**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 10th APRIL, 2022**

THEME: LEARNING FROM JESUS CHRIST

**READINGS: PSALM 24; ZECH. 9:9-12; ISAIAH
50:4-9; PHIL. 2:5-11; MATTHEW 21:1-13.**

Today, Christians around the world are celebrating Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem (which we usually call "Palm Sunday," because the crowd welcomed Him by spreading palm branches in His path). Those who greeted Him were convinced He was the Messiah (or "anointed one"), sent by God to establish His Kingdom on earth, though they later misunderstood the purpose of His coming and they shouted "crucify Him"

The people of Israel had always understood Zechariah's prophecy to refer to the Messiah, to God's anointed king. The prophet said: "Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey" (Zechariah 9:9). When Jesus mounted the donkey—not just any donkey, but specifically a pure-bred colt, as Zechariah promised—he was presenting himself as Israel's promised king. By his actions, he was saying, "Behold, thy king cometh unto thee."

The Jews knew their Bibles, and many people in the crowd would have remembered the words of Zechariah and recognized what Jesus was doing. Some of them may have even remembered that when Solomon became Israel's king, he was presented on the donkey of his father David (1 Kings 1:38-39). One clue that the people of Jerusalem recognized this connection is that, when they saw Jesus riding on the foal of a donkey, they said, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" (Matthew 21:9). In any case, by using that title, they were acclaiming Jesus to be their rightful king. They recognized that he had come "in the name of the Lord!" (Matthew 21:9; Psalm 118:26).

Although it is often overlooked, there is an even older prophecy that explains why Jesus rode a donkey. Long before Zechariah, Jacob pronounced this blessing on his son Judah: "The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his. He will tether his donkey to a vine, his colt to the choicest branch" (Gen. 49:10-11a). Jacob's prophecy meant that Israel's true king would come from the tribe of Judah, and that in some way he would be associated with the colt of a donkey. What is only hinted at in Genesis was made plain in the Gospel: Jesus, the Son of David, from the tribe of Judah, rode into Jerusalem as Israel's rightful king.

However, if Jesus is the king, then all his loyal subjects must recognize his kingship. The Jews did this by calling him the Son of David, and also by spreading their cloaks before him. This was the ancient custom; people threw down their garments to make a carpet for the royal procession. As we mark His triumphal entry today, however, we are also simply saying:

- We recognize his sovereignty by laying our hearts before him,
- We throw down our wills in absolute surrender,
- We are asking Jesus to govern everything we think and say and do and
- We then praise him as our rightful king.
- We recognize Him as The Messiah who has come not to be saved, but to save.

There are many reasons the triumphal entry of Jesus was important.

- 1) It serves as a fulfillment of prophecy of Zech 9:9, and recognition of His role.
- 2) It prepared the way for the events that led to His death and resurrection.

4) Jesus' arrival during this time of Passover week led to much attention in the city. Matthew 21:10-11 notes, "And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, 'Who is this?' And the crowds said, 'This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee.

5) The Entry simply reminds us that Christ started in glory and honor but then takes those steps downward, each step with careful deliberation and sacrifice, thereby reminding us that Christian walk is humble service. It is true we want all the glory and prosperity now. We want the victory and press releases now. This is not the Gospel. The Gospel carefully lays before us the path down.

6) The Triumphal Entry poignantly alerts us to Christ's glory and reminds us of the steps down He is taking. The Christian walk on earth must be one of laying aside the pursuit of self. Like Christ our Master, we deliberately choose to take these downward steps. We willingly forsake our selves so that we can choose God and prefer others. Note how elegantly the apostle recorded this descent.

"Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself; do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross" (Philippians 2:3-8).

The Christian life is to be characterized by humble service. Christ's humble attitude is to be our attitude toward life. We are now to put our serving towel on and wipe the disciples' feet. As Christians we are privileged to share in Christ's humble but loving life.

7) The Triumphal Entry reminds us that each Christian who would desire the crown must also endure the cross. Repentance has lifelong effects. We live in the humility of the cross so that Christ's love and power might flow in and through us. One day that glorious day will shine, indeed, as it did for Christ on His resurrection day. One day the glorious new day will break forth and we will meet Christ. But our ascent is not yet. Now is our time to share in Christ's humble walk. Now is the time to follow His pathway to the cross. We say "No" to serving our own desires and affirm His will and ways. Christ's path led to denial of self so that He could fulfill God's will. There is no difference for any of us.

8) The Triumphal Entry is our annual reminder or call that a true Christian is one who is willing to forsake the fanfare and successes of life, and has chosen to join Christ in His walk toward Jerusalem.

Conclusion

The story of the triumphal entry is one of contrasts, and those contrasts contain applications to believers. (1) It is the story of the King who came as a lowly servant on a donkey, not a prancing steed, not in royal robes, but on the clothes of the poor and humble.(2) Jesus Christ comes not to conquer by force as earthly kings but by love, grace, mercy, and His own sacrifice for His people. (3) His is not a kingdom of armies and splendor but of lowliness and servanthood. (4) He conquers not nations but hearts and minds. (5) His message is one of peace with God, not of temporal peace. If Jesus has made a triumphal entry into our
