**READINGS: PSALM 119:1-8; GENESIS 2:7-9,
3:1-7; JAMES 1:2-19; MATTHEW 4:1-11.**

TEXT: **Matt 4:11 NKJV** " Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him".

James 1:12 AMP "Blessed (happy, to be envied) is the man who is patient under trial and stands up under temptation, for when he has stood the test and been approved, he will receive [the victor's] crown of life which God has promised to those who love Him.

INTRODUCTION

Temptation is as old as, well, the Garden of Eden. The devil, in the form of the serpent, tempted our first parents, Adam and Eve. They fell for the lie, which flattered them, and were led into the trap of death and loss. The rest of the Bible unfurls the redemptive plan of God in Christ.

Temptation is the intentional enticement of a person, by some bait—usually pride, always self-gratifying—to disobey God’s revealed Word. The predicate may be demonic or fleshly, but the object is always the distortion of God’s world and the defiance of God’s mission in the world.

“TEMPTA'TION, n. The act of tempting; enticement to evil by arguments, by flattery, or by the offer of some real or apparent good”. *Definitions from Webster's American Dictionary of the English Language, 1828.*

Our Lord Jesus, the “second Adam” was “led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by satan” (Matthew 4:1). Though led by the Lord, the Savior was tempted by the Devil (Mark 1:13, Matthew 4:1-11, Luke 4:1-13). Satan sought to appeal to Jesus’ divinity and humanity in his trickery in these three ways:

- Satan ordered Jesus to make bread to fill the appetite for food.
- The Devil ordered Jesus to leap from the pinnacle of the Temple to demonstrate His power of saving Himself.
- Finally, Satan offered the Lord Jesus all the kingdoms of the world if only Christ would fall down and worship Satan.

Where Adam and Eve failed, Jesus triumphed. And the victory in the wilderness is not only a sign of reversal of Eden, but of the failure by Israel in the wilderness, and the very fall of mankind.

The scene revealed to us from the gospel of today's reading (Matthew 4:1-11) where Jesus Christ was led up into the wilderness to be tempted by satan, was **to bring to our consciousness as believer the mode (1 John 1:16) and ways temptation will come to us and how to overcome such. The Lord permit and drezt limit for every temptation that comes every believer to achieve the following :**

1. Temptations highlight our ungodly desires (James 1:14-15: Hebrew 12:4-8)

Our struggles with temptation show us the areas of our flesh we have yet to submit to God. It's a way God uses to train and discipline us so that we grow in godliness because He loves us.

2. Temptations test our commitment to God 1 Thessalonians 3:5

Temptations are always a test of our faith. Satan will try to lure us away from our commitment to God.

Let's look at the example of Joseph, who was sold into slavery in Egypt (**Genesis 39:7-10**) Every sin we commit is an affront to God's perfect design and law. Joseph knew to stay loyal to God's will, rather than give in to his own fleshly desires, because he had a healthy fear of God. Joseph did not refuse because his master's wife was undesirable or because he lacked sexual desires. He resisted the sexual temptation because He was committed to his God. Joseph proved that his commitment to God came first and his faith was genuine.

2 Corinthians 13:5 NLT Examine yourselves to see if your faith is genuine. Test yourselves. Surely you know that Jesus Christ is among you; if not, you have failed the test of genuine faith.

3. Temptations build our resilience Romans 5:3-5 Hebrew 12:4

Our resistance against temptations is like a form of "weightlifting" that builds our spiritual strength and resilience. Lifting physical weights can feel uncomfortable as it causes tiny micro-tears in our muscle fibers. But as our sore muscles repair naturally, they grow bigger and stronger. A reasonable amount of muscle strain and damage is therefore helpful and, in fact, necessary for increasing our physical strength and

4. Temptations teach us to rely on God's Word :

No human being is able to overcome our ungodly desires on his or her own strength. Even if our spirit is willing, our flesh is weak. Most of us have tried to talk ourselves out of sinning and found that it was only effective for a while. Soon, Satan bombards us with more temptations till our resolve grows weaker and weaker.

Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.”

Temptations are spiritual battles and need to also be fought spiritually, not just mentally. It is only with the help of the sword of the Holy Spirit, the Bible, that we can fend off our enemy.

OVERCOMING TEMPTATION

In a word, the best recourse for temptation is to be delivered from it by faith in Christ. “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you” (James 4:7 ESV). Faith is not merely a passive clinging to our justification (a one-time event), but rather a militant faith that acts, that seeks sanctification—becoming more like Christ. Temptation dies when the steel teeth of the trap are unmasked. Temptation loses its power when the love of Jesus Christ satisfies our desires.

And I know that if you have been tested and failed, like Peter (Matthew 26:69-75), or tempted and trapped, like so many others, God's grace and love covers a multitude of sins. Jesus Christ loves you. He lived the life you could never live. He died the death that should have been ours. And He offers eternal life and abundant life for all who turn to Him. This message of the Gospel is, in itself, the best defense against the power of temptation.

All you need to do is, embrace genuine repentance and you will be restored. Have a blessed week ahead, shalom!!!
