THEME: DIVINE TURN AROUND

READINGS: PSALM 71:16-24; ROMANS 6:3-11; DEUTERONOMY 6:17-25; JOHN 15:5-11.

Ps 71:20-21 NKJV” You, who have shown me great and severe troubles, Shall revive me again, And bring me up again from the depths of the earth. You shall increase my greatness, And comfort me on every side”.

Ps 71:20-21 NIV “Though you have made me see troubles, many and bitter, you will restore my life again; from the depths of the earth you will again bring me up. You will increase my honor and comfort me once again.

INTRODUCTION

A turnaround is a development or change that results in a favorable and beneficial outcome.

Divine turnaround is when God steps into a specific situation to reverse the circumstance abruptly, turning it into a positive experience that is beyond human and scientific explanation.

Divine Turnaround is where a situation is heading in a certain direction with a predicted outcome and that situation is suddenly intervened by a divine supernatural force that causes the outcome to be the opposite.

Divine turn around involve a divine encounter, where God reverses circumstances; turn around the negative into positive and shifts thoughts and life new directions.

The writer in the chosen text for this discussion, explain his believe in the sovereignty, capability, ability and power of God to change situations and circumstances at will from worst to best. Biblically, divine turn around includes the following:

- **From Sin to Salvation** (John 3:16AMP, Acts 16:30-31 NLT, 2 Cor. 5:17). Examples of this dimension of Divine Turn Around is Paul’s conversion (from **Persecutor to Preacher**) Acts 9, 22,26; Gal.1:11-24 . This is the first kind of Divine turn around every one that gather in the church must have experienced (**SALVATION STORY and EXPERIENCE**) before you will be called a **CHRISTIAN indeed.**
- **Deadness to Life** (2 kings 4: 18-37;13:20-21;Ezekiel 37:1-12; Mark 16:1-8; John 11;Acts 9:36-43; Romans 6:9-10). The deadness nature of the dry bones turn around into Exceeding Great Army by the breath of the Almighty (**Ezekiel 37:1-12**). **Irrespective of the deadness or hopeless your present situation may be Our God has the ability and capability to turn it around.**
- **Sorrow to Joy** (Isaiah 61: 1-3 AMP, Psalm 30:11 GNS , Jer. 31:13). There are examples in the bible of God’s power to turn around situations classified as **SORROW** suddenly to **JOY** by His interventions: as a nation (Israel Exodus 14:10-12; 15:1-21;2 Kings 6:24-7:1-end) individual (Luke 5:1-9;7:11-17;8:41-56).

- **Addictions/Oppressions to Redemption** (Psalm 34:19-20; 2 Cor. 5:17 AMP; James 4:7-10 MSG). The testimony about Mary Magdalene is one of evidences of God's power to deliver from any form of addiction or oppression. (Luke 8:1-2).
- **Poverty to prosperity** (Deut. 15:4-5 AMP , Psalms 35:27)

Brethren, if you will experience and enjoy **DIVINE TURN AROUND** in your life especially in your present predicament the following is **VERY IMPORTANT**:

1. ABSOLUTE TRUST IN GOD Mark 9:23, Mark 10:27

Have faith that only God can turn your situation around. You must have a violent faith to provoke a turnaround in your life's situation. Violent faith is aggressive, persistent, like a bulldog, it seizes with a grip and does not let go (see Mark 5:25-34, Mark 10:47-48 TLB). When Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was coming, he yelled louder, despite the world telling him to be quiet Faith will help you to decide that you are dissatisfied with your current situation and to move forward- (2 kings 7:3-7, 1 Samuel 1:9)Gloria Copeland said: if you let go, it's gone!

The man who trusts in God is not passively waiting – he moves, the man who trusts God does not listen to NO from the doctors, employers, economic situations Every situation is an opportunity to trust God. The widow and Bartimaeus were both tired of their situations, both applied nonstop, constant, continual, steady, relentless pressure on their covenant and on the devil. They did not let go! You must be desperate for a turnaround

2. OBEDIENCE TO DIVINE INSTRUCTIONS - 2 Kings 5:14, Ezekiel 37:7,10; Luke 5:5, John 2:5

To have a divine turnaround in a situation, you must obey the Lord at all cost, the Lord will always give specific instructions that will lead to your breakthrough. The instruction may not make sense, obey anyway. Avoid partial obedience, like king Saul in 1 Samuel 15:2-3, 7-11, 22 when God through the prophet Samuel instructed him to kill the enemy nation and he kept some. He lost his throne at that time.

3. ENGAGE IN THE MYSTERY OF WORD BASED PRAYER,(2 Chronicle 20:1-10, Psalm 18.Isaiah 38:1-8): prayer is agreeing with God on His covenant. Your prayer must be faith and word based.

It was the prayer of the saints that brought Peter out of prison. Paul and Silas prayed and sang and the chains broke and doors opened. Prayer can open doors and breaks chains. Regardless of what the situation is, please pray especially in the Spirit. Prayer brings strange intervention.

Sin is a barrier to reaching God – Hosea 7:1. Joseph witnessed turnaround because he refused to sin against God- Genesis 39:9. Confess and turn away from sin immediately
