It is in God's plan of salvation for the sinful world that grace finds its deepest meaning and widest expression. Or, how else does one explain John 3:16-17; "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved." This Jesus, the Son of God that came into the world to save sinners is the embodiment of Love and Grace. Man did nothing to merit that great sacrifice He paid.

God does not know any person who has not sinned! Paul wrote in Romans 3:10 - As it is written, 'There is none righteous, no not one.' And went further to say in verse 23 – For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. We don't always want to admit it, but we are ALL sinners!

We would like to think that we are basically good people, but the Bible tells us just the opposite. Ecclesiastes 7:20 – For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not. Deep down we are not good, but rather, we are wicked and sinful people. Not only do sinners (or unbelievers) sin, but God does not know a believer who has not sinned! But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Rom.5:8. We do not become perfect when we are saved; we are only given the ability to be an overcomer. This ability comes with grace; "For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, 12 teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age" Titus 2:11-12. Inherent in this salvation that Grace brought are forgiveness, justification, righteousness and all that makes the sinful sinners pleasing to God through simple faith.

The elect or chosen people of God are the people that are, for no justifiable reasons, preferred by God. The Lord God said to Rebekah in in Gen.25:23 - "Two nations are in your womb, two peoples shall be separated from your body; one people shall be stronger than the other, and the older shall serve the younger." NKJV).

Nothing in Theology, other than sovereignty of God, explains this. This is the foundation of Israel as the elect of God; they are the descendants of Jacob who had been preferred by God right from the womb, his many immoral and unpleasant acts notwithstanding. Same grace was extended to the believers in Christ to become the children of God, i.e. the elect or chosen people of God who, according to Apostle Peter, were “once not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.” 1 Peter 2:10.

One may want to ask “who of the Israel of old and the Israel of today qualifies to be loved and chosen of God to be His own special people? The answer is NONE.

Paul made it clearer when he wrote in Eph.2:4-10, 11-13

4 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7 that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.... 11 Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh — who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands — 12 that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. 13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. (NKJV).

Each of us must come to the understanding that we are mere sinners saved by grace. How can that be, you ask? Grace and Mercy!

Grace = God giving us what we don't deserve.

Mercy = God NOT giving us what we DO deserve!

Yes, it is normal for you to be excited knowing that God loves you and had chosen you to be His own child, His very elect, by grace.
