**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2022**

**THEME: THE COMMUNITY OF THE ELECT**  
**TEXT: PSALM 119:81-98; PROVERBS 7:7-10;**  
**1 PETER 5:1-11; MATTHEW 18:1-16**

The community of the elect is the body of Christ, the group of people that have yielded to the call of salvation in Christ Jesus. The doctrine of election in the Bible is on the basis that ‘Many are called but few are chosen’ Matt 22:14. This is simply saying that while salvation of God is for all mankind, only few will embrace it. The few people are the ones choosing by God to inherit the Kingdom of God.

The only way to enter God's spiritual family is by a spiritual birth, through faith in Jesus Christ (John 3:1-16). Just as there are two parents in physical birth, so there are two parents in spiritual birth: the Spirit of God (John 3:5-6) and the Word of God (1 Peter 1:23). The new birth gives to us a new nature (2 Peter 1:4) as well as a new and living hope (1 Peter 1:3).

We need to know that from the first time the gospel has been preached, the message has been the same, but people have refused to listen. It is not just to come to church that makes a man a member of the community of the elect but his repentance from sin and acceptance of Jesus Christ as the Lord and Saviour. God is using this time to call us to the reality that not all that call Him Lord shall enter the Kingdom of God but they that do the will of God- Matt 7:21.

Beloved, it is a glorious to be enlisted into the community of the elect. This is the highest level of life. When you are, you are secured, not because you hold tightly to Jesus but because He holds tightly to you. As community of the elect, we are called to be different from the world. We have our own culture, belief system, way of doing things, value system, philosophy, and set of government different from the world.

As God’s community, we are expected to:

- 1. **Live in humility and submission to one another:** Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but **in humility** count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look not only to his own

interests, but also to the interests of others.<sup>5</sup> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus,<sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,<sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.<sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. (Philippians 2:3-8)

True humility means knowing yourself, accepting yourself, and being yourself - your best self - to the glory of God. It means avoiding two extremes: thinking less of yourself than you ought to (as did Moses when God called him, Ex 3:11ff), or thinking more of yourself than you ought to (Rom 12:3).

2. **Live in unity-** The selfishness and disunity of God's people is a scandal to the Christian faith. What causes these problems? Pride - thinking ourselves more important than we really are. It was pride that led man into sin at the beginning (Gen 3:5). When Christians are Eying for themselves and not for others, then there is bound to be conflict and division (Phil 2:1ff)
3. **Live in Love-** Beloved, let us **love one another**, for love is from God, and **whoever loves** has been born of God and knows God.<sup>8</sup> Anyone who does not love does not know God, because **God is love**.<sup>9</sup> In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. (1 John 4:8-9)
4. **Live in Joy-** Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.<sup>2</sup> Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and **we rejoice** in hope of the glory of God.<sup>3</sup> Not only that, but **we rejoice** in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance,<sup>4</sup> and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,<sup>5</sup> and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. (Romans 5:1-5).
5. **Live in heaven in view-** If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.<sup>2</sup> Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.<sup>3</sup> For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.<sup>4</sup> When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. (Colossians 3:1-4)
