5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 24th APRIL, 2022

THEME: BEYOND HUMAN/MILITARY PROWESS READINGS: LUKE 24: 1-12, MATTHEW 28:1-10; 1 Peter 1:3-9, EXODUS 15:1-11

Introduction: As with some other parts of the scriptures, there are myths and questions around the resurrection of Jesus. Some till today still ask the question, is the resurrection of Jesus true? They ask this question because their knowledge of the Power of God is either shallow or completely non-existent. No man can rationalize how Jesus rose from the dead. This life changing event took place by the power of God. Something beyond the prowess of men. Because of the prophecies around His death and resurrection, the bible told us the kind of security that was put in place just to make sure that it does not happen. The Roman soldiers sealed the tomb. Then, they stood guard for the next three days in four-hour shifts of four soldiers each. How many Roman soldiers were involved we do not know, but it could have been as many as 50 or more and also a number of soldiers from the temple guard, i.e. Jewish soldiers who worked at the Temple. The stone that closed the entrance was very big and was rolled in a channel. This channel was sloped so it was easy to close but hard to open (Matthew 27:62-66).

Nothing Can Stop the Power and the Move of God

As the holy women went towards the sepulcher in the twilight of the morning, desirous to embalm the body of Jesus, they recollected that the huge stone at the door of the tomb would be a great impediment in their way, and they said one to another, "Who shall roll us away the stone?" The guards at the tomb of Jesus had also thought that some people would probably come to take his body away, hence, the security arsenal put in place. But we find that from the Scripture, it came about by the power of God such that the soldiers on guard became like dead men.

There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men (Matthew 28:2-4). The women came to the tomb of Christ, but it was empty, for Jesus had risen. All the forces combined could not stop Jesus from rising.

The Chief Priests Tried to cover it up!

Upon being informed by the Roman guards of what happened at Jesus' tomb, they should have realized that Jesus indeed had risen from the dead as He had prophesied. Since that proves Jesus' deity, they should have been wailing in repentance for what they had done against God and begging Him for forgiveness and mercy, not bribing the Roman guards to try to cover up what happened at the tomb. Some of the guard came into the city and reported to the chief priests all the things that had happened. When they had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, saying, "Tell them, 'His disciples came at night and stole Him away while we slept.' And if this comes to the governor's ears, we will appeare him and make you secure." So they took the money and did as they were instructed; and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day (Matthew 28: 11-15). It is amazing that the roman soldiers became testifiers of this move of God. Even though the Chief Priests, tried to cover it up, they could not.

That Same Power!

The Dean by the leading of God told us that the 40days after the celebration of Easter are days of Revelations. And one of the Revelations you must have is the fact that the power that raised Jesus from the dead, is in you as a Child of God. But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness. And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you (Romans 8:10-11). Paul tells us that you have the very same spirit that raised Jesus Christ from the dead living inside of us. This is an amazing revelation! Ephesians chapter 1 gives us more detail on this truth, "...and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like the working of his mighty strength, which he exerted in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come" (Ephesians 1:19-21). Do you know that the grave could not hold Jesus? The darkness tried to keep hold of him, but this power that raised him from the dead was so great that it could do nothing but release him. Up through the heavenly realm Jesus ascended triumphing over every power, authority and dominion that tried to hold him in darkness and is seated as first born from the dead at the right hand of the father in heaven. Paul is stressing the incomparable victory that we have in Jesus. We are alive in every way! If the Spirit of God raised Christ from the dead, then that very same spirit who lives inside of us will also give live to our mortal bodies. It is already done in the spiritual realm and we also experience this in the natural realm because our redemption is so complete and eternal through Christ Jesus. Paul was so convinced and assured of this that he wrote at the end of this chapter that he was convinced that nothing was able to separate us from the love that was in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:37-39). Why was he convince? Because he saw what had already been accomplished for us by Jesus. He knew that if it existed in the spiritual realm then it would exist in the natural as well. So today, no matter what you are going through in life, you can be rest assured by faith that you have victory in Christ. These things have been provided for you. And if they've been provided for you, then they are yours for the taking. Paul said in II Corinthians 4, "Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal (2Corinthians 4:16-18).
