**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 24TH JULY, 2022**

**THEME: THE VANITY OF LOVING THE WORLD
READINGS: 1 JOHN 2:8-17, MARK 12: 28-34, 1 Peter 4:7-11**

Introduction: In the first chapter of his letter, John tells us it is not possible to “claim fellowship with God” and pattern our lives after the world. He repeats this theme throughout his letter. He tells us we must “walk in the light” (1 John 1:7), and that we cannot simultaneously walk in the light and walk in darkness. As believers, we are not to love the world’s ways or the world’s goods. This writing of John is important today in our generation where it looks like people want to be worldly and spiritual at the same time. We cannot love both the world and the Father simultaneously. Love for the world pushes out love for the Father, and love for the Father pushes out love for the world- that is how it works.

What is the World?

John mentions “**the world**” six times in verses 15 – 17 of 1 John chapter 2. What is the world? It’s the entire system of rebellion against God and his rule. Commentator F.F. Bruce says, “*Worldliness...does not lie in things we do or in places we frequent; it lies in the human heart, in the set of human affections and attitudes.*” This is so important. If you don’t get this, you won’t get what God is teaching in this passage. John is not saying the world God made was bad. He’s saying the way we relate to what God made can be bad. To John, worldliness is thinking the world is all that ultimately matters—placing it above the Father. What makes the world bad is not the stuff in it—which came from God—but how we treat that stuff. We cannot love the world (view it as ultimate) and love the Father (view him as ultimate) at the same time. One comes first in our heart. John says it should be the Father. The mindset that says the world is ultimate originated from the world. When sin entered in, we replaced God for God’s creation. We distorted and twisted God’s good gifts into our ultimate hope. John gives three categories of worldliness: “**the desires (lust) of the flesh and the desires (lust) of the eyes and the pride of life.**” The first two refer to desires for what we don’t have, and the third refers to the pride in what we do have.

The world today is driven by a passion for pleasure and pride in possessions but your life as a child of God must not be driven by what is driving the world. We are called to be different from the world and to be the light.

Reasons Why We Should Not Love the World.

FIRST, love for the world is antithetical to loving God. “If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him” (v. 15). When we love the world it actually pushes out our love for God; conversely, when we love God it pushes out our love for the world. Jesus said, “No one can serve two masters; he will either hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to the one and despise the other” (Mt 6:24). The reason love for the world pushes out love for God is that “all that is in the world – the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life – is not of the Father but is of the world;” so loving the world excludes loving God; loving the world cannot coexist with loving God. Don’t try to convince yourself that you are “fully committed to Christ” if you are not, because if you have a “high level of commitment to the things of this world,” you are not fully committed to Christ. To all of God’s children, in whatever stage of spiritual development they are in, John gives a strong warning’ - “Love not the world”

SECOND, the World and its Lusts are Passing Away (v. 17a). Nobody purposely builds his house on a river bottom; nobody invests his life savings in a company that is going bankrupt; nobody boards a sinking ship; and nobody jumps out of an airplane without first checking his parachute. Conversely, to invest your life in a world that is passing away, will only end in misery and heartache. Why would a believer be so foolish so as to continue investing his life in it, when the undeniable truth is, “this world and all its toys and cravings is passing away”? Are you really willing to exchange the eternal reward for some foolish temporal gain? (Mt 16:24-26). If you share the desires of the world, you will pass away. You will not only lose your treasure. You will lose your life.

THIRD, those who do the Will of the Father will Live Forever (v. 17b). The opposite of loving the world is not only “loving God” (v. 15), but also “*doing the will of God*” (v. 17b). Jesus said, “If you love me *you will keep my commandments*” (John 14:15; 1 John 5:3) — so loving God and doing His will are one and the same. One cannot say he loves God and yet refuses to obey Him — the two positions are contrary.

In the Kingdom of God, whoever does the will of God abides forever. You don't have to reach the top of this world. You can be on the bottom. The world hates the lowly and humble, but God loves them. Whoever comes to God with a heart longing for his grace will find it. Every godly desire ends up in heaven. What is the will of God that abides? It's treasuring Jesus and believing in him for eternal life—looking to him for everything: all satisfaction, all worth, all joy, all peace, all hope. One way to evaluate if you are doing the will of the father is by looking at what you do. For example, how do you spend your money, your time, your effort? How much of what you have do you attribute to Jesus vs yourself? How much energy do you spend on the things of God?

The Eternity Perspective- Our Response

“But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging. As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen” 1 Peter 4:7-11.

This must be our response. The end of all things is at hand. The love of the father and eternity must take hold of our hearts. Martin Luther said we need to live from the perspective of eternity. All that we have right now will not matter in few years to come. If it won't matter then, why do you think it matters now? The world as we know it will pass away with everything in it. Only those who do the will of the father will endure forever. Take time and thing about it.

Conclusion: The world obviously has a different view of how we should live. The postmodern culture in which we live believes that all ideas are equally valid, and that we are all free to believe and practice whatever we desire, in the name of diversity and tolerance. Thus in our broadminded world more and more people have gravitated toward a “hedonistic view” of life — “Eat, drink, and be merry” (Lk 12:19), for tomorrow we die. It is easy for the Christian, in this environment, to embrace a humanistic view of the world rather than a biblical view. To love and enjoy the society of the world is to have a heart “destitute of grace” – be aware of it; the world is a bitter foe to grace; it is an enemy to God, and if you befriend it, you make yourself an enemy of God (James 4:4). The world teaches us to de-radicalize, to fall in line. But when a church let's gospel doctrine create a gospel culture, Jesus sets the rules, not the world. Christ's massive weight of grace leads us out of the land of slavery into the land of freedom. We become a different kind of community—one centered on Jesus and rooted in joy, where confession of sin is common, repentance is a way of life because we have nothing to hide anymore, and loving one another is the natural outflow of our deep desire for the Lord. The world doesn't understand it because it's not of this world. It's of God.
