For the women and Choir alike, today's anniversary will mark the beginning of greater exploits for you in Jesus Name. Our meditation today is on Faith at Work. Working our faith is preparatory to experiencing fresh dimensions of God. For he that comes to him must believe that he is and he is the rewarder of them that diligently seek him. The reward of faith is generally fresh and new experience of God. That is what we must seek after.

2. ACTIVE FAITH

Faith is action, action and action. We profess and express. Faith in Christianity is inherently active. It comes with elements of force and dynamism. Faith is weighty and compelling. It is not passive. The presence of faith commands a change or an action or a performance. Hebrews 11:1-2 helps us clarify this. "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report". The elders were able to achieve great feats by faith. These elders were those highlighted in the Chapter and many more in the New Testament and many more in generations before us and many more in our generation. Anyone who is desirous of a good report(exploit for God) must be willing to deploy faith. Our generation and generations to come can only talk about out exploits if we activate our faith. This message is summon to Faith Workshop. Therein we can produce great things for the Kingdom of God.

Let me share a story in Matthew 9:27-29

"And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou son of David, have mercy on us. And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you"

The interesting things here are;

(i). Two blind men followed him. How were they able to keep up? (ii). They were crying as they followed him. (iii). They were saying 'Thou son of David, have mercy on us'. (iv). They followed him to the house. At this point, Jesus asked if they believe he could heal them. Jesus didn't ask this all the way! While they were crying and pleading, Jesus didn't answer them! They could have felt snubbed and disparaged but they kept on following, crying and pleading. They were not discouraged. Eventually, they got their healing according to their faith. **Their faith had substance.**

a. Faith at Work is Walking Faith

Without walking with God, it will be difficult to put your faith to work. 2Cor 5:7 "For we walk by faith, not by sight". You ask me, for how long will I be walking? I'll say, we keep walking till God calls us home. There is no stopping or dumping our faith. This walk starts from the point of salvation and goes all through life. Now some people stop walking by faith at some point for several reasons but no reason is worth jettisoning this walk of life. If a man stops walking by faith, he stops experiencing God. He becomes static. No spiritual excitement. Then, his faith will decline into fear and fear doesn't speak to life. Was Abraham not getting weak in his faith? He was but he fought it Romans 4:17-20. In verse 20, the Bible says "He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God". He had a promise of about 25years. Age was not on his side. Strength was not on his side. In this, he didn't stagger at God's promise. He didn't abandon God's word. He kept on walking God.

When we walk with God, it may not make things easy but it makes them possible. Walking with him gives us assurance of his presence and power in our lives. Our God is powerful and with him all things are possible.

b. Faith at Work is Performing Faith

John 4:12 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on

me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father". Faith is active. Faith is in the doing. It begs to be applied every time. We use faith most times but not consciously. We use it passively. We might not even know what we are doing is an element of faith. For instance, someone wants to celebrate his 60th birthday and he starts planning towards it. Now, the planning is the substance of the event. He believes he will celebrate the birthday. If he fixes date and does nothing else, that disagrees with his intention. What am I saying? We must perform. Christianity is about the performance of Kingdom values, virtues and power. When we use our slogan 'Tell the Story – Keep the Faith', what are we saying? It essentially means the good works of Jesus must be continued by us. Preach about Jesus and do the works of Jesus. Pray for that boy and keep praying until you get result.

c. Faith at Work is Living Faith

Faith is never meant to be a one-time experience. In our circles, it is tempting to fall into that trap because we put so much emphasis on being saved by faith. We talk about accepting Christ, receiving Christ, trusting Christ, and giving your heart to Christ. We challenge people to respond in faith to the Gospel invitation. This is well and good, but sometimes we leave the impression that having been saved by faith, the rest of life is up to us. Not so! The same faith that saves us is the faith that carries us from day to day as we make the journey from earth to heaven. That's why the Bible says, "The just shall live by faith" - faith from first to last" Romans 1:17. The whole Christian life is a life of faith. We are saved by faith, kept by faith, and we walk by faith, endure by faith, rejoice by faith, serve by faith, love by faith, sacrifice by faith, pray by faith, worship by faith, and we obey by faith. We get married by faith, and we have children by faith. All that we do, we do by faith. Paul said"the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me" Gal 2:20

d. Faith at Work is Victorious Faith

We can choose to live as victims. We can choose to live as whiners. We can choose to live as losers. Do you know that we can choose to live otherwise as well? The ability to live otherwise, i.e by faith, is in us. A Christian can live tormented by the devil if he chooses to undermine the power of his faith in Jesus. A Christian can unnecessarily suffer if he fails to realize he has the power to reject it. 1John 5:4 "For whosoever is born of God overcometh the world. And this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith". The victory that overcomes the world is our faith in Jesus. Please don't forget this. In Mark 2, four friends of a man suffering from palsy broke the roof to access Jesus. That was disruptive but they knew what they wanted. They needed to access Jesus at all cost. Will you pray at all cost? Will you study the Bible at all cost? Will you be in Church at all cost? Will you get out of that which holds you down at all cost? What we didn't know was how long they had been trying to access Jesus. In those days, to get Jesus attention could be very difficult because of the crowd. That was why the woman with the issue of blood crawled to access Jesus. These four friends broke the roof. Again, I ask, what bad habit will you break to be victorious? What mentality will you drop to be victorious? What will you give up to be victorious? Mark 2:5 says Jesus saw their faith. Brethren, that special offering you are giving may the substance of your faith Jesus sees today to give you the victory you so desire. Take that step of faith on your health.

Please ponder on these things. Things we do prove whether we are faith-full or faith-less. Let us step out today to walk by faith, act in faith, live by faith and win by faith. Do have a glorious week in Jesus Name. Amen
