It is worshipping only God. If we have other gods in our hearts that take the place of God, we aren't worshipping Him acceptably. We cannot have two masters. Nothing must take God's place. He must be Lord and Master over our lives, decisions and over every step we take.

2. Unacceptable:

This is the opposite of the above.

Worship is also not just an activity, worship must be our life.

As Christians, worship for us is perpetual obedience and surrender to God.

It is possible to lift our hands and offer lip service to God, but our hearts are far from Him - Matthew 15:8.

It is impossible to claim you have reverence for your earthly father and still disobey him. Obedience therefore is an evidence that we worship/reverence God.

Why then is worship our fate?

- It is a prerequisite for pleasing Him. John 4:23 says God seeks for worshippers. This means He is daily looking for people to will worship Him.
- 2. It is a prerequisite for making heaven. We earlier established the fact that worship is a lifestyle of perpetual obedience to God. A disobedient Christian has no place in the kingdom of God. This is therefore a charge for us not to take the commands, laws and dictates of God lightly.
- 3. Jesus our example lived a life of worship and reverence. Hebrews 5:8 says "although He was a Son, He learned obedience through the things He suffered". Jesus the Son of God learnt obedience, He learnt the art of worship and reverence to God, what then is our excuse??
- 4. It is a heavenly way of life. As citizens of heaven, we must, like the creatures in heaven, worship God all the days of our lives. Revelation 4:8
