SUNDAY, 11TH SEPTEMBER, 2022**

THEME: PRAYING ARIGHT

**TEXT: PSALM 119: 145-160; 1KINGS 3:5-12,
ROMANS 8: 18-23, LUKE 11:1-13**

INTRODUCTION

Happy Sunday in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, Who is the reason for our gathering. You are welcome to His presence today, and I pray that our cups shall be filled to overflowing with oil of gladness as we fellowship together today.

"And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples".

Prayer is communication between us and God. It is a spiritual conveyor, which enables humanity to have access to Divinity in order to present their case and also know the **will** of God. We must not reduce the effectiveness of prayer to one way traffic. It is a two-way conversation; we talk and God respond to our requests. Besides, it is an address (such as a petition) to God in word or thought. A conversation with God or an evolving interaction with God. In this regard, such conversation could be for:

1. Praise and Worship (Adoration)
2. Petition
3. Intercession
4. Thanksgiving
5. Supplication
6. Deliverance
7. Spiritual warfare, etc.

Luke 11 begins with Jesus "praying in a certain place." When he has finished praying, one of his disciples asked, **"Lord, teach us to pray..."** In response, Jesus offered a three-part teaching which includes **"a model prayer, a parable about prayer, and some sayings about prayer"**.

Jesus' prayer and the teaching that follows are mutually enlightening. Jesus invites his disciples into a deep personal relationship with God, encouraging them to call upon God using the same name He uses **"Abba", Father**. He invites his disciples to call upon God as children call upon a loving parent, trusting that they belong to God and that, what God wants for them is good and life-giving. Jesus' sayings reinforced this invitation. If human parents, with all their faults, know how to give their

Jesus, in giving the Lord's Prayer, does not only teach us how to pray, but He also teaches that God is Our Father. A Father who loves and cares for us, a Father who is a Friend, Shepherd, Companion, Supporter, Provider, Priest and Encourager (Psalms 23:1-5). Hence, Jesus' revelation of the Father is a gift that led us to have a warm relationship and interaction with Him, and thus restored our original state of being the children of God.

We become conscious that we ought to respect individuals name not because they have a good name, but because of the person that it represents. Now, with regards to God, His divine name must be hallowed in all we do, not because He needs it, but because of His **nature** and we recognize Him as the source of holiness.

Again, we got the understanding that the Kingdom of God is present wherever He is present, thus, we continuously and gradually seek Jesus to unite us to the Father's will, so that just like Him we can also say: **Thy Will Be Done**. Every prayer offered in accordance to His will always gain His attention. To know His will, we must be students of his word. Because, the mind and the will of God, are in the Word of God.

He further taught us to depend on God who is compassionate for forgiveness which is the centrality of salvation (John 3:16), deliverance from evil and protection from temptation because "To forget (err) is a human act, to forgive is a divine act. Ever since mankind was corrupted by Satan, God has been working to save humanity, allow us to escape from evil, allow us to escape from the bondage and terrible jaw of Satan, and this He achieved through the redemptive work of Christ on the Cross. Hence, we ask for His grace to rescue us from the snare of Satan.

Of a truth, God is everywhere and wherever we call on Him, there's a guarantee that He will answer but the major factor that facilitates His response to our calling is "**when we pray aright**". Hence, we will only waste our time, cry in vain and gain nothing in return because whatever we ask outside the will of God can only be triggered by our self-will (James 4:3).

The only way to pray aright is by praying in alignment to the will of God, knowing the will of God per time is a deposition of the Holy Spirit. He who has the Holy Spirit is someone who is born again, and committed to the worship and service of God. It was testified of Solomon in 1st kings 3:3-5 that he loved the Lord, walked in the statutes of David his father; he sacrificed and offered thousands of burnt offerings at the high places, etc.
