**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 15TH MAY, 2022**

THEME: THE HOLY SPIRIT AT WORK
READINGS: PSALM 1; PROVERBS 4:10-19;
1 COR. 4:14-5:1-5; JOHN 16:5-22.

Christianity is a journey of the Spirit. Much more than our physical daily living are deep spiritual things that define who we are as Christians. From our passage, Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to His disciples when He departed. This is what would make it to their advantage that He departed from them. Jesus meant that the presence and work of the Holy Spirit would actually be better for believers than his physical and bodily presence.

Can this be true? Yes, it is true. This is because the Holy Spirit is not just a force as many taught, but the third Person in the Trinity. There is one God manifested in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit 1 Timothy 3:16. This implies the fact that we don’t just have a spirit with us, we have the REAL GOD with us, working in us as Holy Spirit. Just as Jesus Christ is God in Man, so also the Holy Spirit is God in Spirit.

The work of the Holy Spirit is of two ways.

His work in the world. John16: 8-11

His work among the believers-John 16: 12-15

1. The work of the Holy Spirit in the world. John 16:8-11

“And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: of sin, because they do not believe in Me; of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.”

- a. He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Sin is the truth about man, righteousness is the truth about God, judgment is the inevitable combination of: The ancient Greek word translated convict has a broader range of meaning than simply our word convict, especially as it is understood in a legal sense. It also carries the ideas to *expose*, to *refute*, and to *convince*. This is the work of the Holy Spirit in the world and in individual hearts; to convince and convict the world of sin. Before the

- b. convicting work of the Holy Spirit one may say, *I make a lot of mistakes. Nobody's perfect.* After the convicting work of the Holy Spirit one may say, *I'm a lost rebel, fighting against God and His law – I must rely on Jesus to get right with God.*
- c. Each man's conscience has some glimmering of light on each of these; *some* consciousness of guilt, *some* sense of right, *some* power of judgment of what is transitory and worthless; but all these are unreal and unpractical, till the convicting work of the Spirit has wrought in him. The Spirit does not merely accuse men of sin, he brings to them an inescapable sense of guilt so that they realize their shame and helplessness before God.
- d. **Of sin, because they do not believe in Me:** It is unbelief, the rejection of Jesus, which ultimately proves one to be guilty. The Holy Spirit will tell the world of the importance of trusting in, relying on, and clinging to Jesus to avoid this sin.

2. **Of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged: The judgment of Satan himself means that there will be a final reckoning between God and His rebellious creature. The Holy Spirit warns the world of this coming judgment The work of the Holy Spirit among the Believers-John 16: 12-15**

"I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you."

- A. I still have many things to say to you:** Jesus frankly admitted that His own teaching was incomplete, and anticipated the further instruction of the church by the Holy Spirit.

B. He will guide you into all truth: In another sense the Holy Spirit continues today to personally lead us into truth, but *never* in opposition to the Scripture, because God's supremely authoritative revelation is closed with the New Testament.

i. Into all truth: "The Greek means 'all *the* truth', i.e. the specific truth about the Person of Jesus and the significance of what He said and did. The New Testament is permanent evidence that the apostles were guided into truth about this.

C. He will not speak on His own authority... He will glorify Me... He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. It is essential that we see that the work of the Spirit of God is never divorced from Jesus Christ or the Word of God. "He shall testify of Me" (John 15:26); "He shall glorify Me" (John 16:14). People who claim that the Spirit of God led them to do things contrary to the example of Christ or the teaching of the Word are mistaken and are being led astray by Satan. Jesus is the truth (John 14:6), and the Word is truth (John 17:17), and the Holy Spirit is "the Spirit of Truth" Where the Holy Spirit is at work, there must be truth.

D. The Holy Spirit As Helper: The Holy Spirit is a helper Who comes alongside us to guide us in our Christian walk (John 14:16).

E. The Holy Spirit As Teacher: The Holy Spirit is our Teacher (John 14:26, 1 John 2:27, 1 Corinthians 2:13,14).

i. When we are born again, we enter the dimension of the Spirit. In this dimension, we can be taught by Him to understand the things of God that are beyond the reach of our experience or intellect (2 Corinthians 4:18).

ii. The Holy Spirit brings the Scriptures that we have read or heard to our remembrance (John 14:26). It is so good to have the right Scripture come to mind when we need it.

F. The Holy Spirit As Guide: The Holy Spirit will guide us into all truth (John 16:12-13).

i. He will give us the discernment to judge between true and false teachings.

ii. If we will open our hearts and read the Bible with the Spirit as our Guide, we will not stray from the truth and we will have all we need to live the Christian life (2 Peter 1:3).

Beloved, more than anything else, we need the Holy Spirit in us. Without Him, we can do but nothing. May the Lord help us.
