5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 4TH SEPTEMBER, 2022 THEME: DOING EXPLOITS FOR GOD TEXT: PSALM 119:129-144; EXODUS 3:13-20; ROMANS 8:26-30; MATTHEW 10:16-22.

1. INTRODUCTION

Happy Sunday in the Name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Welcome to another Sunday, a day of worship and fellowship. Thank you for maintaining fellowship with God and the brethren. As we interact with God, we also interact with one another (1John 1:3). Together, we constitute a formidable team constantly useful to God doing exploits for him.

Daniel 11:32 ".....But the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits"

There are three focal points in this scripture; knowing God, being strong, and doing exploits. Being strong and doing exploits are dependent on knowing God. Christians can be differentiated in the matters of knowing, being, and doing. For only as we know God can we be strong, and only as we are strong can we attempt to do great things in the Name of God. Conversely, if we are not doing exploits for God, it is because we are not strong, and if we are not strong, it is because we do not know God well enough! Our degree of knowing God is directly proportional to our strength and exploits.

2. KNOWING GOD.

This knowing is very personal. Some think of God as "distant, up there, somewhere," and they as "down here on earth.". If we see God as far from us, then he may seem unreachable or unreal. God desires that we know him. Knowing him comes from seeking him. Knowing God personally starts with being saved through the Lord Jesus Christ, Who said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6). In the Lord's high-priestly prayer in John 17, He said, "And this is life eternal, that they may know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent" (John 17:3). This is the initial sense in which we come to know God, through personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as our Savior; but we must go on to know Him progressively and intimately, as the apostle Paul described in Philippians 3:10, "That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death." Paul wanted to know better his (3Ps); His Person, His Power and His Passion.

The measure of our knowing will determine the measure of our being... and our doing! Our life task is seeking to know him more and more. God is the repository of unimaginable, incomprehensible and unfathomable power. Knowing him is encountering his awesomeness. When you encounter him progressively, you can't remain the same because his might, powers and greatness will rub on you. When Moses came down from Mount Sinai where he stayed forty days and night, nobody could look at his shining face. After spending this extended amount of time with God, Moses comes down the mountain, and his face is shining with the glory of God (Exodus 34:29-35). He had to wear a veil over his face to shroud the glory.

3. BECOMING STRONG.

The more we know God the stronger we will be! We will be stronger morally, as Daniel was when he was cast into the den of lions because he refused to stop praying to His God (Daniel 6); and as Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah were when they were cast into the fiery furnace because they refused to bow to a false god (Daniel 3). We will be strong spiritually, because we are reminded in Ephesians 6:10, "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might."

Therefore, as we know God, we become strong and stronger in our trust in Him; stronger in our ability to resist and overcome temptation and evil; and stronger in our ability to be a source of strength to others.

4. DOING EXPLOITS FOR GOD.

Once the disciples received power, they started doing exploits. They started achieving great feats. We have examples of men and women who did exploits for God in the Bible. Think about Gideon and his small band of 300 men (Judges 7); of Samson (Judges 14); of David and his encounter with Goliath (I Samuel 17); of Elijah on Mt. Carmel (I Kings 18); and see God's picture gallery of the great heroes of faith (Hebrews 11). Think also of the apostles of our Lord and the early Christians, "Men that have hazarded their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Acts 15:26), who were spoken of in these terms, "These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also" (Acts 17:6). If we truly know the Lord and are thereby made strong by Him, we shall do exploits, and our God will get the glory.

5. CONCLUSION

I want to believe there is a hunger in you already to knowing God. All Jesus came to do was to show us the Father and reconnect us to him. When he physically departed, having reconciled us to the Father through his blood, he left his Spirit, the Spirit of God with us, to keep revealing God to us. Our lifetime can't exhaust knowing God. Seek to know God by reading, studying and meditation. Pray passionately, meaningfully and sincerely. Open your heart to the Holy Spirit and you will be filled with the strength needed for exploits.
