**THEME: GOD’S WORSHIP AND MAN’S FATE**  
**TEXT: PSALM 119:97-112; 1 CHRONICLE 29: 1-9; ACTS 2:41-47; MATTHEW 25:31-46**

Fate can be defined as the development of events outside a person's control, regarded as predetermined by a supernatural power.

It is man’s fate and destiny to worship God. We were created for His pleasure - Revelation 4:11.

All of God’s creatures in heaven; the 24 elders, the four living creatures, the holy angels and archangels all worship God day and night before His throne - Revelation 7:15. All His creations on earth are also expected to give Him worship.

God loves to be worshipped.

**What then is worship??**

Worship is the feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a living God.

Worship has a lot to do with knowing who God is. If we don’t know who He is, we won’t worship Him adequately.

If we don’t know His power, His love, His faithfulness, His benevolence, His majesty, His might, we won’t worship Him appropriately.

I therefore encourage us to study more about this our God. To seek to know Him more because, we really can’t worship who we don’t know.

**There are two types of worship:**

- 1. **Acceptable:** Hebrews 12:28-29 says “Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire”.

**What is Acceptable worship?**

- This is when we worship God in spirit and in truth - John 4:24.
- When we worship God in purity of heart. Only the righteous can praise God acceptably. Psalm 24:3-5 says only those that have clean hands and pure hearts, those that have not lifted up their souls into vanity nor sworn deceitfully.
- Acceptable worship is expressing reverence and adoration to God without eye service. This is when you worship God for God and not for people to see you.

- It is worshipping only God. If we have other gods in our hearts that take the place of God, we aren't worshipping Him acceptably. We cannot have two masters. Nothing must take God's place. He must be Lord and Master over our lives, decisions and over every step we take.

2. **Unacceptable:**

- This is the opposite of the above.

Worship is also not just an activity, worship must be our life.

As Christians, worship for us is perpetual obedience and surrender to God.

It is possible to lift our hands and offer lip service to God, but our hearts are far from Him - Matthew 15:8.

It is impossible to claim you have reverence for your earthly father and still disobey him. Obedience therefore is an evidence that we worship/reverence God.

Why then is worship our fate?

1. It is a prerequisite for pleasing Him. John 4:23 says God seeks for worshippers. This means He is daily looking for people to will worship Him.
2. It is a prerequisite for making heaven. We earlier established the fact that worship is a lifestyle of perpetual obedience to God. A disobedient Christian has no place in the kingdom of God. This is therefore a charge for us not to take the commands, laws and dictates of God lightly.
3. Jesus our example lived a life of worship and reverence. Hebrews 5:8 says "although He was a Son, He learned obedience through the things He suffered". Jesus the Son of God learnt obedience, He learnt the art of worship and reverence to God, what then is our excuse??
4. It is a heavenly way of life. As citizens of heaven, we must, like the creatures in heaven, worship God all the days of our lives. Revelation 4:8
