**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 5<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2022**

**THEME: THE PROMISED HOLY SPIRIT**  
**READINGS: PSALM 130; JOEL 2:28-32; ACTS 2:1-21; JOHN 20:19-31.**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

Happy Sunday Beloved of God. Big congratulations to us all for witnessing this year’s Pentecost Sunday. A day we commemorate the outpouring of God’s Spirit on the Church. Since that experience, the Church has not remained the same. I believe right here, right now, God can pour out his Spirit on as many as are ready for him. Jesus said in Luke 24:49 *“Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high.”* God cannot lie. It is impossible for God to lie. “God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that he should repent. Has he said, and will he not do? Or has he spoken, and will he not” Numbers 23:19. Every covenant he makes with man is underpinned with a promise. The strength of the Covenant is in the promise. The Covenant of his Spirit was given right in the Old Testament, notably in Ezekiel and Joel

- **Ezekiel 36:26-28** says *“And I will give you a new heart, and put a new spirit within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and will give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit in the midst of you: and I will cause you to walk in my commandments, and to keep my judgments, and do them. And you shall dwell in the land which I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God”*
- **Joel 2: 28** says *“And it shall come to pass after this, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy: your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions”*

**2. IN THE OLD TESTAMENT**

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of God and has been from eternity and will remain eternally. He operated in the Old Testament but unlike the way he operates now. He would come momentarily for specific assignments. In our dispensation, right from the Pentecost of Acts 2, the Holy Spirit has been with us permanently. In Genesis 1:2, he hovered over the surface of the earth. Let’s see some more examples;

- David: So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the Spirit of the Lord came upon David in power. Samuel then went to Ramah. 14 Now the Spirit of the Lord had departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the Lord tormented him (1 Samuel 16:13-14).
- Othniel: The Spirit of the Lord came upon him, so that he became Israel’s judge and went to war. The Lord gave Cushan-Rishathaim king of Aram into the hands of Othniel, who overpowered him (Judges 3:10).
- Gideon: Then the Spirit of the Lord came upon Gideon, and he blew a trumpet, summoning the Abiezrites to follow him (Judges 6:34).



- Jephthah: Then the Spirit of the Lord came upon Jephthah. He crossed Gilead and Manasseh, passed through Mizpah of Gilead, and from there he advanced against the Ammonites (Judges 11:29).
- Samson: And the Spirit of the Lord began to stir him while he was in Mahaneh Dan, between Zorah and Eshtaol (Judges 13:25).

### 3. THE NEED FOR THE HOLY SPIRIT

God saw our need to have His Holy Spirit, otherwise we would be doomed. For this reason, before Jesus ascended to Heaven, he instructed his disciples to tarry in Jerusalem for the promise of the Father. If we don't need the Holy Spirit, God will not make the promise. Imagine if the disciples ventured before they were empowered by the Holy Spirit. Your guess is as good as mine. They would utterly fail. In John 16:7, Jesus said *"But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengtheners, Standby) will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him (the Holy Spirit) to you [to be in close fellowship with you]"* (AMP)

### 4. WORSHIP OF GOD

The promised presence of God is for those who are ready to worship him in spirit and truth. No one will be able to worship God as he desires without his Spirit. John 16:14 *"He will glorify me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you"* Everything we do in worship of God must be in the Spirit for it to be of acceptable quality and impact (1Cor 12:3). When Jesus was physically on earth, he kept on glorifying the Father. In this dispensation of the Holy Spirit, Jesus is glorified only through his Spirit (John 16:14). You can't access God without his Spirit as the Channel. I have tried to talk about this over and over.

Whatever is not done in the Spirit is not acceptable to God. So, if you pray, pray in the Spirit; if you sing in the Spirit; if you dance, dance in the Spirit; if you give your offering, give in the Spirit. GOD IS SPIRIT (John 4:24). The outpouring of the Holy Spirit births a new life in every believer.

### 5. LIVING THE NEW LIFE

Now, let's talk about New Life. New Life is began at our new birth. There is a way John the Baptist put it in Matthew 3:11 *"I baptize you with water for repentance, but after me will come One more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire"* Water and Spirit Baptism are essential entrance pass for those living the New Life (Matthew 28:19-20). Once a sinner confesses his sins and accepts Jesus as the Son of God who came to save mankind, he becomes born again and baptized as a sacrament; outward sign of an inward grace. He is made a saint and starts a new life in Christ. Old things have passed away. All things have become new (2Cor 5:17). Now Baptism in the Holy Spirit is the infilling of the Spirit of God to operate as a child of God with ability to hear God, bear his fruit, receive his gifts and be led by him as Romans 8:14 said, *"For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. ... For whosoever are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God"*

When he says he is with us, he is definitely with us. The implication of this statement is "YOU DON'T NEED ANYTHING OR ANYONE IN MY PLACE. I AM ALL YOU NEED AND CAN EVER NEED". Our prayer regularly must be like the prayer of David in Psalm 51:11 "Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me"

## 7. ACTS OF THE SPIRIT

The Book Acts of the Apostles ideally can be expressed as Acts of the Holy Spirit or simpler put 'Exploits of the Holy Spirit'. If you remove the Holy Spirit from the Book, it becomes very boring and bland. From Chapter two onward, there was a spark like never before in the history of mankind. Men and women were on fire for God. The Holy Spirit comes with fire. The Holy Spirit in us generates fire and power to function in the supernatural. Acts 1:8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth" So, the Apostles were ignited and moving through Jerusalem, to Judea, to Samaria to everywhere possible. If you are willing to operate in the supernatural, allow the Holy Spirit to fill you.

## 8. CONCLUSION

What is important right now is to ask yourself if you have received the Promise of the Father. When people saw what happened to the disciples of Jesus in Acts 2, they were moved to action. "Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do? Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.**" (Acts 2:37-39). So I say, the promised Holy Spirit is for you
