#### JUSTIFICATION FOR SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP

The desirability of society membership is traceable to the Godly advice of Jethro to Moses his son in law as he administered the huge population of the Israelites in the wilderness.

"MOREOVER THOU SHALL PROVIDE OUT ALL THE PEOPLE ABLE MEN, SUCH AS FEAR GOD, MEN OF TRUTH, HATING COVETOUSNESS AND PLACE SUCH OVER THEM, TO BE RULERS OF THOUSANDS AND RULERS OF HUNDREDS, RULERS OF FIFTIES AND RULERS OF TENS" EXOD. 18:21.

Beloved to the glory of God AVMCC is a fairly large congregation and as the Israel of God today Gal. 6:16 we must follow the Bible standard as expantiated fully in Exodus 18:17-27 for the following reasons:

- 1. It is good to be in society vs. 17.
- 2. The blessings of joining a society far outweighs the burden if any.
- The burden if any is light because it is of Christ and not of man – Matt. 11:28-30.
- 4. The Priests will not wear out in attending to large congregation as it is not possible to know everybody vs 18.
- 5. The people will not wear out as their matter receive the attention of sectional leaders with a referral of major matters to appropriate quarters vs 18.
- 6. It is a Godly counsel to be a member of a society vs 19.
- 7. It is an avenue to learn more of the ordinances of God and His laws vs 20.
- 8. It affords the opportunities of knowing the way of God better as seminars retreats, visitations, fellowships, fasting praying are arranged vs 20.
- 9. It points us to the work which we have to do vs 20.
- 10. It enables the Priest to focus more on Prayer and the word of God which of course is their major assignment Acts 6:4.
- 11. It allows the church to maximize the potentials of spiritual gifts and explore talents of members using also their professional expertise to enhance the standard of the Church vs 21.
- 12. It allows for matters to receive urgent and timely attention vs 22.
- 13. It makes the work in the house of God to be EASY and not become a BURDEN vs 22.

"So Saul clothed David with his armor, and he put a bronze helmet on his head; he also clothed him with a coat of mail. David fastened his sword to his armor and tried to walk, for he had not tested them. And David said to Saul, "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them." So David took them off. Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose for himself five smooth stones from the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine". Ephesians 6:11-13 KJV 11 Put on the whole armour of God that ye may be able to
<ul> <li>stand against the wiles of the devil.</li> <li>12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.</li> <li>13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.</li> </ul>
<b>INTRODUCTION</b> Job in Job 14:1 described the length of days of every man as full of trouble. Apostle Paul in our text (Ephesians 5:12) explain to us that we "wrestle" that is we fight . for every bible believer in Christ we fight with the confident of the victory attain and obtain for us by our Lord Jesus through His suffering, death ,resurrection and ascension( Colossians 2:14- 15; 1 John 3:8). In the story of David and Goliath from the old testament reading for this Sunday, King Saul gave his armour to David for the battle but David could not proceed to battle with it (for he had not tested them. And David said to Saul, "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them.") and he used the only equipment of war he has tested to get the victory for the nation of Israel . Likewise in the battle of life, you don't used the equipment you have not tested . Apostle Paul revealed to us the appropriate armour suitable for fighting this battle(s) otherwise VICTORS WILL TURN TO VICTIMS. Let discuss the armour and how we can appropriately use this armour, thus:
<ol> <li>What is the belt of truth?         A belt was the first piece of equipment put on, and it secures all the other pieces of our armor. Wearing the belt showed that the soldier was ready for action, since he would only loosen his belt when he went off duty. Truth should surround us like a belt. Knowing God's truth is the surefire antidote to Satan's lies and deception. And to be truly ready for the battle, we must be completely truthful ourselves in our inner being, like our Creator.     </li> </ol>

#### 2. What is the breastplate of righteousness?

Next, Paul tells us to "put on the breastplate of righteousness."

Without righteousness, we leave ourselves open to Satan's attacks. To be righteous is first of all to repent and be forgiven of our sins, and then to do what is right in God's eyes. Psalm 119:172 tells us that God's commandments are righteousness. So to be righteous is to obey God's laws of love.

Isaiah 59:17 says that God Himself puts on righteousness as a breastplate! This may be part of what inspired Paul to use this analogy. Isaiah 59 starts by explaining that "your iniquities have separated you from your God" (verse 2). Iniquity is the opposite of righteousness, so when we give in to sin without repenting, we are removing our breastplate and leaving ourselves open to more of Satan's attacks.

#### 3. What are the shoes of the gospel of peace?

Shoes might not be the most exciting piece of armor, but the Zondervan NIV Bible Commentary highlights their importance:

"The military successes both of Alexander the Great and of Julius Caesar were due in large measure to their armies being well shod and thus able to undertake long marches at incredible speed over rough terrain."

The word "preparation," denoting readiness, reminds us that we are to be eager to preach the gospel of peace. The Church of God is sent to announce the good news of God's Kingdom, which will spread His way of peace around the whole world. Having our spiritual shoes on, we will be ready to spread the news to others.

Albert Barnes' Notes on the Bible tells us that the sandals of the Roman soldier "often were fitted with nails, or armed with spikes, to make the hold firm in the ground." God's good news and our mission—our marching orders—to preach it serve as our firm foundation.

#### 4. What is the shield of faith?

When our faith in God's power and love is strong, it is impossible for Satan to break through our shield and land a blow. Faith means more than just believing that God exists, of course. It includes a firm belief that everything God does is truly for our good. Also, faith is the absolute conviction that God will always do what He has promised (Romans 4:18-21).

Faith protects us in many ways. Faith is powerful and protects us not only from those physical dangers, but from the spiritual temptations and dangers. The shield of faith is not just for personal protection. The Roman soldiers had a strategy of joining their shields together. If we join our shields—that is, strengthen each other with our faith, building up and serving as we are able—we will be able to take on any challenge. David expresses he has this Shield of faith with him in the encounter with Goliath (1 Samuel 17: 37 & 45).

The sword of the Spirit, like the Roman gladius, can also help us to conquer all our enemies, including that most difficult one, our entrenched human weaknesses. Hebrews 4:12 explains: "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

Remember how Jesus used the Word of God to defeat Satan (Matthew 4:1-10)? Christ used scripture quotes three times. He brought to mind the scriptures that dealt with the situation, that showed what He should do and that strengthened His resolve. And so should we.

Our sword won't stay sharp on its own. We must continually sharpen it with regular and focused Bible study.

#### Praying always with all prayer and supplication

Paul ends this section encouraging us to pray fervently for ourselves, for each other and for the work of the Church.

"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak" (Ephesians 6:18-20).

The Church and each of us individually, move forward on our knees. Praying reminds us of the battle, reminds us of the source of our strength and defense, and reminds God that we are fully committed to following Him as obedient and faithful soldiers. **Prayer and Bible study are the most powerful tools for combating Satan's weapons.** 

When we put on this whole armor of God, we will be prepared for Satan's attempts to attack us with pride, envy, lust for forbidden pleasures, itching ears, disappointment, discouragement, doubt or division—or any other tricks he may use.

#### CONCLUSION:

To use this armour, you must have been enlisted, tested and trained as one of the solider of Christ. To be enlisted, you must repent from your sin (s) and confess Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Saviour. Remember, we're at war. Let's be alert to Satan's devices, and let's put on the whole armor of God!
