5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 17TH JULY, 2022

THEME: OBEYING GOD UNCONDITIONALLY READINGS: PSALM 119:17-32; GENESIS 12:1-9, ROMANS 12:1-8: LUKE 15:11-32.

A. INTRODUCTION

Obedience is an act of surrender. It is when we say "not my will Lord, but your will and align our actions with that will. Every parent wants to instill unquestioning obedience into his child. Success, safety and life depend on it. Obedience is an act of worship as it demonstrates our love, trust and regards for God. It is a crucial Christian discipline for anyone who wishes to enjoy God. No one can enjoy God who has a conflicting agenda. Obedience is not easy but must be learned. Many times it means taking the higher road doing things that are against our fleshly desires. The greatest example there is to perfect obedience is that of Jesus Christ.

B. THE GREATEST EXAMPLE OF OBEDIENCE

Hebrews 5: 8 - "Although He was a Son, He learned obedience from what He suffered. And having been made perfect, He became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey Him". Jesus always did the Father's will, even when it was painful, like when He expressed in the Garden of Gethsemane the desire to have the cup pass from Him, but he said, "Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done" (Luke 22:42). Jesus said "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work" (John 4:24). The Apostle Paul wrote to the church at Philippi to "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men" Phil 2:5-7, and so Jesus "humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross"

C. WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO OBEY UNCONDITIONALLY?

i. TO LOVE GOD WITHOUT RESERVATIONS: Obeying God is about loving Him. Mark 12:29-30 ... 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength' Release your heart to God. Let it beat for God. You will tremble at his word. Heart is the center of life. Your life will revolve around God. Release your soul to God. You will be ever conscious of his presence and him in all you do. Release your mind to God. Reasoning and decision making will align with the Master's instructions and desire. Release your strength to God. You will use your energy for God's work, not on vain things.

ii. TO SUBMIT TO GOD WHOLLY: Obeying God is about accepting him. First is accepting who God as the potter. Isaiah 64:8. But now, "O Lord, You are our Father, we are the clay, and you our potter; and all of us are the work of your hand". He is the Almighty, without whom no one can amount to anything or become anything. Accepting that he created the whole wide-world and nothing was created and will be created without him. Accepting that he holds the reigns of all things. Accepting that he calls the short. Accepting that he has powers beyond human reasoning and comprehension. Accepting that no one matches his powers. King Nebuchadnezzar realized this and it wasn't difficult to now obey God after encountering him. Before then, he vaunted self. Obeying God is 'me becoming less significant and God becoming more significant'. Second is accepting myself as the clay, the work of his hands. Clay can't question the Potter. In Jeremiah 18:2-6, God said to Jeremiah "Go down to the potter's house, and there I will give you my message. So I went down to the potter's house, and I saw him working at the wheel. But the pot he was shaping from the clay was marred in his hands; so the potter formed it into another pot, shaping it as seemed best to him. Then the word of the Lord came to me. He said, "Can I not do with you, Israel, as this potter does?" declares the Lord. "Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand, Israel.

iii. TO LIVE IN GOD'S SPIRIT: Obeying God without reservations is living life in the Holy Spirit. The spirit of man in total sync with the Spirit of God leaves no room for disobedience. Romans 8:11 - "But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you" The Holy Spirit has the ability to enable our flesh respond to his biddings. Obedient Christians live a robust life in the Holy Spirit. They don't argue with God. They don't wait to consider alternative to the instruction. They have mortified the flesh. "For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God" (Rom 8:13-14). They have modified active listening to the Holy Spirit (Rev 2:9). They keep beating the flesh. You hear them referencing the Holy Spirit every time; 'as the Lord leads'. Spiritual things are not foolishness to them. "The natural man does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God. For they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned" (1Cor 2:14)

D. BENEFITS OF OBEYING GOD UNCONDITIONALLY

Wealth: The path to success is the path of obedience. If you be willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land Isaiah 1:19. In Joshua 1:8, God told Joshua, do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that may be careful to do (obey) everything written in it. Then, you will be prosperous and successful."

The man became rich, and his wealth continued to grow until he became very wealthy.

- 1. **Health:** Exodus 23:25-26. "Worship the LORD your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you, and none will miscarry or be barren in your land. I will give you a full life span." Deuteronomy 7:12-15. "If you pay attention to these laws and are careful to follow them, then the LORD your God will keep his covenant of love with you The LORD will keep you free from every disease." Fathers and Mothers, there is no wisdom in disobeying God as disobedience brings sufferings.
- 2. Closeness to God: When you obey people above you, they naturally draw you closer. Exodus 33:11 says the LORD spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend...... Obedience naturally attracts intimacy or closeness. Be committed to obeying God and see how you grow closer to him. John 14: 23-24 "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them"
- 3. **God is happy with obedient people**: Obedience delights God. Samuel reminded Saul that God delights in obedience 1Sam 15:22, after his flagrant disobedience to God. "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed than the fat of rams". If you want God to be happy with you, obey him.

E. CONCLUSION

Obedience to God is not expected to be half-hearted or with reservations. It is expected to be wholeheartedly. It is in our own best interest to take God's words seriously and begin to act without questioning him. If we can trust his commands and truly obey, rest assured our exploits will be enormous.
