**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK  
SUNDAY, 10<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2022**

**THEME: LIVING AS CHILDREN OF THE LIGHT**

**READINGS: PSALM 119:57-64; EXODUS 20:1-17, EPHESIANS 5:1-10; MATTHEW 6:24-34.**

The theme of light and darkness is prominent throughout the Bible. Darkness symbolizes Satan’s evil domain and the sinful deeds of those who do not obey God. It also represents the spiritual ignorance of those whose sin has blinded their eyes from the light of God’s truth (Eph. 4:18; 2 Cor. 4:4). Light pictures the knowledge of the truth that comes when God shines into our lives. As Paul wrote (2 Cor. 4:6), “For God, who said, ‘Light shall shine out of darkness,’ is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.” Light also pictures the holiness of God (1 John 1:5), who dwells in unapproachable light (1 Tim. 6:16). So as believers, we are called to walk in the light, just as He Himself is in the light (1 John 1:7), living with every area of our lives exposed to God.

Walking "as children of light" means revealing God's light in our daily lives. By our character and conduct, we bring God's light into a dark world. As God's lights, we help others find their way to Christ. The mind of the unsaved person is blinded by Satan (2 Cor 4:3-4) and by sin (Eph 4:17-19). Only as we witness and share Christ can the light enter in just as a healthy person can assist the sickly, so a child of God can lead the lost out of darkness into God's wonderful fight.



Light reveals things; light produces fruit; but light also exposes what is wrong. No surgeon would willingly operate in darkness lest he made a false move and take a life. How could an artist paint a true picture in darkness? The light reveals the truth and exposes the true character of things. This explains why the unsaved person stays clear of the church and the Bible. God's light reveals his true character, and the exposure is not very complimentary. As we Christians walk in light, we refuse to fellowship with the darkness, and we expose the dark things of sin for what they really are.

As children of light in this dark world, we are to expose the deeds of darkness (Eph 5:7, 11-14). In verse 7, Paul says, "Therefore do not be partakers with them." Them refers to the sons of disobedience, who are under God's wrath (5:6). Not being partakers with them is the same thing that Paul explains in 2 Corinthians 6:14-18. Then, in Ephesians 5:11-12, Paul adds, "Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them; for it is disgraceful even to speak of the things which are done by them in secret." We should not be interested in hearing gossip about the movie stars' latest sexual sins. Such talk should repulse us. Instead, Paul says, we should expose such sins. What does he mean?

In the context, he means that by our lives (primarily) and our words (secondarily) we expose the unfruitful deeds of darkness for what they are: disgraceful sin in God's holy presence. Jesus used this word (John 3:20) when He said, "For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be **exposed**." He continues (3:21), "But he who practices the truth comes to the Light, so that his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God."

Are you walking in the light or darkness? Can people close to you still point to deeds of darkness in your life?

Beloved, if we're no different in our thinking, attitudes, words, and behavior than those that do not know Christ, we have no message to give them. If you profess to know Christ, but you're not walking in the light, conforming your life to His Word, then please do not let unbelievers know that you claim to be a Christian! If you're comfortable with your sinful lifestyle, you may not be a genuine Christian. But whether you are or not, don't link the holy name of the Lord with your disobedient lifestyle (2 Sam. 12:14). As you separate yourself from that kind of sinful lifestyle and live to please the Lord with all goodness, righteousness, and truth, your godly life exposes the dirty lives of those around you. May the Lord continue to free us from the deeds of darkness and empower us to live as children of light. Until next week, remain blessed.
