and trembling (Phil 2:12), so we're not to just let God do it all for us. It is only God *“who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy”* (Jude 1:24), but we must strive to live a life of holiness and be blameless before God. That's what it means to be transformed into the image of Christ. God's Spirit works in us as we work out our own salvation, and day by day, we (should) become more like Christ.

To be conformed to the image of Jesus we must:

1. SEE the image of Jesus: We have to know the Jesus. It's through the scripture, particularly the gospels, that the Holy Spirit SHOWS us the life of Jesus. We learn what Jesus valued, what He taught, how He treated people, how He obeyed God. We must spend time with Jesus through the word of God in order to behold His image. Only when we see Him, can we begin to be changed so as to be like Him.
2. DESIRE the image of Jesus: Let's face it, our lives are filled with distractions. There are people and things in each of our lives that influence both our minds and our hearts. Like it or not, these things naturally conform us into their images instead of Jesus'. So we must pray, and put ourselves in environments that we would grow a desire to be more like Jesus daily. (John 6:66-69)
3. PURSUE the Image of Jesus: Once we see the image of Jesus, and God helps us desire the image of Jesus, we must choose to pursue the image of Jesus. Just like any goal you have in life, being more like Jesus requires hard work. We must strive after Him, always pursuing and wanting Him more, even when discouragement and failure come. The refreshing part about conforming to the image of Jesus is that God's power works in us, along with our striving to accomplish His purpose. (Philippians 1:6)

Beloved, being transformed into the image of Christ is not easy but not impossible. We can't abide in Christ if we're not abiding in His Word (John 15:1-5), so even though it's hard it's certainly possible, but not by ourselves. It takes the Spirit of God and being in the Word of God to become more like the Living Word of God, Jesus Christ. Until next week, remain blessed.
