# 5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 3<sup>RD</sup> APRIL, 2022

THEME: THE OLD AND THE NEW COVENANTS READINGS: PSALM 22:23-29; JEREMIAH 31:31-34; HEBREWS 9:11-14; JOHN 12:20-32.

It is in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ that we welcome the entire congregation of this great Cathedral to the presence of God on this first Sunday of the fourth month of the year 2022 and fifth Sunday in the penitential season of Lent. It is our prayer that the mercy and love of God that brought us this far in our journey through the year shall continue to tabernacle with us and see us to the end of it in the name of Jesus. Amen.

The theme of our meditation today is The Old and the New Covenants, and because the topic has been thoroughly treated in the Diocesan Lenten Manual, which majority of us hopefully have, the focus is herein shifted to how we can appropriate the inherent benefits of the New Covenant which came in as a result of the inadequacies of the Old one.

A covenant is a relationship initiated by God to which a body of people responds in faith. The two most prominent Covenants that guide the Christian faith are the Old Covenant and the New Covenant.

The Old Covenant is the one given by God to the Israelites in which He promised that they would be His people to bring all the nations of the world to him. In this Covenant, God required the chosen people to be faithful; to do justice, to love mercy and to walk humbly with Him.

The Old Covenant, as the name goes, is to be found in the books which we call the old Testament. The rules guiding this commandment are shown most clearly in the Ten Commandments.

The New Covenant, on the other hand, is the new relationship with God given by Jesus Christ the Messiah to the Apostles; and, through them, to all who believe in Him.

Christ the Messiah in this Covenant promised to bring us (believers) into the Kingdom of God and give us life in all its fullness, but however commands us to believe in Him and keep His commandments.

"Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah .... but this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more." (Jeremiah 31:31-34; NKJV)

The Bible in Hebrews 9:15 tells us that Christ is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance. Since eternal life comes through Christ of the New Covenant, it behoves us to care about how we should live under this Covenant that offers life in the place of death.

The most essential principles guiding the New Covenant are the Summary of the Law and the New Commandment as taught and given to us by Jesus Christ.

The summary of the Law teaches that we should love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our mind and with all our strength; and also love our neighbours as ourselves. More like a corollary to the Summary of the Law is The New Commandment which teaches us to love one another as Christ loved us. (John 13:34)

From this Summary and the New Commandment, one can reasonably say that living under the New Covenant means living in love for God and mankind.

Principles for Living a Life of Love:

We love God because He first loved us. God's action of manifesting His love to us through His Son demonstrates the truth that love must be exercised. Since God acted in love toward us, believers must act likewise by showing godly love to others through the following means among others:

- i. Practical Love (1 John 3:11, 16-18; 4:7-21; Ephesians 5:2; 1Corinthians 13; John 15:17) God's love to us is the greatest love possible. We should, in turn, show our love for others by our words and actions.
- ii. Giving (2 Corinthians 9:6-8; Proverbs 3:9-10; Luke 6:38) We should give cheerfully to God the first part of all we earn. We should also give to others unselfishly.
- iii. Evangelism and Mission (Psa1m 126:5-6; Matthew 28:18-20; Romans 1:16-17; 2 Corinthians 5:11-21). We should be busy telling others about the love of God and His plan of salvation. We should share in the work of foreign missionaries by our giving and prayers.
- iv. Communication (Ephesians 4:22-29; Colossians 4:6; James 3:2-13; Isaiah 50.4) We should have control of our tongues so that we will not say things displeasing to God. We should encourage others and be kind and helpful in what we say.
- v. Friendliness (Proverbs 18:24; 17:17; Psalm 119:63) We should be friendly to others, and we should be loyal to those who love and serve God.
